- Welcome, review agenda and community agreements
- Roll call completed; quorum established, feedback received on minutes, not approved and will need to include the wording of the recommendation.
- New members introduced
- Public comment period; no public comment received.
- OHA updates include POP 505 and work sessions
- Recommendations reviewed:
 - Provide funding for graduate students to assist with costs of behavioral health education, internships at Community Mental Health Programs (CMHPs) and Certificate of Approval (COA) organizations, BH license/certification preparation and exams, and other costs.

Discussion, clarification that the wording is not finalized and all recommendations will be viewed in their entirety before submitting to legislature. Soft poll, vote, pass.

- · Change the narrative of CMHPs as workplace options by investing in:
 - Marketing/promotion, community engagement
 - Honoring for expertise of complex cases
 - •Benefits of Team Based Care
 - •Support from multiple disciplines, resources, and collaborate with different county/local departments, etc.
 - Training opportunities
 - Leadership support
 - Career pathway/advancements
 - Incentives

Soft poll, move to discussion. Vagueness, have been doing this work at local level, what would be different? Basis of CMHP recruitment at the state level, aligning and incorporating CMHP work to date in collaboration with OHA. Marketing campaign and funding caveats. OHA centralized campaign proposed. Soft poll, vote, recommendation passes with inclusion of OHA to lead statewide marketing campaign.

- Funding for organizations to propose paid internship programs including precredential interns, internship/staff management, internship administrative costs, and clinical supervision for rural, community based, COAs, and CMHPs.
 Soft poll, vote, pass.
- Ongoing funding for Tuition Assistance pursuing degrees or certifications related to work or future work at CMHPs or COAs, prioritizing masters level degrees. Soft poll, move to discussion. Clarification: this would be funding going to CMHPs/COAs, not the educating authority. Upfront, not loan forgiveness, and comes with a work obligation/service commitment to stay with the funding organization for two years after degree completion. Clarification of "work or future work", future work could include a case manager that wants to become a therapist, or an employee within the organization getting certified for different roles. Career advancement, if a service commitment/administrative procedure, certain employers wouldn't be able to use funds if a length is determined. Flexibility on service commitment, as certain bills can have very prescriptive funding and organizations that are intended to be funded cannot comply with funding as prescribed. Inclusion of integrated health settings and

FQHCs to become a BH provider as a career pathway. Original recommendation included a maximum limit for employee tax implications. Certain organizations leave it to the employee as an informed choice.

Soft poll, vote, inclusion of designated health shortage areas if including rural, pass.

 Invest in Career and Technical Education (CTE) BH pathway for Oregon High School students.

Soft poll, vote. At the time of vote, the tally keeper confused the soft polling (65-80%) and voting (majority passes) requirements. According to the recording, the recommendation did not pass, but upon reviewing, the recommendation does pass.
