#### **Requested Action:**

Review 2024 Oregon Transportation Commission (OTC) meeting schedule and highlight key items expected in the next six months; discuss items and topics for deeper consideration and discussion, provide feedback on initial draft.

## **Background:**

The Oregon Transportation Commission serves as Oregon's statewide body establishing transportation policy, executing transportation programs and projects, and guiding the planning, development, and management of Oregon's statewide multimodal transportation network. Oregon, and the transportation system on which it relies, is growing and modernizing. As Oregon's transportation system faces structural revenue challenges, increased demand from a growing population, and an increasingly diverse economy, the work of the OTC and Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) in supporting Oregon's economy and communities is critical.

The agency and Commission, along with public and private partners, stakeholders, and communities, are preparing for Oregon's 2025 legislative session in anticipation of an historic transportation funding package. This package may offer durable solutions to the structural revenue challenges Oregon faces in order to provide sufficient and reliable funding for maintenance, operations, and modernization of our aging system.

The OTC's work through 2024 will function as key inputs into a 2025 package, whether through direction, discussion, or decisions on work already underway.

## **Long Term Planning Calendar:**

The long-term planning calendar provides an initial forecast of the major topics, issues, and actions before the Commission through 2024. This forecast will enable informed and strategic sequencing of discussion topics, direction or guidance to the agency, and ultimate decision points. This tool will:

- ensure all OTC commissioners have visibility into upcoming items and ability to obtain foundational or supplemental information in advance.

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- provide a level of transparency and accessibility to stakeholders and members of the public on items or topics under Commission consideration.
- offer intentional opportunities for dialogue on topics of intersection, whether substantively or temporally.
