## PURPOSE

The Integrated Preparedness Plan (IPP) documents the planning, organizational, equipment, training and exercise (POETE) priorities for a multi-year period – this version outlines priorities over a three-year period from July 2023 through June 2026. This product is a living document, updated and refined annually via regional, state government, and internal Oregon Department of Emergency Management (OEM) Integrated Preparedness Planning Workshops (IPPWs).

The priorities identified in this document are separated by core capabilities and derived from analysis of existing strategic guidance, threat assessments, and previous exercise and incident corrective action findings. A progressive, multi-year program enables organizations and jurisdictions to develop planning documentation related to the priority areas, train personnel on its content, and exercise those documents to validate and/or implement the product in a no-fault environment. There is no one set of preparedness priorities that will support the needs of every community in Oregon, the statewide priorities are broad enough to allow all jurisdictions and state agencies to plan activities that align with their individual priorities and requirements as well as support the priorities of the state.

The IPP combines POETE activities that develop or maintain capabilities in support of the established priorities. These activities were identified and confirmed in regional, state government, and internal Oregon Department of Emergency Management IPPWs. Local and tribal emergency management agencies, as well as all state agencies identified in the state's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP), were invited to participate in and provide their perspective and inputs during the IPPWs.

Included in this IPP is a schedule, which provides a graphic illustration of the proposed activities for the identified priorities, scheduled for July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2026.

### 2024 Update Process – V1.2

The Oregon Department of Emergency Management engaged statewide City, County, Tribal, and State Department partners in the 2024 Annual Update Process to receive updated data regarding their planning, training, and exercise activities for the remaining period of the IPP to ensure this update best reflects the preparedness activities occurring across the state of Oregon.

The IPP Update Process is outlined in detail below:

- A. **Organizational-Jurisdictional IPP Development:** The 2024 process will support partners developing their own IPP products to help inform future decision-making and actively participate in the State IPP process. The more organizations and jurisdictions that have active IPP products, the easier it will be to develop a collaborative IPP product during both annual update and multi-year development processes.
- B. **Improved Statewide Forecast Awareness:** The 2024 process will build an improved statewide awareness to the ongoing planning, training, and exercise processes and events for the next 12-24 months through the revision of data and/or information. Through item "A" above, and a general revision of the 2024 IPP product, statewide partners will collectively have an improved awareness of what activities are up ahead.

- C. **Inform Local and State Needs:** This process will review the submitted Core Capability Assessment data and the updated forecast schedules to inform local and statewide needs within the areas of planning activities, training, and exercise. The forecast schedule will share what is already being planned, the 2024 process will also identify the needs locally and statewide to meet the existing priorities listed in the 2024 State of Oregon IPP.

Statewide partners will use the final two years of the 2024 State of Oregon IPP to develop and implement identified IPP products. Oregon will enter a more informed and collaborative process in 2026 to create Version 2 of the State of Oregon IPP (July 1, 2026-June 30, 2029).

#### Phase 1 | Data Request & Development (December 2023 – February 2024)

OEM distributed materials to support partners update or develop forecast(s) and provide awareness to the 2024 IPP process. The development of a local, tribal, or organizational IPP includes engagement from critical internal and external partners that influence the 1-3 year forecast.

1. **IPP Process Awareness Notice | December:** OEM distributed a notice to all IPP participants in early December 2023 to share specific process schedule, requests, and expectations.
2. **[IPP Educational Session](#) | January 30<sup>th</sup>:** OEM hosted a 90-minute education seminar that provided guidance and resources to support internal IPP updates or development. The educational seminar was hosted virtually and recorded.
3. **IPP Data Request | January:** OEM requested preparedness activity data in preparation of the regional and state IPPWs. The following data points were requested:
  - a. **Planning Activities:** A 1-3 year forecast of the intended development of or updates to plans, processes, procedures, and policies. Participants were asked to consider current and expected grant projects that include planning, training, or exercise events during this step.
  - b. **Special Events:** Special events that may require build-up planning, training, or exercise activities.
  - c. **Training Events:** Planned trainings based on the planning activities and special events identified. Consider trainings hosted by local and regional jurisdictional partners. And,

d. Exercise Events: Planned exercises based on the planning activities and special events identified.

4. **OEM Data Collation | February-March**: OEM collated and presented the data at the regional and state IPPWs.

**Phase 2 | Regional & State Integrated Preparedness Planning Workshops (IPPWs) (February-March 2024)**

The regional and state government IPPWs built off the Phase 1 data request and development to present the findings to workshop participants.

- Intended Audience: Primary audience for the regional IPPWs were County and Tribal emergency management agencies, additional key stakeholders were invited upon request by the emergency managers. The primary audience for the State IPPW were member agencies of the Oregon Emergency Response System (OERS) Council.

**Phase 3 | Data Collation & IPP Draft (March-April 2024)**

OEM developed a draft 2024 State of Oregon IPP Version 1.2 (V1.2), shared virtually with all IPP participants at the Statewide IPPW.

**Phase 4 | Draft Statewide IPPW & IPP Finalization (June 11<sup>th</sup>)**

OEM hosted a 2-hour Statewide IPPW to formally present the draft IPP V1.2 to all IPP participants to confirm:

- Identified statewide priorities,
- State-level planning activities and special event planning expectations,
- Training vision and requests, and
- State-level exercise expectations.

## Phase 5 | IPP Rollout & 2025 Vision (June 2024)

OEM distributed the IPP V1.2 to all local, tribal, state, and federal partners.

### 2025 Update Process Overview – V1.3

The 2025 IPP Update Process will develop V1.3 and will follow a similar phased approach to 2024. The priority areas for 2025 are outlined below and intended to progress the IPP effort in preparation for the 2026 full revision and development of Version 2 (July 1, 2026-June 30, 2029).

- A. Using the 2024 Data:** The data collected for V1.2 in 2024 offers a roadmap for preparedness activities taking place in the coming 12-24 months but is likely to change. OEM will facilitate regular opportunities to check-in on upcoming activities and revise the existing data to provide more in-depth discussions about needs and gaps during Phase 3 IPPWs. These regular opportunities include:
  - Quarterly Check-Ins with local-tribal partners and their OEM Regional Coordinator during routine regional meetings, and
  - Quarterly Check-ins during OERS Council Meeting.
- B. Organizational-Jurisdictional IPPW Support:** The 2025 process will increase the support offered to local and tribal partners in hosting jurisdictional IPPWs by offering more direct technical assistance, early capability strength and gap analysis, and identifying community-specific needs. The more organizations and jurisdictions that host an IPPW, the more effective the regional IPPWs. This effort will provide additional guidance and direct support to County and Tribal Emergency Management agencies.
- C. Improved Use of Data & Existing Preparedness Activities:** Using the 2024 IPP Update Process as a foundation, the 2025 process will seek to expand the use of risk assessment data to encourage and inform the preparedness activities planned in jurisdictions. This process will utilize the existing preparedness activities submitted in 2024 to inform the subsequent training and exercise activities to implement those efforts.

# PREPAREDNESS ACTIVITY CONSIDERATIONS

## Threats, Hazards and Risks

Oregon faces several threats, hazards and risks, as listed in the Hazard Categories section in the State of Oregon Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) on pages 16 and 17. The primary threats, hazards and risks that informed the preparedness priorities were the capabilities compared to either a Cascadia Subduction Zone earthquake and tsunami, cyber-attack or explosive devices incident.

## Capability Assessments

The State of the State Capability Assessment is an annual assessment of Oregon counties, select cities, tribal partners and state agencies. Information collected in this assessment is used to identify the progress of emergency management initiatives and support prioritization of future Planning, Organization, Equipment, Training and Exercise (POETE) efforts. This data is also used to inform the annual Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA) and Stakeholder Preparedness Review (SPR) update to FEMA.

The capabilities are assessed through five categories: Planning, Organization, Equipment, Training and Exercise (POETE) for capability lost, sustained or built, and to determine if an overall gap remained in the core capability. Overall gaps indicate that despite efforts and resources, there's still a challenge in fully performing the core capability as needed based on Oregon's potential threats and hazards. Following the identification of gaps, strategies to address those gaps were identified. Core capabilities are further broken down into their component functional areas and ranked within the POETE to highlight which areas had the highest and lowest capacity. Functional area rankings were based on a 0-5 scale rubric, with 0 indicating no capacity and 5 indicating the highest capacity. Core capabilities rated as high by a majority of respondents were selected as the high priorities overall for Oregon. Medium- and low-priority capabilities were similarly selected.

The compiled and analyzed data from the Capability Assessment is used to create the annual State of the State Report. Based on the State of the State Report, THIRA/SPR and the National Exercise Program Priorities, the top eight priorities with gaps were chosen to focus on during this IPP cycle.

Continuity of Operations is a functional area within the Planning core capability identified as a top priority by many local, tribal and state information gathered through the IPPW process.

## Continuity of Operations

Continuity of Operations is the ability to provide uninterrupted critical services, essential functions and support – while maintaining organizational viability – before, during and after an event that disrupts normal operations.

Fire Management and Suppression provides structural, wildland, and specialized firefighting capabilities to manage and suppress fires of all types, kinds, and complexities while protecting the lives, property, and the environment in the affected area. Due to fire management and suppression being carried out by local fire agencies independently of local emergency managers, much of the ongoing efforts across the state are not effectively captured by this document.

Ensure the capacity for timely communications in support of security, situational awareness, and operations by all means available, among and between affected communities in the impact area and all response forces.

## **PROGRAM REPORTING**

The Oregon Department of Emergency Management submits annual reports to FEMA as a recipient of federal preparedness grant funds. The THIRA/SPR and Integrated Preparedness Plan are all required. Through these processes, OEM confirms if capability gaps are closing by completing preparedness activities and therefore improving Oregon's overall preparedness and resilience in support of the National Preparedness Goal. To support these reporting requirements and goal, grant-funded jurisdictions report planning, training and exercise activities that occur.

In 2022, House Bill 4068 passed in Oregon Legislature amending ORS 401 to including additional exercise conduct and reporting requirements for OEM and state agencies. Each state agency will conduct an internal exercise that tests at least one element of the state agency's emergency preparedness and submit a written report to OEM via the [Emergency Management Exercise Reporting \(EMER\)](#) tool. These reports provide a snapshot of work accomplished but may not indicate the ultimate closing of a gap. All the reports are collected and aggregated in the State of the State capability assessment to highlight trends statewide and identify gaps and opportunities for future improvement.

## **DOCUMENT MAINTENANCE**

This product is a living document updated and refined annually by the OEM Preparedness Section via regional, state government, and internal Oregon Department of Emergency Management Integrated Preparedness Planning Workshops (IPPWs).

## **MULTI-YEAR SCHEDULE OF PREPAREDNESS ACTIVITIES**

The multi-year schedule of preparedness activities is listed by planning, training and exercise activity. It is then subdivided by Tribes, Counties, and State of Oregon Departments, any entities existing within a county geographically are represented under that county. The schedule indicates the core capability for each activity and type for exercises. The first 12 months of the schedule are broken down by month, then by quarter as further out activities are still in the planning stages.
