ODLAP Quality Plan

- What is it and why?
- Why should you care?
- Items of note:
 - Standards
 - Roles and responsibilities
 - Required milestones
 - Required deliverables
 - Exceptions to ODOT standards, manuals, quality plans, and processes



Why are projects underfunded or not scoped?

- Cash flow and funded
- Not knowing the federal requirements
- Not understanding how ODOT will deliver a project
- Not knowing the state laws
- Not knowing the difference between federal, state, local laws, and ODOT processes
- Not understanding the STIP, A&E contracts, construction contracts, and agreements and how they interact





ODOT reviews, how to navigate

- ODOT to specify what is wrong per what document
- Opinion or recommendation is not a requirement
- Order of precedence, in general:
 - FHWA and regulatory agencies
 - State
 - ODOT
 - Local
 - And yes, there are always exceptions to the rule

Statewide statement of work

- Will ODLAP use it?
 - NO, ODLAP will have it's own version
- Why?
- What will be different
 - Why?

Conflicts of Interest, Tier 2 selection,

- All contracts for A&E with a local are to be Tier 2
 - ODOT makes initial selection and LPA makes final selection
 - THERE ARE NO MIXED PANELS
 - Yes this applies to A&E planning projects for project development (NOT Transportation system plan development, that's planning not A&E)
- Avoid conflicts of interest:
 - If you do work on a prior part of a project, be open and share all documents, deliverables, and work associated with that prior work
 - Prior work on a project for a local, you can and will be excluded if all documents are not shared with ODOT
