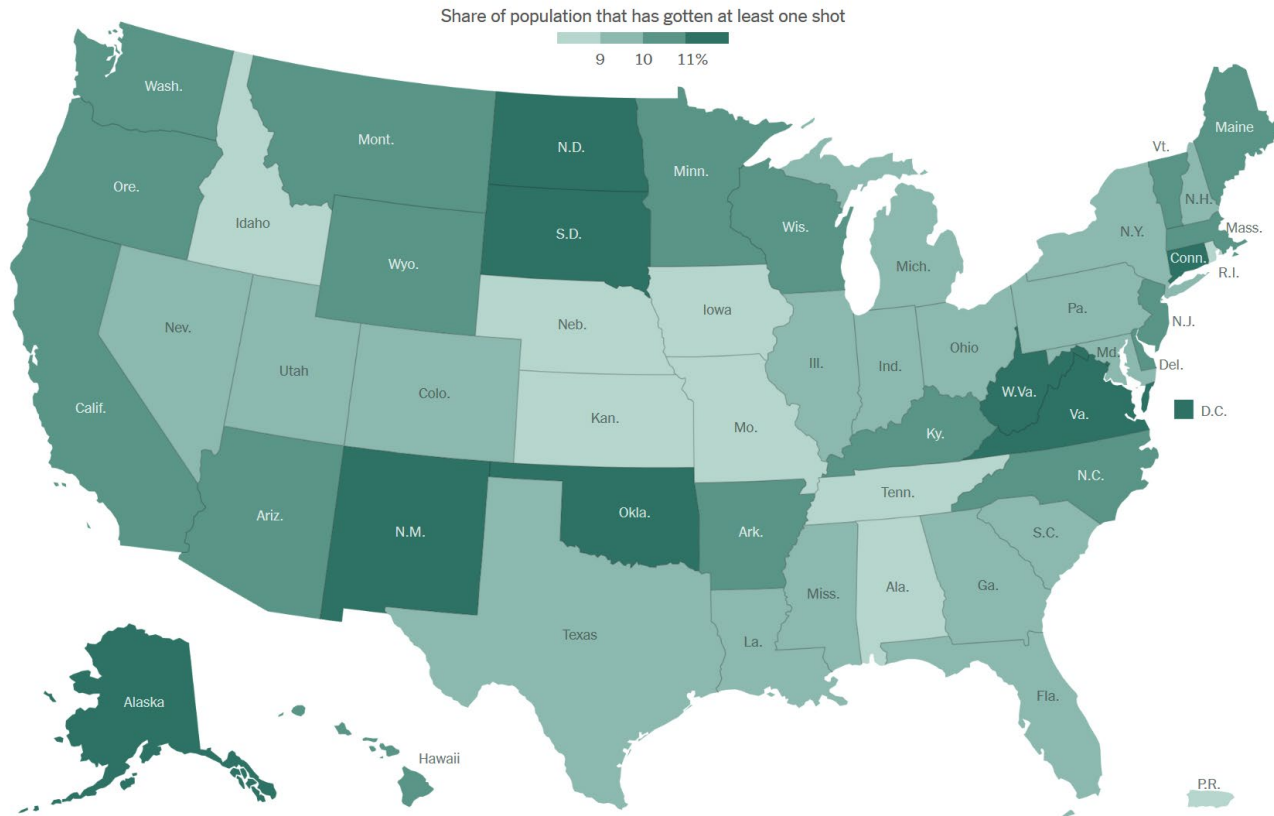

Oregon is tied for 17th in nation for population vaccination.*

- 10% of the total population is vaccinated.

Oregon administered first doses to approximately 70 percent of current eligibles.

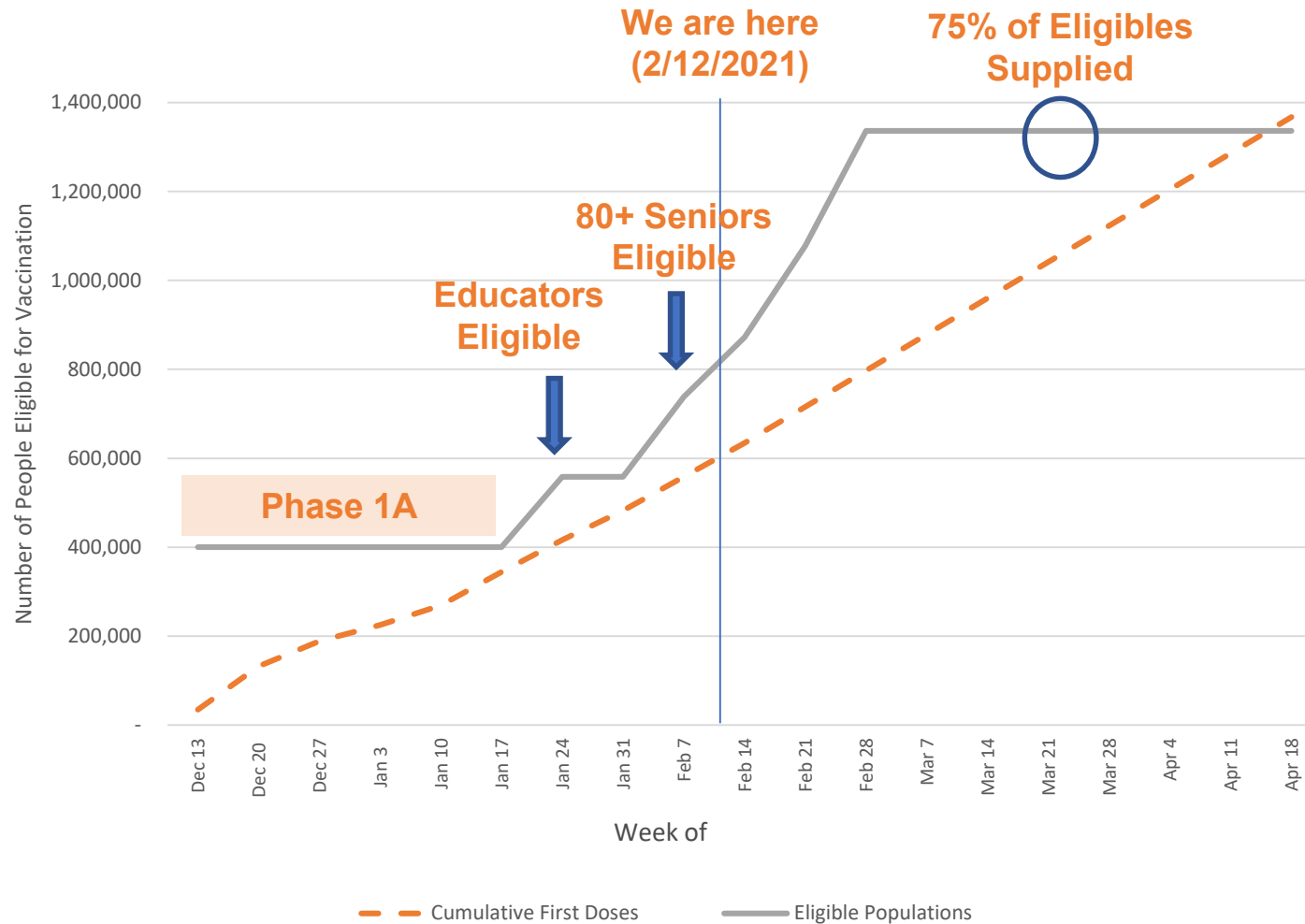
- Oregon has administered approximately 44,000 doses to people 80+ (26 percent).
