

SEED SURVEY DATA USE Professional Learning Series

The Oregon Department of Education (ODE) is offering a monthly drop-in professional learning series designed to support Oregon school districts to effectively use and interpret data from the Student Educational Equity Development (SEED) Survey.

Participants will:

- Receive information about SEED data and how to interpret such data
- Develop equity-centered explorations of SEED data
- Identify practical applications and questions that can be asked of SEED data
- Collaborate with other district personnel on problems
 of practice
