### FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On June 12, 2023, Parent filed a request for due process hearing with the State Superintendent of Public Instruction on behalf of Student.
- (2) On June 12, 2023, the Department of Education referred the hearing request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Alison Greene Webster to preside over the hearing in this matter.
- (3) On June 30, 2023, ALJ Webster issued a Ruling on District's Motion for Determination of Sufficiency on Due Process Complaint dismissing seven of Parent's 14 claims in the due process complaint, and authorizing Parent to submit an amended complaint.
- (4) On July 17, 2023 Parent filed an amended complaint. That same date, ALJ Webster convened a prehearing conference with the parties. The parties notified the ALJ of their mediation session scheduled for July 28, 2023.
  - (5) On July 24, 2023, Parent filed a second amended complaint.
- (6) On July 28, 2023, via electronic mail, Parent notified the OAH that the parties had come to an agreement through mediation, and Parent wished to withdraw the hearing request based on resolution of all issues in the due process complaint.

### **ORDER**

Parent's June 12, 2023 request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn. OAH Case No. 2023-ABC-06027/Agency Case DP 23-108 is dismissed with prejudice.
