Award Purpose

The Teaching and Learning Innovation Awards aim to:

- Highlight and promote innovative practices using Smarter Balanced resources
- Inspire creative ideas for leveraging the Smarter Balanced Assessment System
- Increase awareness of the system's capacity to enhance teaching and learning goals

We welcome submissions that showcase innovative practices, strategies, methods, or interventions designed to enhance teaching.

Award Priorities

Priority will be given to strategies that accelerate student learning or enhance outcomes in areas such as:

- Narrowing achievement gaps
- Engaging students in assessments and instruction
- Learner-centered instruction (e.g., student agency, student voice, etc.)
- Evidence-based interventions
- Student mastery, competency, and personalized learning
- Data-driven and needs-based approaches

Award Value

Smarter Balanced will offer up to \$10,000 to a public school district in Oregon. Unused funds may be redistributed, and future awards may increase based on the program's success.
