- SSPS Progress Update, Quarter 1 & Annual Plans
 - Policy Development
 - Adi's Act Toolkit developed by High Desert ESD and ODE

- Lays out comprehensive strategy that incorporates related legislation, regional systems, and best practices
- Includes staff training recommendations and student curricula
- Sample district policy & procedure docs
- Question: how does this relate to Lines for Life's Step by Step Guide?
 - Wondering if messaging is consistent when so many are asking for help
 - Answer: lots of interconnected work with legislation, policy, implementation, training, being handled by different people
 - SBS Guide is designed by using SSPWs at L4L or by districts
 - Adi's Act Toolkit is designed for use by someone with more background knowledge (SSPWs, SSPSs)
 - SBS Guide is not specific to Oregon, AA Toolkit is specific to Oregon's specific laws
- New Systems Development
 - 8 new Behavioral Safety Assessment Teams
 - 7 new Crisis Response Teams
 - 4 new Professional Learning Communities
- Pilot Initiatives
 - High Desert ESD Forward Project grant for suicide prevention supports
 - Multnomah ESD African-American/Black culturally responsive mental health training
 - Malheur ESD Developing local suicide prevention education and services partnership with the Burns Paiute Tribe of Harney County
 - Question about coordinating services and information want to weave in efforts like the Alliance's work in Harney County with the ESD's work with the Burns Paiute Tribe
 - How can we be matchmakers to assure these local efforts are connected to each other?
 - Answer: building from the organizational strength that we have as an advisory, providing regular updates, reaching our stakeholders
 - Question: can we develop clear shared messages and referrals for resources?
 - Hope to update advisory structure, website, other forms of messaging

 - Boston Colton hired as SSPW for Eastern Oregon region
- Questions and feedback from SSPS Core Advisory
 - Participant shared excitement about development

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- Also wondered about communication and nuances based on regional and district needs
- Participant expressed enthusiasm for collaboration and grassroots efforts good problem to have
 - SSPW team has secured mini-grant funds (not from OHA) that are open to creativity for schools, districts, ESDs
- Participant shared information about new cross-office ODE mental health team to attempt to align messaging and responses and new initiative to increase mental health literacy, address workforce shortage
- Participant requested monthly or quarterly meetings to bring everyone together to secure messaging
- Asked about update on LGBTQ2SIA+ Student Success Plan Coordinator
