Introduction

Oregon Health Authority, Health Workforce Registry Applicant Portal is an efficient platform for applicants to apply, track, and manage certification for Traditional Health Workers and credentialing for Health Care Interpreters.

You can now create a new or renewal Traditional Health Worker application using this portal.

Both Traditional Health Workers and Health Care Interpreters can view and update their

Complete a new or recertification application in registry



OHA THW Staff reviews application for completeness and submits a background check request to ORCHARDS BCU



ORCHARDS BCU emails applicant information to give consent



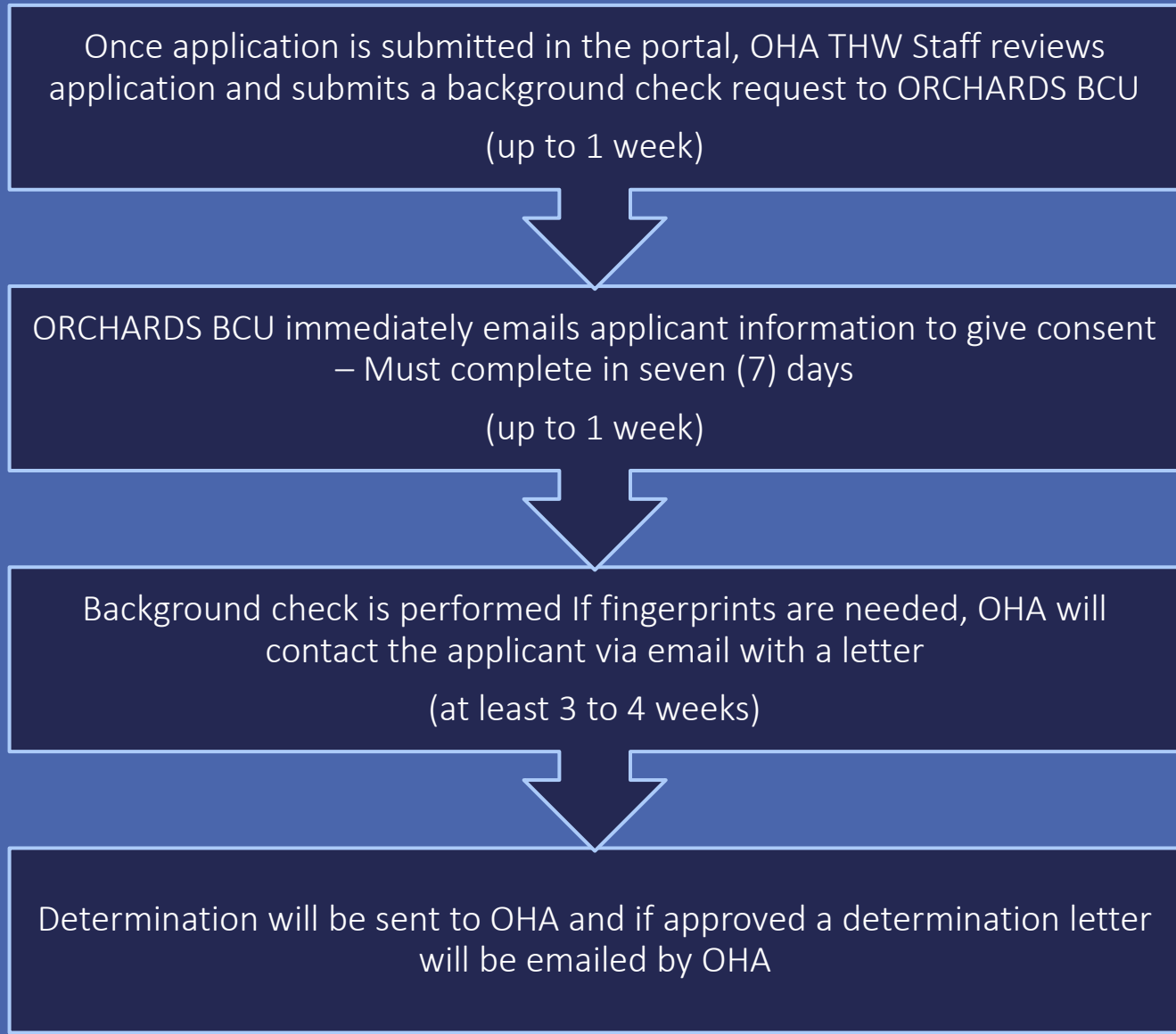
Background check is performed (If fingerprints are needed, OHA THW staff will email fingerprint letter)

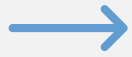


Determination will be sent to OHA THW Staff and they will email a determination letter to applicant

Steps in the Application Process

Estimated Timeline (total 4 to 6 weeks)





You only have SEVEN (7) days to log in to the ORCHARDS BCU applicant portal and give your consent to run your background check



Not everyone will need to get fingerprinted

If you are asked to get fingerprints, you have SEVEN (7) days from letter date to get your fingerprints taken



Check your junk/spam folders! ORCHARDS BCU and OHA THW emails often get sent there



Applications in English need to be entered in the portal. All applications in other languages can still be emailed to the thw.program@odhsoha.oregon.gov email address

Need to Know

Reminders

1. Recertification applications require the completion of:
 - The Continuing Education Requirements for each worker type
 - 1.5 hours of OHA Approved Oral Health Training
 - Three (3) hours of OHA Approved Suicide Prevention Training
 - If certification has lapsed more than 6 months, you can a complete competency skills test
2. You cannot use CEUs for more than one worker type
 - The exception is the oral health training and suicide prevention training

Other Important Information...

OHA THW Program

- Does not process background checks nor appeals
- Has no access to background check results
- Cannot submit consent for you

BCU ORCHARDS

- Is a separate division – shared services between agencies
- Has separate portal
- Processes background check appeals

Tips

Use a computer or a laptop to give consent if it is not working on your phone

Submitting the “weigh-test” documents during the background consent process is the most favorable for a quicker background check turnaround

If additional supplemental documents are needed by ORCHARDS BCU, you can send to the thw.program@odhsoha.oregon.gov email address and staff are able to upload for you

Don't forget to include your Oral Health Certificate with the hours indicated. Make sure it has your name on it.
