

Initial Training Report: Civil Rights Coordinator

Purpose. Civil Rights Coordinators (CRCs) are required to complete training and to keep records of completed trainings. This optional reporting form is one tool a Civil Rights Coordinators can use to ensure that they have completed the required training within one year of first being designated as a CRC.

Training Requirements:

Oregon requires each district to designate one or more Civil Rights Coordinators (OAR 581-021-0655). Upon being first designated, a Civil Rights Coordinator must receive training in accordance with a schedule established by the Oregon Department of Education:

- A Civil Rights Coordinator designated prior to July 1, 2024 must complete training by June 30, 2025 (OAR 581–021–0665)
- A Civil Rights Coordinator designated on or after July 1, 2024 must complete training within one calendar year.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- Question: Can CRCs take training from an entity other than ODE?
 Answer: Yes. If training content requirements are met, CRCs may take training from other entities or organizations.
- 2. Question: Can CRCs take a national training course, or a training course from a different state? Answer: Yes. However, CRCs are still responsible for training on specific Oregon laws, so if a national or different state training is completed, CRCs must be sure to receive training on Oregon-specific requirements.
- 3. Question: Are CRCs required to utilize a specific training documentation form? Answer: No. ODE has provided this form as a voluntary template for recording and documenting training completion.
- 4. Question: Can CRCs meet their initial training requirements with previous trainings taken? Answer: No. Coordinators cannot utilize trainings from years past to meet their training requirements upon initial designation (e.g. a Title IX training taken in 2022 cannot be used to meet training requirements upon designation in January 2024).
