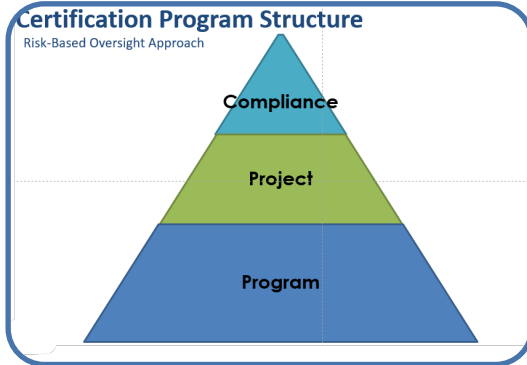

What is the Local Agency Certification Program?



Program

- FHWA approved, state administered, started early 2000s
- **Enables local agencies to deliver federal projects**
- Risk-based oversight by ODOT (key milestones & programs: environmental, ROW, civil rights)



Purpose and objectives

- Delegate **project delivery** and **contracting responsibility** to the lowest practical level
- Provide accountability and assistance
- Streamline administrative costs while maintaining quality

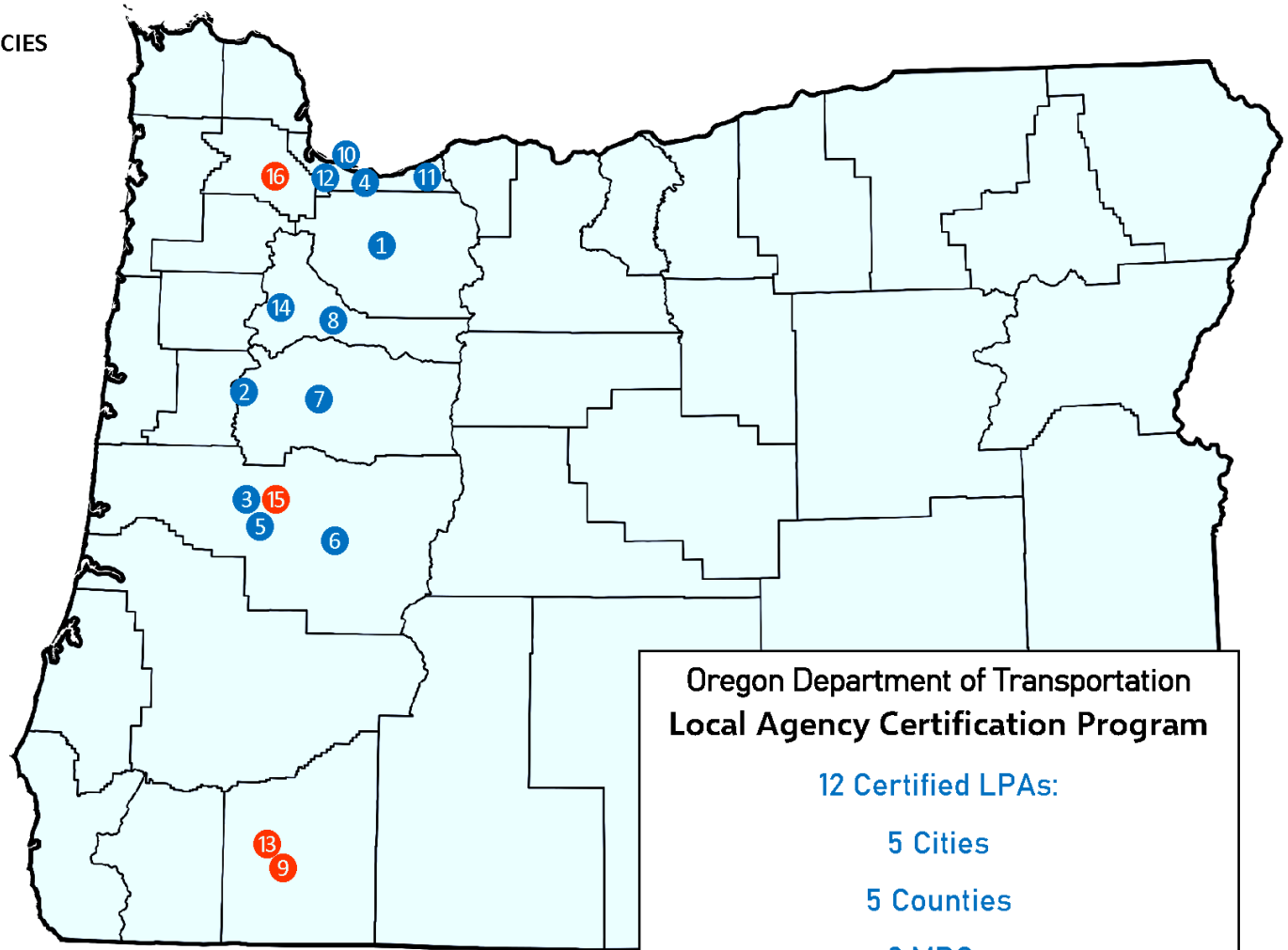

ODLAP: ODOT DELIVERED LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM

**Prior known as
non-certified.**

- Program reinstated in 2021 as a delivery program alongside Certification and ODOT Delivery.
- Does not follow Certification guidance
- Similar but not the same as ODOT delivery
- Addresses delivery by ODOT on behalf of a local agency
- Establishes policy, requirements, and process to be followed (for both inhouse and outsourced delivery)

General Information

ODLAP

- Training to ODOT, consultants, LPA's
- ODLAP Quality Plan
- ODLAP Manual (expected July 2024)
- Invoice ODOT
- ODOT partners with LPA for ODOT to deliver the project on their behalf (ODLAP quality plan)

Cert/ODLAP

- ODOT general guidance and direction for FHWA requirements
- Procurement requirements
- Civil rights requirements
- ODOT Seeks reimbursement of federal funding from FHWA
- LPA/CLPA agreement with ODOT for individual project

CLPA

- Training to CLPAs
- Local Agency Guidelines Manual for Certified LPAs (LAG)
- Invoice CLPA, CLPA seeks federal reimbursement from ODOT
- CLPA delivers w'key approvals from ODOT per approval authority matrix
- Cert Program Agreement & Project Agreement

Procurement (A&E)

ODLAP

- ODOT SOW templates (ODLAP specific)
- ODOT advertisement
- LPA makes final selection of consultant after initial selection by ODOT.

Cert/ODLAP

- ODOT to provide technical advice and support to project teams
- ODOT to provide guidance, direction, procurement templates and requirements for both delivery programs
- Guidance on Civil Rights goals

CLPA

- CLPA SOW templates
- CLPA advertisement
- CLPA makes sole selection of consultant.

Standards

ODLAP

- ADA: Follow ODOT standards, drawings, pertinent to ADA
- LPA above minimum, may require an ODOT design exception depending on circumstance
- ODOT discipline quality plans, noting applicability within ODLAP Quality Plan

Cert/ODLAP

- ODOT facility: ODOT Standards
- Non-ODOT facility: Minimum AASHTO
- Minimum MUTCD with Oregon Supplement
- Environmental prospectus
- Local Agency Technical Scope Sheet

CLPA

- ADA: follow CLPA ADA transition plan
- CLPA standards above minimum
- CLPA quality program plan

PS&E

ODLAP

- ODOT PS&E checklist

Cert/ODLAP

- Utility cert
- ROW Cert
- Rail cert
- ODOT civil rights goals request

CLPA

- CLPA PS&E Checklist

Construction: Ad, Bid, Award

ODLAP

- ODOT advertised
- ODOT bid
- ODOT awarded
- ODOT assess bid
- ODOT may reject bids

Cert/ODLAP

- Follow FHWA requirements
- Follow same general advertisement lengths per FHWA CACC

CLPA

- CLPA advertised
- CLPA bid
- CLPA awarded
- CLPA assess bid, seek ODOT concurrence on rejection of all bids

Contract Administration

ODLAP

- ODOT does all contract administration of A&E contract
- ODOT does all contract admin of construction contract
- ODOT templates and forms

Cert/ODLAP

- ODOT civil rights documentation, guidance, contract provisions*

CLPA

- CLPA admin A&E
- CLPA admin Construction
- Cert. Program or CLPA templates, forms
- *CLPA to enforce civil rights contract provisions with advice/oversight from ODOT civil rights field coordinators
- **CLPA to provide AASHTOWare compatible data

Key considerations

- On an ODLAP project, though the LPA is a consulted team member, ODOT procures and administers the contracts.
- A&E contracts are frequently full-service
- Procurement on OregonBuys
- Direct technical questions to the ODOT project manager
- On a CLPA project, though ODOT is a consulted team member, the CLPA procures and administers the contracts.
- A&E contract scopes vary significantly between CLPAs and project-project.
- Procurement may be on OregonBuys and/or CLPA's website or procurement system
- Consultants and ODOT technical experts should only communicate directly regarding a CLPA project with the CLPA project manager's permission.
