The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is seeking applicants for the Mobile Health Advisory Committee (MHAC), established under House Bill 4052, which allocates grant funds to develop a mobile health unit pilot program. These units are designed to reduce health inequities and address racism as a public health crisis in Oregon.

What is the MHAC?

The MHAC will continue to guide the development of mobile health units that provide culturally responsive and accessible care to priority populations, including those most impacted by systemic racism.

Who Should Apply?

We encourage individuals with lived or professional experience addressing health inequities caused by racism to apply. This includes members of communities of color, LGBTQIA+, immigrant, refugee, and rural or low-income communities.
