Subject: Oregon Health Plan coverage of travel and nonroutine vaccines

This communication is to clarify Oregon Health Plan (OHP) coverage of travel and nonroutine vaccines. The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is aware that its <u>August 15, 2023</u>, memo to CCOs has resulted in some confusion about this coverage.

OHP covers the travel and nonroutine vaccines listed below for both adults and children as indicated per each vaccine license and recommended by the <u>Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP)</u>. For children, these are managed like adult vaccines and not through the Vaccines for Children program. Please note that the Chikungunya vaccine is new to the list.

- Assessing your Provider Network. Make changes if needed to ensure appropriate access to these services. Pay special attention to travel vaccine providers.

Please communicate this coverage change to:

- Providers who render or refer for these services.
- Members as appropriate. Update member-facing information to include this new coverage.
