OREGON TOBACCO RETAIL LICENSE (TRL) BULLETIN

Be prepared for the NEW compliance inspection component that starts July 1

Starting July 1, 2024, the TRL program will begin enforcing the Packaging Attractive to Minors law through compliance inspections. It's Oregon state law that all types of inhalant delivery systems (IDS), commonly referred to as e-cigarettes, must not be packaged in a manner that is attractive to minors (Oregon Revised Statute [ORS] 431A.175[2][f]).


During an inspection, compliance specialists will look at a sample of IDS to ensure that products sold comply with the IDS packaging attractive to minors rule, Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-015-0357. 

Look for inspection results via email

We are **emailing retailers their pass/fail letters and inspection reports** after we finish TRL inspections. These emails will be sent to the email address provided on your application for your tobacco retail license.

The emails will come from contact@hscloudsuite.com (Oregon Tobacco Inspections), so be sure to check your junk or spam mailboxes and update your email settings to allow emails from this address. Here are examples of what the emails look like:





Inhalant delivery system (IDS) child-resistant packaging requirements

Enforcement of IDS (also known as e-cigarette) child-resistant packaging requirements started Jan. 1, 2024, through compliance inspections.

No self-service tobacco products

Did you know that the law requires you to keep **ALL** tobacco products behind the counter in an area only employees can get to **OR** in a locked case? If you keep tobacco products where customers can get them without help from a clerk, it may result in a violation (ORS 167.765). An exception to this is if the business prohibits customers younger than 21.

Smoke Shops and Cigar Bar Certification and Minimum Legal Sales Age Inspections

Certified smoke shops and cigar bars cannot allow persons under 21 years of age to enter the premises. OHA will begin considering Minimum Legal Sales Age (MLSA) inspections that are failed on or after Aug. 1, 2024, to evaluate whether a certified smoke shop or certified cigar bar has met this requirement. The smoke shop or cigar bar certification may be revoked or denied if the business fails an MLSA inspection. The business may also be subject to penalties for selling tobacco to an underage person in addition to penalties under the Indoor Clean Air Act.
