SUBJECT: HB 4106 – Report on Rulemaking for 2024

House Bill 4106 (2016) asks state agencies to report to the Legislative Assembly on their rulemaking activity each year.

In accordance with the procedures in ORS 183.333, ORS 183.335(2), and ORS 183.335(3), the Oregon Government Ethics Commission processed two rulemaking actions in 2024, adopting or amending 16 rules. The table below details those rules.
