'20-'21 Review

- Student Suicide Prevention and Wellness (SSPW) Program established through partnership with OHA and Lines for Life (L4L).
- 5 positions created (program manager & 4 regional coordinators through L4L)
- Lines for Life worked with 124 different schools and districts statewide during 2021-22 year.
- \$115,000 in mini-grant funding provided to school districts across the state.
- Initial ODE-OHA Guidance provided for implementation of SB 52
- Sample SB 52 plans (school district suicide prevention plans) provided (ODE/OHA/L4L)
- Development of 6 hours of culturally responsive suicide prevention and intervention training (ODE/OHA/L4L)

Looking Ahead: '21-'23

- Interagency Agreement (IAA) with Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will continue through 2021 - 2023 biennium.
- Efforts will focus on:
 - Development of evaluation criteria for Adi's Act plans,
 - Gap analysis of Adi's Act Plans,
 - Technical assistance guided by the gap analysis,
 - Updating the Step-by-Step guide to reflect learning from this process.

Planning for '23-'25 Biennium

- During 2021 2022
 - Request for Information: to determine what services are available in the field to support Adi's Act and Sec. 36 of SSA.
 - Request for Applications: to review applications for services to support Adi's Act/Section 36 and allocate grant funding.
 - Guided by deep partnership with a broad array of stakeholders.
- 2023 2025
 - Funding will be allocated to future grantee(s) based on RFA outcomes
