Assessment Manuals/Resources

1. How do districts order braille testing materials?
 - a. Braille order forms for the English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) Summative and Screener, and Oregon Extended (ORExt) assessments are available on the [Assessment Administration page](#) under the Forms accordion.
 - b. The braille versions of the general English Language Arts (ELA), Math, and Science assessments are online and do not require any ordering.
2. Will ODE translate 30-day notices/opt-out forms into additional languages (beyond the current list)?
 - a. Current ODE policy is to translate essential documents into the top ten languages represented in Oregon's student population.

3. Are there any updates to the Early Learning Transition Check-in (ELTC) process?
 - a. The ELTC held an informational session for districts on October 30 to help new districts prepare for future implementation. Feedback from past pilots showed that districts appreciate having more time for planning and communication with early learning partners, community members, staff, and school boards.  - a. The SEED Survey is the only survey that the Assessment Team supports. Please review the [survey overview document](#) for points of contact for the Student Health and EVE surveys. The administration responsibilities for these will be designated at the local level.

Some limited preliminary associations between select Opportunity to Learn questions and statewide summative test results were shared during the District Assessment Result Release Webinar in October.
