 - Develop template for key ‘hot topics’ and reach consensus on best practices



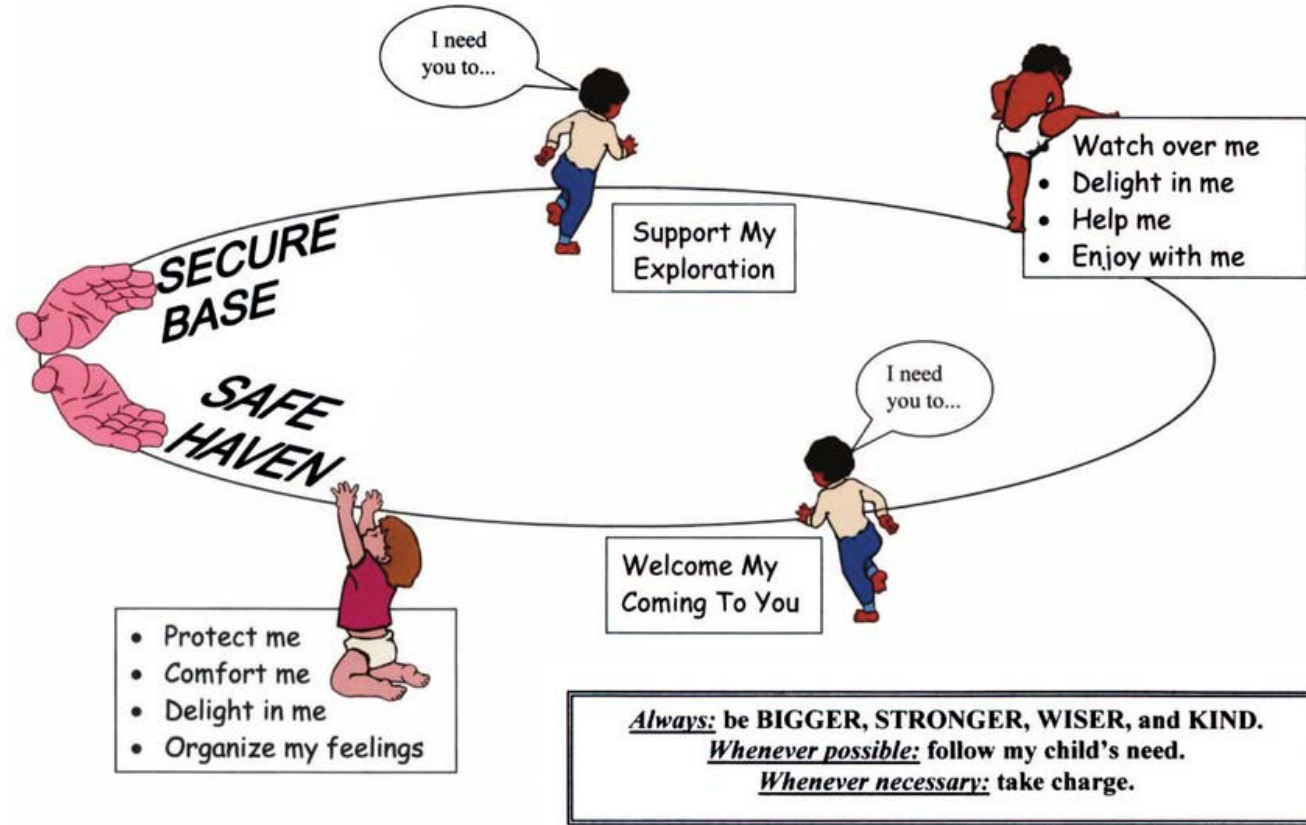
Pediatric Nutrition Collaborative
