  - 1. We are seeking commercial carrier representation on the **Rules Advisory Committee!** 
    - The Rules Advisory Committee will review Oregon Health Authority's proposed Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) changes for the Universally offered Home Visiting Program, OARs 333-006-0000 through 333-006-1090, to expand the type of organization eligible to be designated as a Newborn Nurse Home Visiting Provider and Community Lead.
