


How to log in to SGMS using single sign-on

- 1) Go to https://odot.smartsimple.com/s_Login.jsp
- 2) You might be wondering what is the “SSO Login” link below the Email and Password fields? Single sign-on (SSO) in Azure Active Directory (Azure AD) is an authentication feature that allows users to log in to multiple applications using a single ID and password. SSO with Azure AD works by delegating authentication to Azure AD, which verifies a user's credentials. Once you have logged in once, you should be able to click the “SSO Login” link and it will log you into the system without having to enter your Email and Password.
