

Registration Fee Overview

Every class of vehicle within the state’s efficiency-based structure is subject to a supplemental registration fee for each year of the registration period, on top of a base registration fee of \$43 per year for all passenger vehicles:

- For vehicles that have a rating of 0-19 MPG: \$20
- For vehicles that have a rating of 20-39 MPG: \$25
- For vehicles that have a rating of 40 MPG or greater: \$35
- For electric vehicles: \$115
