## The State of STIs in Oregon in 2023



4,960 cases of GONORRHEA; 19% decrease since 2019



2,085 cases of SYPHILIS; 67% increase since 2019

Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) are very common but preventable.



30 cases of SYPHILIS AMONG NEWBORNS; 67% increase since 2019

Anyone who has sex could get an STI, **but some groups are more affected:** 

The antibiotic doxycycline helps prevent syphilis, chlamydia, and gonorrhea when taken within 72 hours after sex. Talk with your medical provider about Doxy PEP!
