WESTSIDE MULTIMODAL IMPROVEMENTS STUDY





- ODOT partnered with Metro to convene and chair a Steering Committee
- Evaluated scenarios for ability to address congestion on US26 and related routes
- Westside implementation plan expected first quarter of 2024

I-5 BOONE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



- Project needed to create earthquake readiness, improve safety and multimodal options, and manage traffic bottleneck
- Planning and Environmental Linkage (PEL)
 phase has begun in partnership with FHWA
- Collaboration with 18 federal, state, regional and local agencies
- Connected with the community at a November open house
