<input type="checkbox"/>	A copy of a valid driver's license, passport or other valid government issued identification. <i>(Must be at least 18 years of age)</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Current RID ( <a href="#">Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf</a> ) <b>Certification</b> (National Interpreter Certification [NIC] or Certified Deaf Interpreter Certification [CDI])
<input type="checkbox"/>	Include proof of passing a Sign Language proficiency exam, such as the American Sign Language Proficiency Interview or SLPI:ASL. <a href="#">For more information see Oregon Qualification and Certification for Sign Language Interpreters</a>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of high school <a href="#">diploma</a> (or GED equivalent) or higher.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of not being on the Medicaid exclusion list <a href="http://exclusions.oig.hhs.gov/">http://exclusions.oig.hhs.gov/</a>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Note:</b> By first renewal, qualified Sign Language interpreters must complete a <a href="#">60-hour OHA approved health care interpreter training program</a> , along with other 24 hours of CEUs <a href="#">renewing requirements</a> .
