


Pediatric Nutrition Collaborative

- Collaborative met 3 times in 2019 and selected priority activities for 2020:
 - Develop contact lists for dietitians, specialty clinics and health care providers
 - Assess our system for sharing data with health care providers
 - Explore ways to communicate on what materials WIC provides
 - Develop template for key 'hot topics' and reach consensus on best practices
