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You must provide proof for the type of plate you are requesting.

**Service branch insignia or blank plate (first row of plate options)** - Proof can be:

- Form DD214 or DD215, showing honorable military service
  - The copy with “MEMBER 4” or “SERVICE 2” on the bottom right usually shows your character of service
- WD AGO/Form 53-55 – Enlisted Record and Report of Separation

**Service related medal (second and third row of plate options)** - Proof that you are an honorably discharged veteran and received the medal can be:

- Form DD214 or DD215, showing honorable military service and the awarded medal
  - The copy with “MEMBER 4” or “SERVICE 2” on the bottom right usually shows your character of service
- WD AGO/Form 53-55 – Enlisted Record and Report of Separation, showing the awarded medal
  - A letter, award certificate or other document issued by the US Department of Defense, showing the awarded medal

**US Army Special Forces** - Proof that you are an honorably discharged veteran and Special Forces qualified can be:

- Form DD214 with Special Number/Title box containing SQI identifier “3” in the prefix or suffix; a “5G” or “S,” or a CMF or Functional Area number beginning with “18”
- DD214 recognizing an award of “Special Forces Tab,” or “Special Forces Training” (SFQC)
- DD214 and USAJFKSWCS retroactive award of the Special Forces Qualification Tab

**1st Marine Division** - Proof that you are an honorably discharged veteran or on active duty and a member of, assigned to, attached to, or in support of the 1st Marine Division can be:

- Form DD214, DD215, or Notice of Separation showing service with the 1st Marine Division
- 1st Marine Division Association Member or Life Member card showing your name

**Purple Heart** – Proof that you received the Purple Heart Medal can be:

- U.S. Department of Defense letter listing the Purple Heart Medal
- The Certificate of Purple Heart
- Purple Heart Life Member Card (gold color)
- Form DD214 or DD215
- WD AGO/Form 53-55 – Enlisted Record and Report of Separation
- U.S. Department of Defense Separation Documents (for officers)

**Non-Commissioned Officers Association** – proof can be one of the following:

- For military service year 1950 or after, a DD214 or DD215 that specifies honorable discharge and a rank of E5 to E9; or
- For military service before year 1950, a separation document or form issued by a branch or department of the US Armed Services that specifies honorable discharge and a rank of E5 to E9; or
- A separation document that does not provide a rank of E5 to E9 on the document, and a military ID card or other documentation issued by a branch or department of the US Armed Services that specifies a rank of E5 to E9.

**Vietnam Veterans of America:**

- A DD214 or DD215 that specifies a term of service during the Vietnam era, the period beginning November 1, 1955, and ending on May 7, 1975.
