The LaneACT Bylaws Committee will meet on Wednesday, November 4 from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM. This notice is provided in the interest of transparency, to keep the public informed about LaneACT activities. However, this is not a public meeting and the public is not invited to attend.

Additional information

The LaneACT appointed an Officer Nominating Committee (Committee) on October 9. The Committee is comprised of several members of the LaneACT.

The Committee is an *ad hoc committee* as defined in the LaneACT Bylaws. The Committee will convene for a limited duration for the purpose of recommending candidates to serve as officers for 2025. The Committee's recommendations will be presented to the LaneACT for their consideration on December 13.

The LaneACT is not a legislative body. The LaneACT is one of 12 Area Commissions on Transportation chartered by the Oregon Transportation Commission. An ACT is a voluntary association of government and non-government agencies and individuals with an interest in transportation. ACTs do not have any regulatory, policy, or administrative authority.

The LaneACT is considered a governing body as defined in the Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) and is required to comply with public meetings laws (ORS 192.610 to 192.695). Public notice is provided for all regular LaneACT meetings in compliance with these requirements.

This meeting of the LaneACT Bylaws Committee is not considered a public meeting, as defined in ORS 192.610. The Committee will not be making any decisions or deliberating toward a decision. Their role is limited to developing recommendations for the LaneACT to consider and act on if they choose.
