The location where all coordination is managed between all participating agency control, simulation, and evaluation.

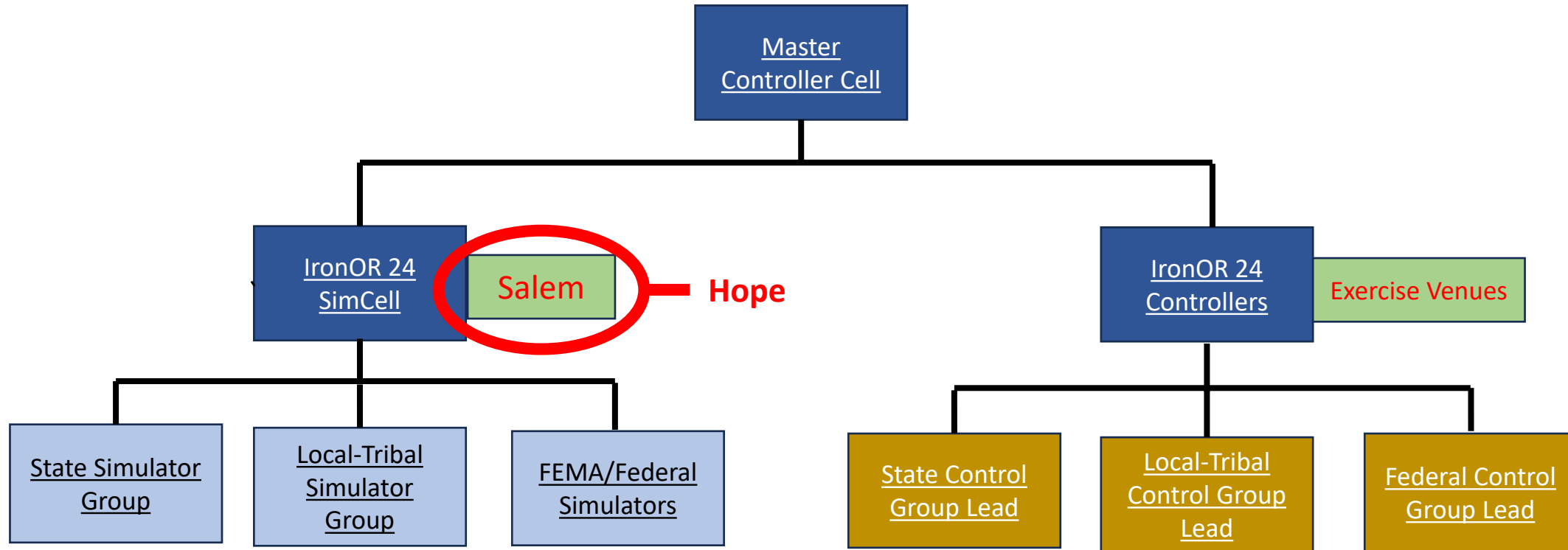

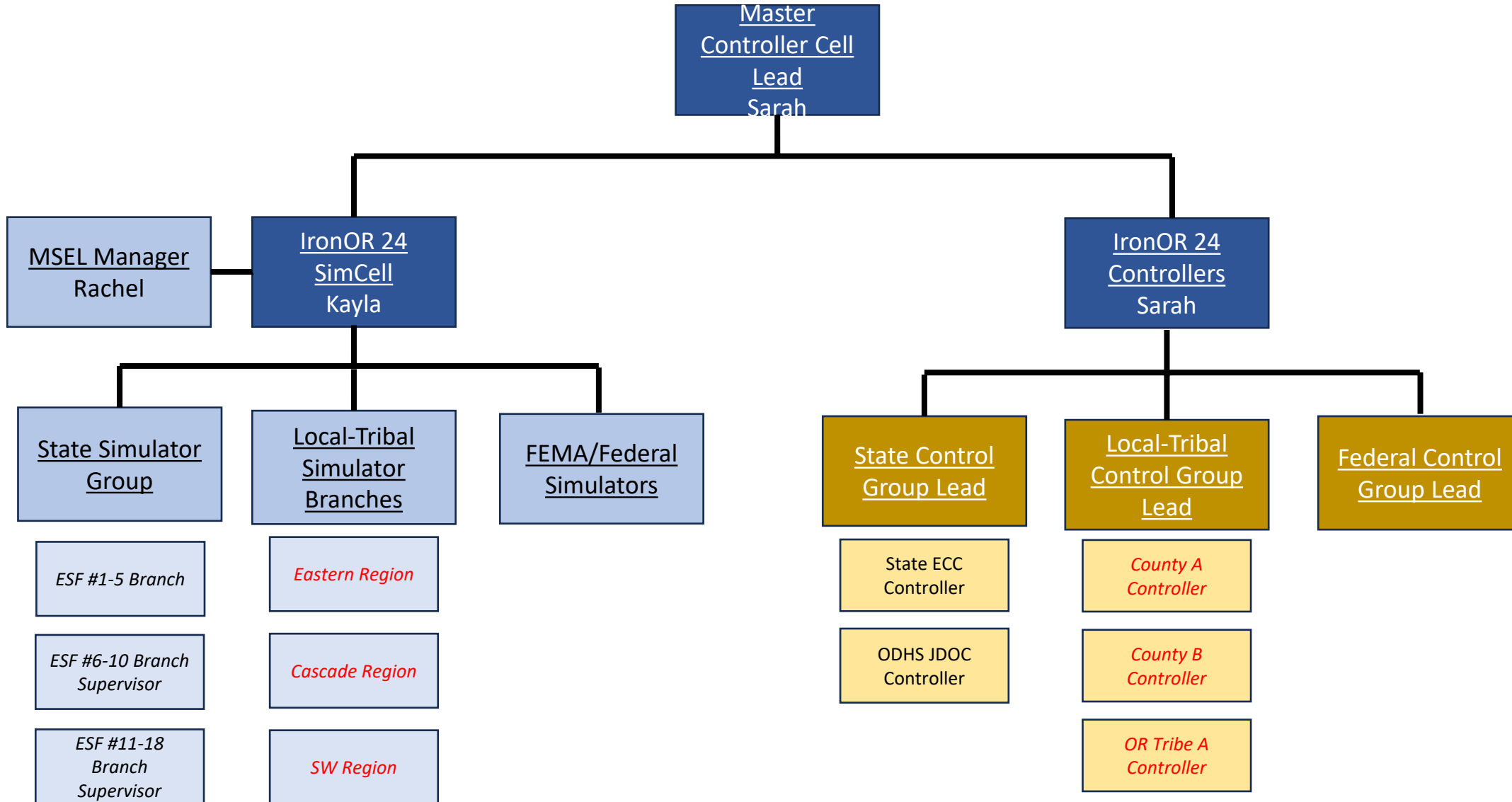
The location where all coordination is managed between venue control cells, simulation cells, and other control areas.

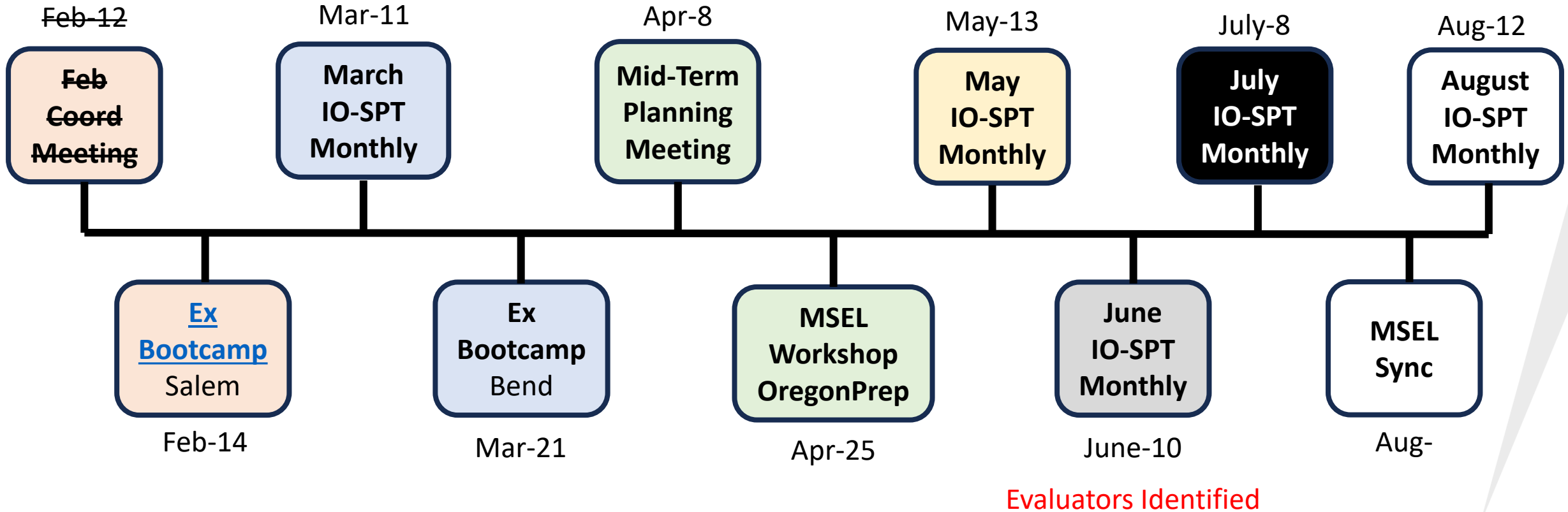
