

Public-Facing REALD & SOGI Survey Tool

The Public Facing Survey Tool (PFST) is a secure, web-based form that allows patients to enter their REALD & SOGI data for automatic reporting to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). It was designed to help providers without EHRs that can be configured for REALD & SOGI questions to fulfil their requirement to ask REALD & SOGI of their patients.

How it works

- Participating providers have a customized survey link and QR code specific to their facility.
- Recommended: Provider team loads the Public-Facing REALD & SOGI Survey Tool onto a smart device (i.e., tablet), refreshed for each new person.
- People using a desktop or smart device connected to the Internet can access the survey tool to self-report using the link or QR code.
- REALD & SOGI data collected using this tool are then reported to OHA; this removes the need for provider teams to submit data.

How to get started

Getting started is easy; email the <u>REALD & SOGI</u>
