My name is Craig Morris and I am writing to respectfully request a waiver of my \$120.00 in accrued penalties as the registered Client/Employer for Southern Oregon University ("SOU") at the time the Q1 expenditure report was due. While I temporarily assisted Southern Oregon University as a Client/Employer with respect to SOU's lobbying activities, Julie McFadden was hired to fill that role in January 2017. Our late filings were attributable to an honest misunderstanding of the transition of those responsibilities.

In addition, I mistakenly understood the notices I received to be referring to my obligation to file my Statement of Economic Interests, which I submitted prior to the deadline. 

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this stipulated final order is to settle any and all claims, allegations and charges by the Oregon Government Ethics Commission (Commission) against Roger Thompson.
- JURISDICTION: At all material times, Roger Thompson was a Port Commissioner for the Port of Brookings Harbor. Roger Thompson was a public official subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to ORS Chapter 244.

3. STIPULATED FACTS:

- A. On 7/7/15, Roger Thompson, acting in his official capacity as a Port Commissioner, attended an executive session meeting of the governing body of the Port of Brookings Harbor. During this executive session, Mr. Thompson offered to purchase two recently vacated buildings located on Port property.
- B. ORS 244.040(1) prohibits any public official from using or attempting to use their official position or office to obtain financial gain for themselves, their relative or household member, or any business with which they are associated.

- C. The action described in paragraph A above constituted one (1) violation of ORS 244.040(1).
- D. ORS 244.050(1)(s) requires Port Commissioners to file an annual verified Statement of Economic Interest (SEI) each April 15, in which they disclose their financial interests from the prior calendar year. Roger Thompson timely filed his 2016 and 2017 SEIs, but failed to disclose the name of a business under which his household member did business, as required by ORS 244.060(2).
- E. Roger Thompson amended his 2016 and 2017 SEIs on 11/21/17 to include the business name under which his then-household member did business.
- F. The actions described in paragraph D above constituted two violations of ORS 244.060(2).
- G. ORS 244.350 authorizes the Commission to assess civil penalties of up to \$5,000 for each violation.
- H. The results of the Commission investigation, if submitted through exhibits and testimony at a contested case hearing, would establish a preponderance of evidence in support of a post-hearing order to find 1 violation of ORS 244.040(1) and 2 violations of ORS 244.060(2).

4. <u>TERMS OF SETTLEMENT</u>:

The parties agree as follows:

A. On 11/17/17, the Commission acted to find violation, bring the investigative phase to a close and move to a negotiated settlement or a contested case

hearing. The 11/17/17 action was a preliminary finding of violations of Oregon Government Ethics law, as a prelude to a stipulated settlement or a contested case hearing, and not a final conclusion regarding a violation of Oregon Government Ethics law by Roger Thompson.

- B. In lieu of a civil penalty, as authorized by ORS 244.350, Mr. Thompson will receive a letter of education to settle and compromise this matter.
- C. The Commission releases, settles and compromises any and all claims, which have been or could be asserted against Roger Thompson within the scope of the above-referenced proceedings.
- D. Roger Thompson will initiate no claims, litigation or other action against the Commission as a result of these proceedings.

5. REVIEW BY COUNSEL:

All of the parties hereto acknowledge that this agreement has been entered into by their own free will and with full understanding of the contents herein. Each of the parties further acknowledges that each has had the opportunity to seek the advice of counsel in comparing and reviewing this agreement.

6. <u>EFFECT</u>:

This agreement is subject to the final approval of the Commission. Once approved, this agreement shall be the final disposition of the matter and shall be binding upon all parties.

By signing this agreement, Roger Thompson agrees to waive his right to a contested case hearing as provided in ORS Chapter 183 and ORS 244.370. This order shall be the final order and all information in the Commission files on this

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matter shall become part of the record.

By signing this agreement, Roger Thompson agrees to waive his right to obtain judicial review of this order as provided in ORS 183.482.
