



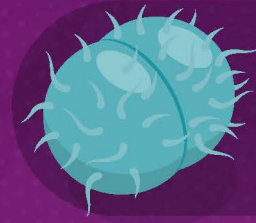

The State of STIs in Oregon in 2023

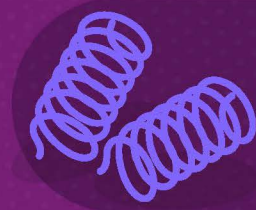
Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) are very common but preventable.



15,344
cases of **CHLAMYDIA**;
20% decrease since 2019



4,960
cases of **GONORRHEA**;
19% decrease since 2019



2,085
cases of **SYPHILIS**;
67% increase since 2019



30
cases of **SYPHILIS AMONG NEWBORNS**;
67% increase since 2019

Anyone who has sex could get an STI, **but some groups are more affected:**

The antibiotic doxycycline helps prevent syphilis, chlamydia, and gonorrhea when taken within 72 hours after sex. Talk with your medical provider about Doxy PEP!

Untreated STIs can lead to **serious health problems:**



increased risk of transmitting or getting HIV



long-term pelvic/abdominal pain



inability to get pregnant or pregnancy complications
