<input type="checkbox"/>	Current RID (Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf) Certification (National Interpreter Certification [NIC] or Certified Deaf Interpreter Certification [CDI])
<input type="checkbox"/>	6 hours of interpretation skills
<input type="checkbox"/>	6 hours of health care interpreter ethics
<input type="checkbox"/>	12 hours that cover any topics accepted for continuing education by interpreter certification testing centers.
<input type="checkbox"/>	If you have not already submitted proof of passing a Sign Language proficiency exam, such as the American Sign Language Proficiency Interview or SLPI:ASL, please include that with your renewal application.
