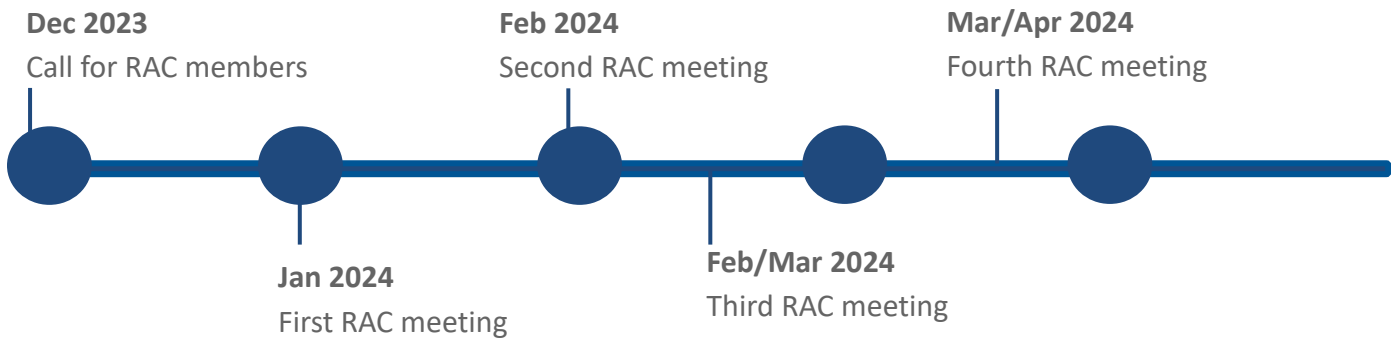


Join the Rules Advisory Committee
