

Ground Emergency Medical Transportation (GEMT) Coordinated Care Organization (CCO) Supplemental Payment Program Annual CARES Participation Report for Ground Emergency Medical Transportation (GEMT) Coordinated Care Organization (CCO) Supplemental Payment Program

The GEMT CCO Supplemental Payment Program's directed payment arrangement must advance at least one of the goals and objectives in Oregon's Medicaid Quality Strategy required by 42 CFR §438.340. Oregon Health Authority (OHA)'s quality measure is GEMT provider participation in the Cardiac Arrest Registry to Enhance Survival (CARES) registry.

- OHA reports this measure at least annually to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services.
- CCOs also receive an annual report of participating providers.
- Oregon's Medicaid Quality Strategy has a target of increasing GEMT provider participation in CARES by 5 percentage points per year. OHA will continue to share information with CCOs, the Quality and Health Outcomes Committee, and participating provider groups about progress meeting the goal(s) and objective(s) in the quality strategy, and the effectiveness of this quality measurement.

The 42 CFR §438.6(c)(2)(i)(A) requires that supplemental payments be based on the utilization and delivery of services for CCO enrollees. The directed payments must be linked to quality improvement in accordance with 42 CFR §438.6(c)(2)(i)(C).
