The City of Roseburg and the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) are working together to plan for community travel needs for three Roseburg areas:

- Interstate – 5, Exit 124.
- Interstate – 5, Exit 125.
- Garden Valley Boulevard.

For the I-5 exits, an Interchange Area Management Plan (IAMP) will outline a 20-year vision for access and roadway improvements to protect the function and operations of the interchanges. The Garden Valley Corridor Plan (GVCP) will identify strategies for the City to improve safety, mobility and connectivity so the corridor better serves our community's needs now and into the future.

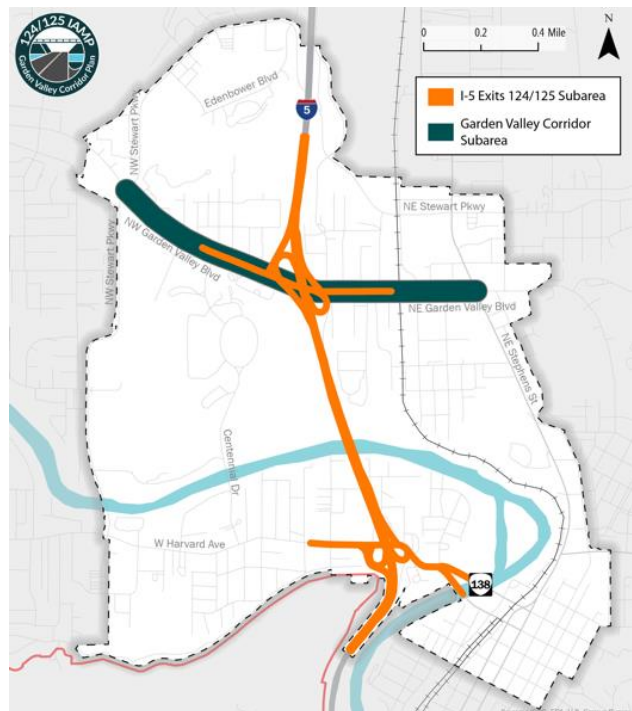
Together, these plans will develop a set of transportation solutions and land use policy actions needed to prepare for, balance and manage transportation and land use needs over time.
