

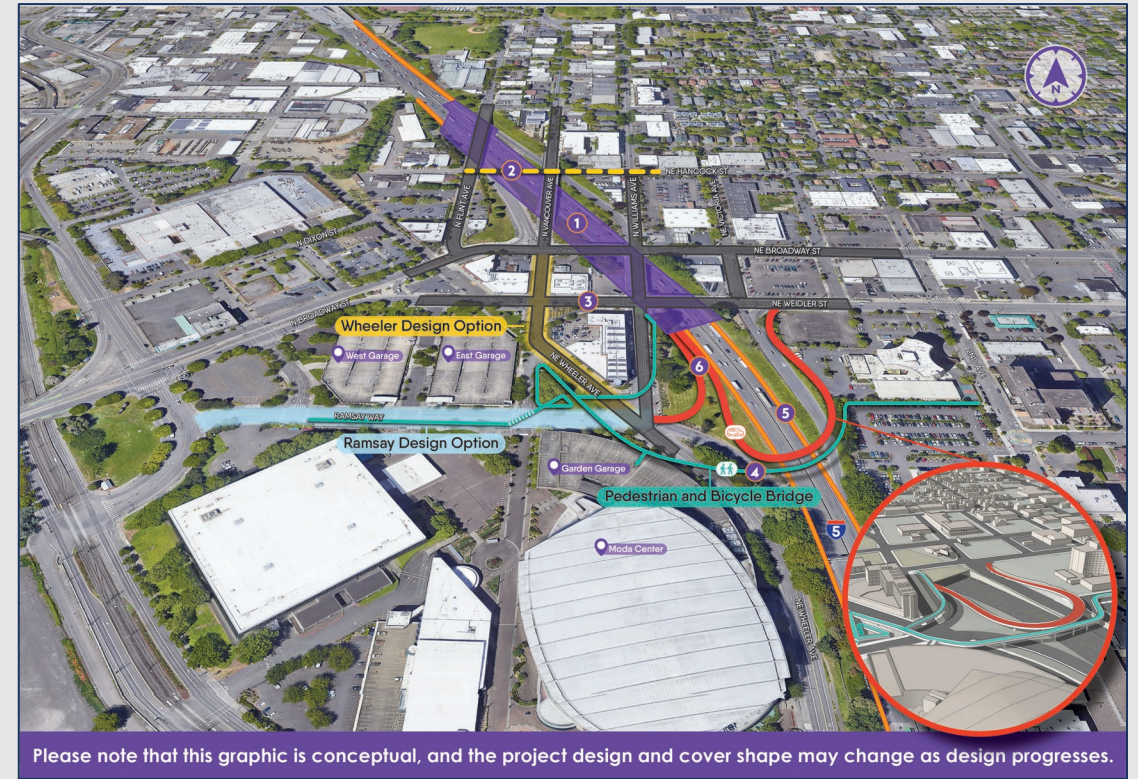

I-5 ROSE QUARTER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

- **\$450 million** awarded from USDOT's Reconnecting Communities and Neighborhoods grant program
 - Finalize design and constructing core portion of highway cover
- Received environmental decision document from the FHWA on March 12
- ODOT remains committed to working with the community and partners to advance Project



RESOLUTION: ODOT AND ALBINA VISION TRUST PARTNERSHIP



RESOLUTION PURPOSE

- To establish and implement a work plan collaboratively with Albina Vision Trust to jointly explore options for the highway cover governance and future ownership of surplus lands associated with the Project
- **Objective:** determine if Albina Vision Trust can have access and rights to 1) future lease(s)/easement(s) for developable air rights on the highway cover; and 2) ownership and development rights for surplus property associated with the Project
 - Under current law and regulation
 - Determine what law and regulatory changes are needed
