Formula shortages: Total Comfort, Similac Sensitive and Similac Advance

- According to the manufacturer, Abbott, the reasons for the shortages include:
 - Stores not required to stock alternate formulas (only Similac Advance)
 - Local Agency staff issuing more of these formulas
 - Stores unaware of the need/increased need
 - Stores not able to keep up with demand, and
 - Supply chain issues
- What the manufacturer is doing:
 - Increasing production and accelerating deliveries to market, make take 6-8 weeks
- What we are doing:
 - Sending updates three times per week to coordinators
 - Sending resources in weekly situation updates
 - Working with the manufacturer and other states to coordinate messages and obtain updates



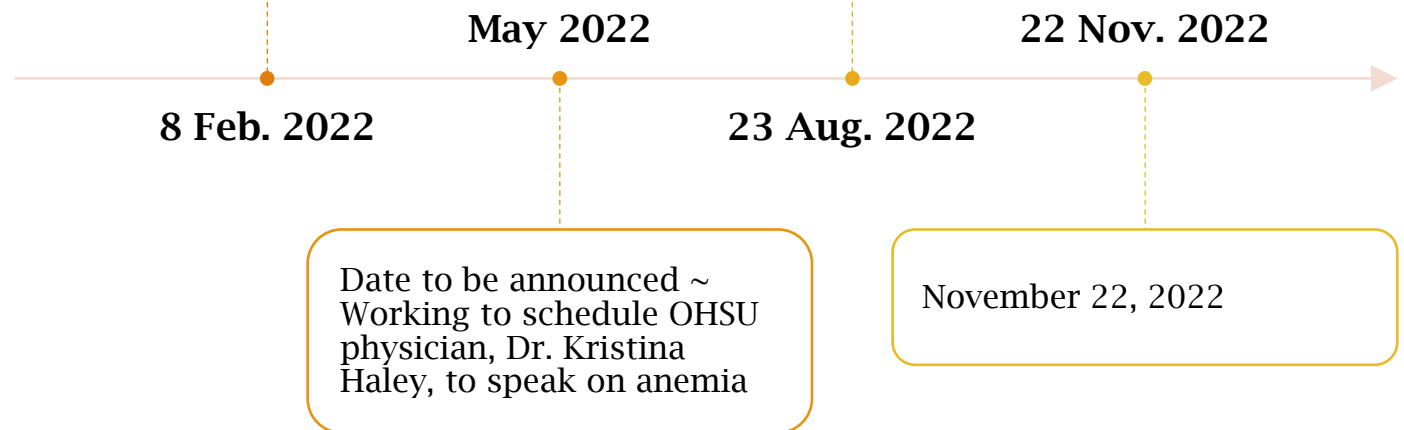
