

Oregon Health Authority/Oregon Council on Problem Gambling (OCPG): Problem Gambling Certification or Recertification Subsidy Request Form

DIRECTIONS: Fill out and return to pgs.support@oha.oregon.gov. You will be notified if you are eligible for the certification subsidy (including how much you have qualified for) within 7 business days. You will pay all fees upfront and receive the specified subsidy amount by check via mail from the Oregon Council on Problem Gambling once certification testing or recertification process is completed and verified.

The subsidy application is intended to offset some, but not all, of the costs of certification/recertification for eligible participants (see below) and only if fees are not covered by your agency or another payer.

Eligibility:

1. Provider of state-funded problem gambling prevention/treatment/outreach/recovery services program or member of PGS advisory group, or
2. Key statewide or local partner and/or serving an underserved population, as determined by OHA/PGS.
3. Requested certification must be associated with the current work you are doing (ICD PG Specialist, PG Professional, or PG Medicaid Program).
