	Document includes <b>Language Access Statement</b> (also called taglines) in all prevalent nguages. Example taglines can be found on the <u>Member Material Submission page</u> .
	<ul> <li>Per Section 1557 of the Affordable Care Act, some member materials must include language access statements in Oregon's Top 15 prevalent non-English languages. For the list of these materials, please see 45 CFR § 92.11. For materials not on this list, language access statements must be in English and all prevalent non-English languages in the CCO service area.</li> <li>OHA uses the Monthly Medicaid Population Report to determine which languages fall into the Top 15 list.</li> </ul>
	Language Access Statements must include:
	<ul> <li>Help is free</li> <li>Other languages and formats are available</li> <li>Interpreters are available</li> <li>Customer service number</li> <li>TTY number</li> <li>18 pt font size</li> </ul>
	All <b>font sizes</b> are at least 12 point for regular text, 18 point for large text. This applies to all ext, including graphics, headers, and footers.
	Font color has a contrast ratio of at least 4.5:1 for normal text and 3:1 for large text. You an check contrast ratio of your font colors on <a href="WebAIM">WebAIM</a> .
	All <b>URLs are correct</b> and <b>hyperlinks are working</b> . If the document will be printed, URLs re spelled out.
	Document includes <b>CCO branding and contact information</b> . Subcontractor documents nust be co-branded with the CCO.
