

# Service Categories and Types of Assistance

When authorizing a service plan in Oregon ACCESS, it's important to look in ONE first to make sure the type of Service Category/Benefit matches the individual's authorized medical program. If the approved benefit doesn't match the authorized medical program, provider payments will not be issued. This guide helps APD/AAA Case Managers identify which service categories correspond with individual medical TOAs in ONE.

OSIPM TOAs should have a corresponding BPA (SPPC), APD, ICP, PACE, or NFC Service Category/Benefit as appropriate to the individual's person-centered service plan. MAGI TOAs should have a BPO (SPPC), KPS, PACE, or NFC Service Category/Benefit. Oregon Project Independence (OPI) cannot co-exist with an OHP Plus benefit.
