- Provide TA to systems of care and providers to support teledentistry



Optimize Use Of Existing Clinical Infrastructure

- Identify opportunities to advance oral health activities at School-based Health Centers
- Collaborate with CCOs and DCOs providing care at SBHCs
- Increase participation in school oral health and dental sealant programs
- Provide resources to support closed-loop referrals
- Support development of CDT codes for oral health provider HbA1c testing and vaccination; improve reimbursement, training issues for dentists
