Renewing HCI Qualified - Sign Language Application Checklist

Renewing Qualified Sign Language HCIs must complete 24 hours of OHA approved continuing education (CEU) (OAR 950-050-0090) during the 4-year credential period.

Please use this checklist to assist you with your application. Include all documents with your HCI application.

Note: See the <u>OHA Health Licensing Office</u> for Sign Language Interpreter **license** requirements.

	A copy of a valid driver's license, passport or other valid government issued identification. (<i>Must be at least 18 years of age</i>)
	Current RID (Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf) Certification (National Interpreter Certification [NIC] or Certified Deaf Interpreter Certification [CDI])
	If you have not already submitted proof of passing a Sign Language proficiency exam, such as the American Sign Language Proficiency Interview or SLPI:ASL, please include that with your renewal application. For more information see Oregon Qualification and Certification for Sign Language Interpreters.
	 24 hours of CEUs 6 hours of health care interpreter ethics 6 hours of interpretation skills 12 hours that cover any topics accepted for continuing education by interpreter certification testing centers.
	Note: By first renewal, qualified Sign Language interpreters must complete a 60-hour OHA approved health care interpreter training program. Include training certificate.
