Subject: July 1, 2024 fee-for-service rate increase for Medicaid behavioral health services completed

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has updated its fee-for-service claim system to reflect the new reimbursement rates effective July 1, 2024 and completed the following actions:

- Posted communications to the <u>Behavioral Health Rate Increase page</u>.
- Posted the July 1, 2024 <u>Behavioral Health Fee Schedule</u>.
- Adjusted rates for adult mental health residential billing codes T1020 and T2033.

Why is this happening?

OHA is sending this communication to confirm systems work to apply the increase is complete, as explained in OHA's <u>June 12, 2024 memo</u>.

What should you do?

Adult mental health residential providers: Submit all claims for services rendered on or after July 1, 2024, at the higher rate as noted on each resident's plan of care.

Other behavioral health providers: Bill new claims at the higher amount listed in July 2024 Behavioral Health Fee Schedule.
