Welcome & Roll Call

- Chair Barnes called the meeting to order at 10:00am.
- Kyle Abraham and Chair Barnes noted no agenda changes or updates.
- Chair Barnes opened for public comment, no public comments noted.

ODF Updates & Member Training Requirements

- Kyle Abraham led the following discussions:
 - Review of Kyle Abraham's history with ODF.
 - o Review of Forest Resources organizational chart, noting the increase in capacity.
 - Randy Silbernagel expressed interest in receiving an updated organizational chart more frequently.
 - a. **ACTION**: Emily Gregorio to send them to the committee members quarterly.
 - o Update on outcome of legislative session.
 - Many limited duration positions in the agency transitioning to permanent.
 - Eric Kranzush expressed interest in visibility to funding sources associated with positions in the division.
 - Update on agency training done for Foresters.

- Chair Barnes expressed interest in improved training for ODF Foresters explaining rules to landowners.
- Emily Gregorio reviewed the training requirement completion.
 - ACTION: Emily Gregorio to send an email reminder with instructions to set up Workday login to committee members.

<u>Updates & Informing Post-Disturbance Harvest Rulemaking</u>

- Nicole Stapp presented a slideshow. The following information was noted:
 - No significant changes are expected to be made to the rules from initial proposal.

HCP Updates

Jennifer Weikel presented a slideshow.

Stream Model Update

- Thomas Whittington presented a slideshow. The following information was noted:
 - As you go up the drainage, it has less flow so there is a smaller stream size category associated. The highest applicable protection classification is always used.
 - o Fish surveys to determine classification rely on habitat characteristics to support fish.
 - Each individual stream segment and the upstream drainage area of that segment is considered, not the whole basin.
 - Current work is focused internally, and surveys are not currently in FERNS because submission of surveys are not dependent on a notification.
 - o Modeling update with new PRISM data not in the near-term plans.
 - We are currently in phase one for flow permanence modeling, and phase two relates to adopting a regulatory model which will be done by ODFW.
 - GIS staff are looking to publish the public side of the survey data quarterly, and FERNS uses the most available update data.
 - Regarding incorporating surveys into flow model, ODFW is working with USGS to get an
 acceptable format so they can be part of the modeling.

FERNS Update

- Brian Barfield presented information. The following information was noted:
 - o Minimum option reporting includes tracking if the threshold has been met.
 - o Looking for ways to mitigate small forestland owners not testing to be an SFO.
 - o Currently working on next set of releases and features, release set for June or July.
 - o **ACTION**: Brian Barfield to follow up with information on FERNS mobile maintenance and updates.

Planning and Priority for Guidance Development

- Scott Swearingen presented a slideshow. The following information was noted:
 - Technical fact sheets are an intermediary before formal guidance is established and they are used by landowners and ODF staff.
 - Kyle Abraham outlined the process of having committee members send their comments in to the committee email (<u>forestresources.committees@odf.oregon.gov</u>) for Emily Gregorio to compile and send to the agency subject matter experts with a following RFPC meeting to discuss.

Forest Practices Technical Guidance Comment Review

- Greg Erb reviewed the Wet Weather guidance document and comments submitted.
- Arden Guinn reviewed the FRIA guidance document for any comments or questions, and then reviewed the pre-inventory document. Arden Guinn documented questions for evaluation and incorporation into the future iteration of the FRIA guidance.
