Basics of Oregon School Immunization Requirements

- Help protect almost 650,000 children against 11 vaccine-preventable diseases.
- Help build community immunity.
- Make sure kids can be brought up-to-date on vaccines at least once a year.





Back to School

Child's record must show at least one dose of each required vaccine or exemption



Fall

Schools work with families to get records for any missing vaccines

Data collected from all schools, verified, and released

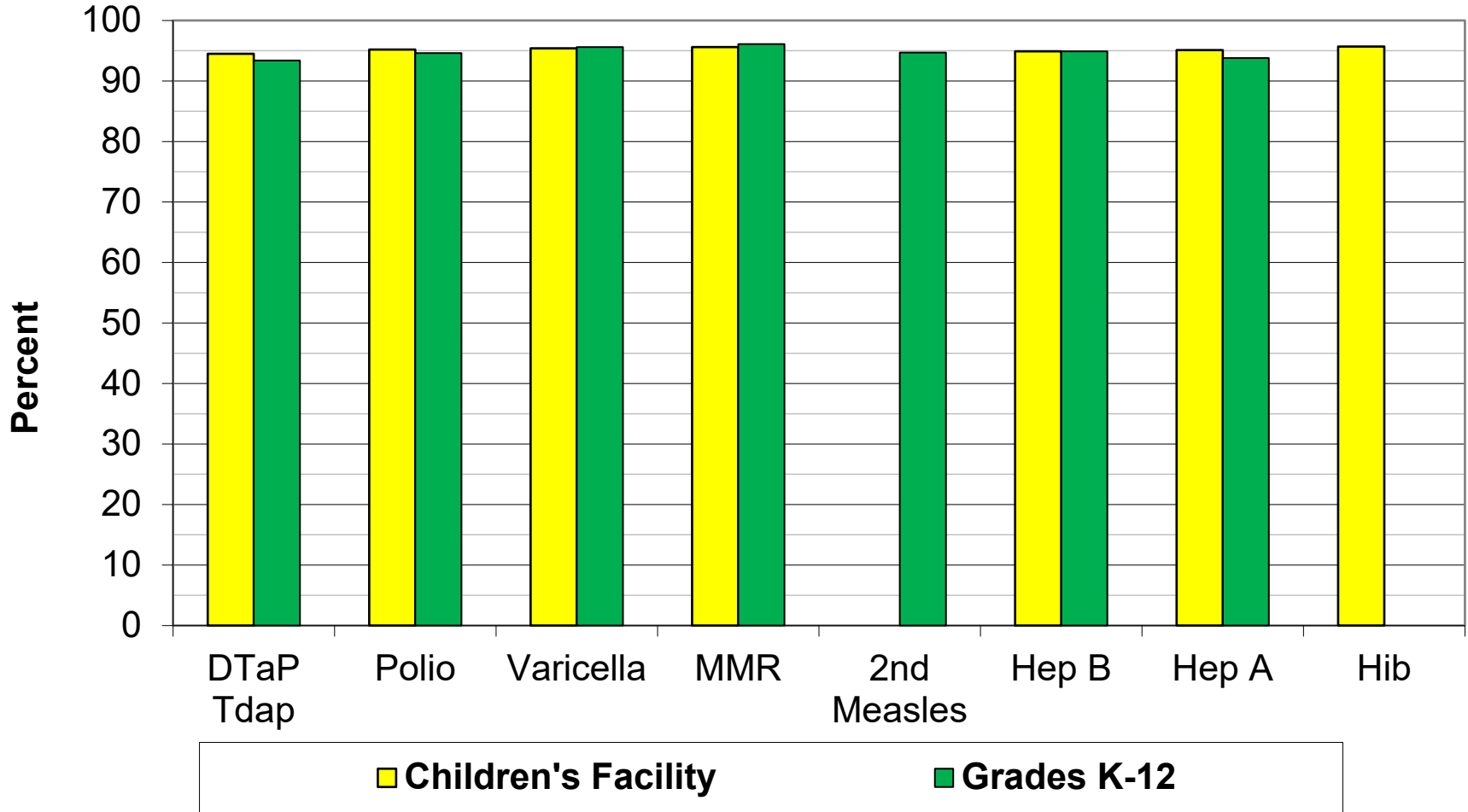

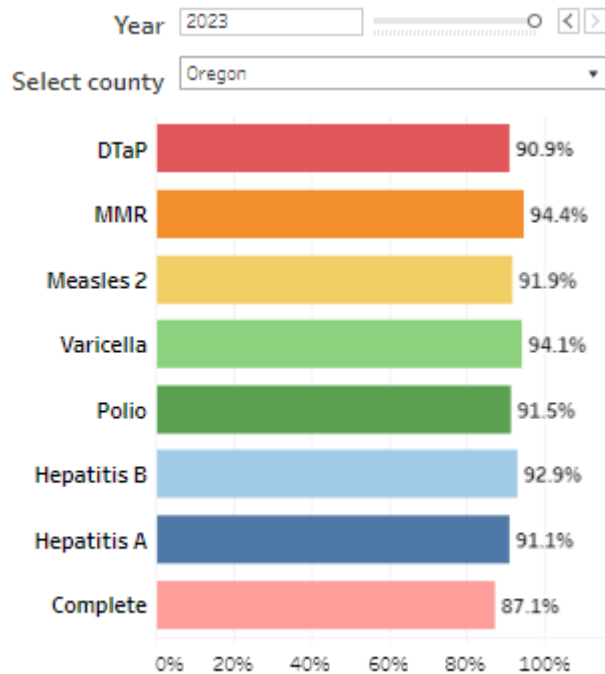


Percent of Children with School/Children's Facility Required Vaccines, 2024

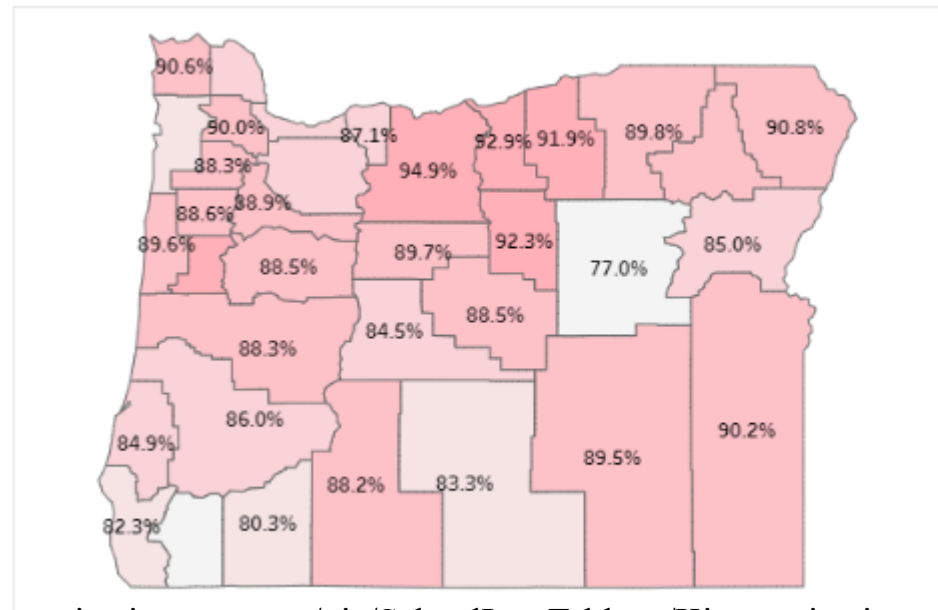


Kindergarten Immunization Data

Statewide, over 87% of kindergarten students completed all school-required vaccines in 2023. From 90% to 94% of kindergartners completed each individual required vaccine. Use the year and county selection tools to change the displays of vaccination rates. *Note: county-specific immunization rates are missing for 1992 and 1996.*



The map shows the percent of kindergartners with complete school-required vaccines by county. The darker the color, the higher the vaccination rate.

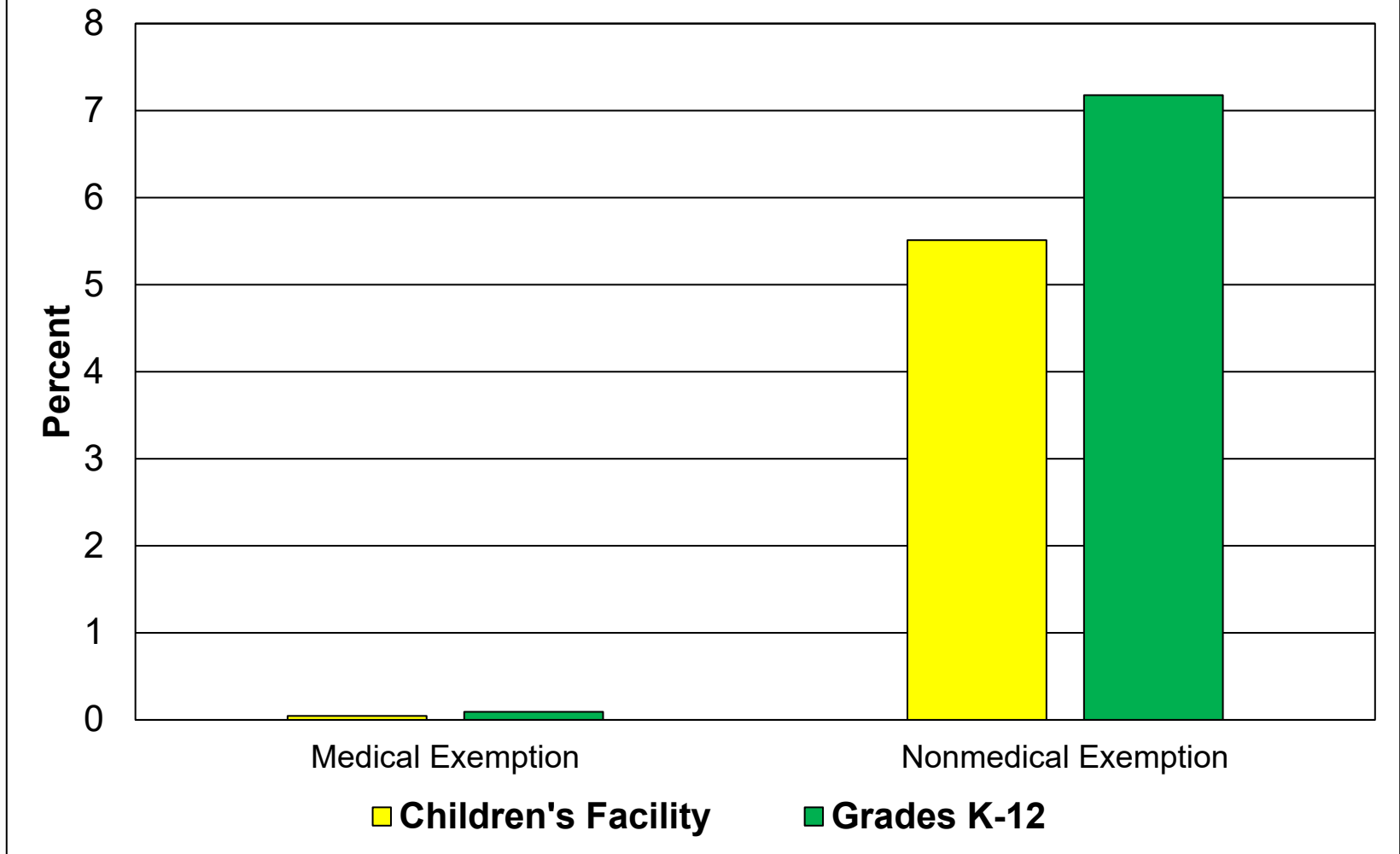

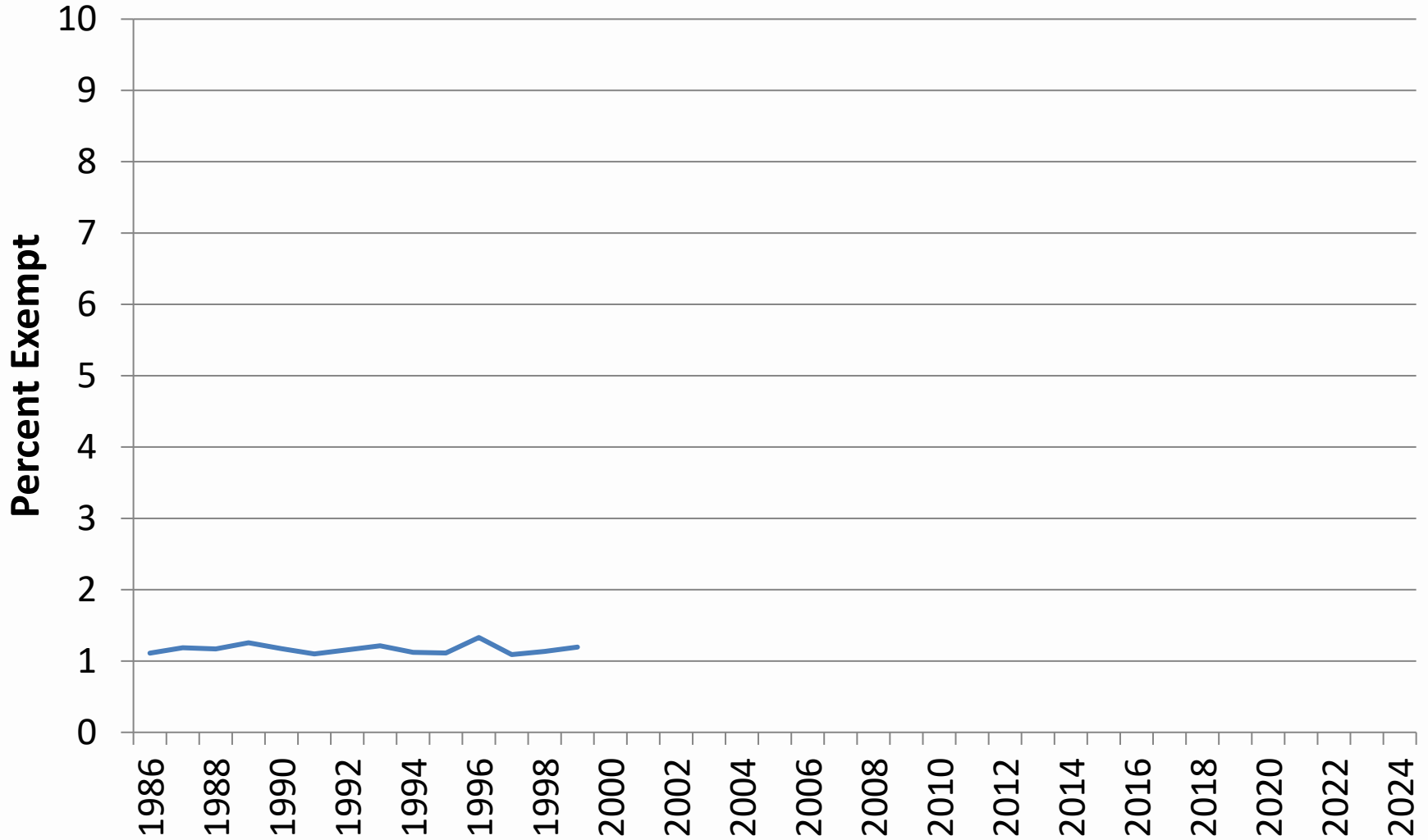

Percent of Children with Exemptions to School Required Vaccines, 2024

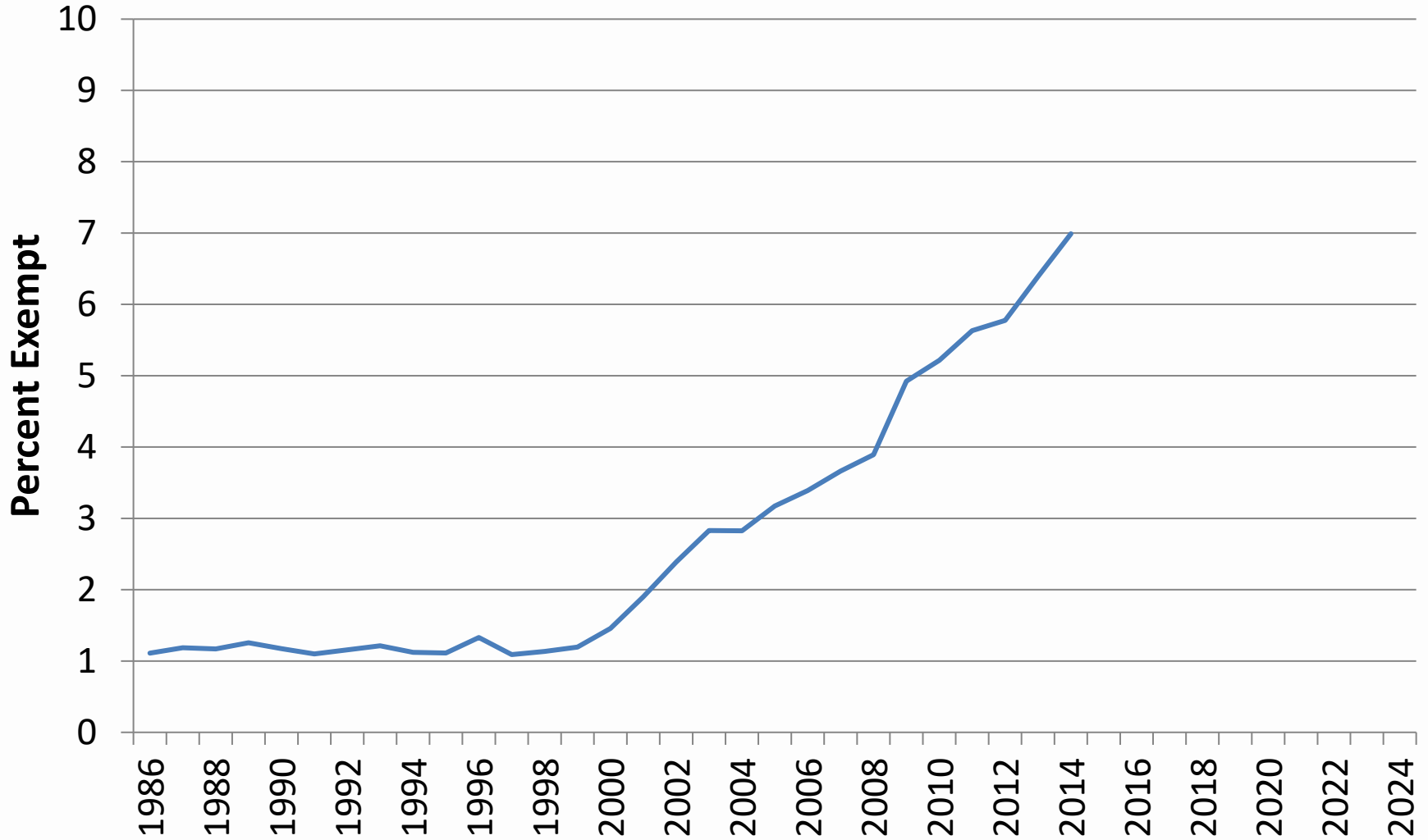


Oregon Kindergarten Nonmedical Exemption Rates



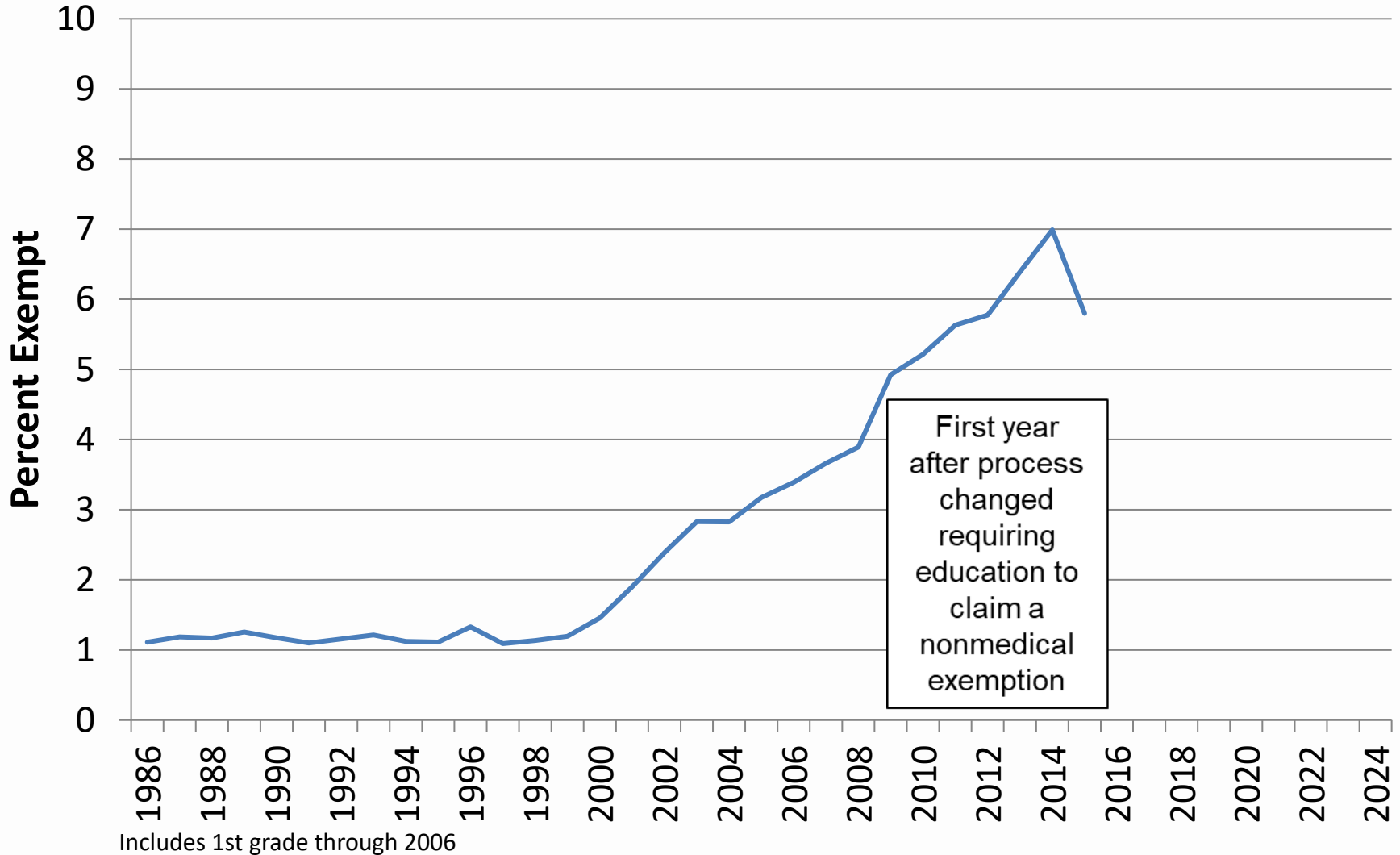

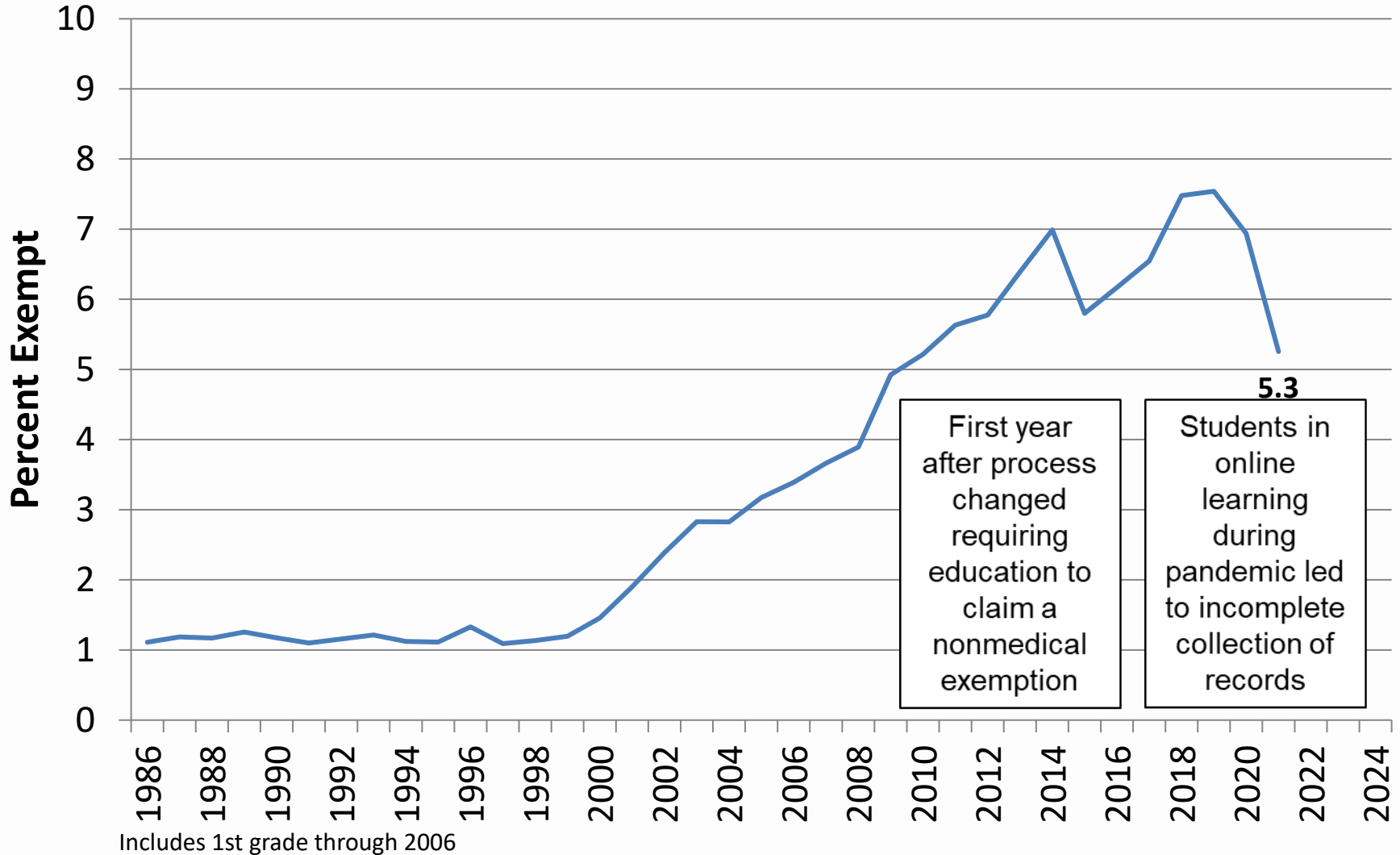

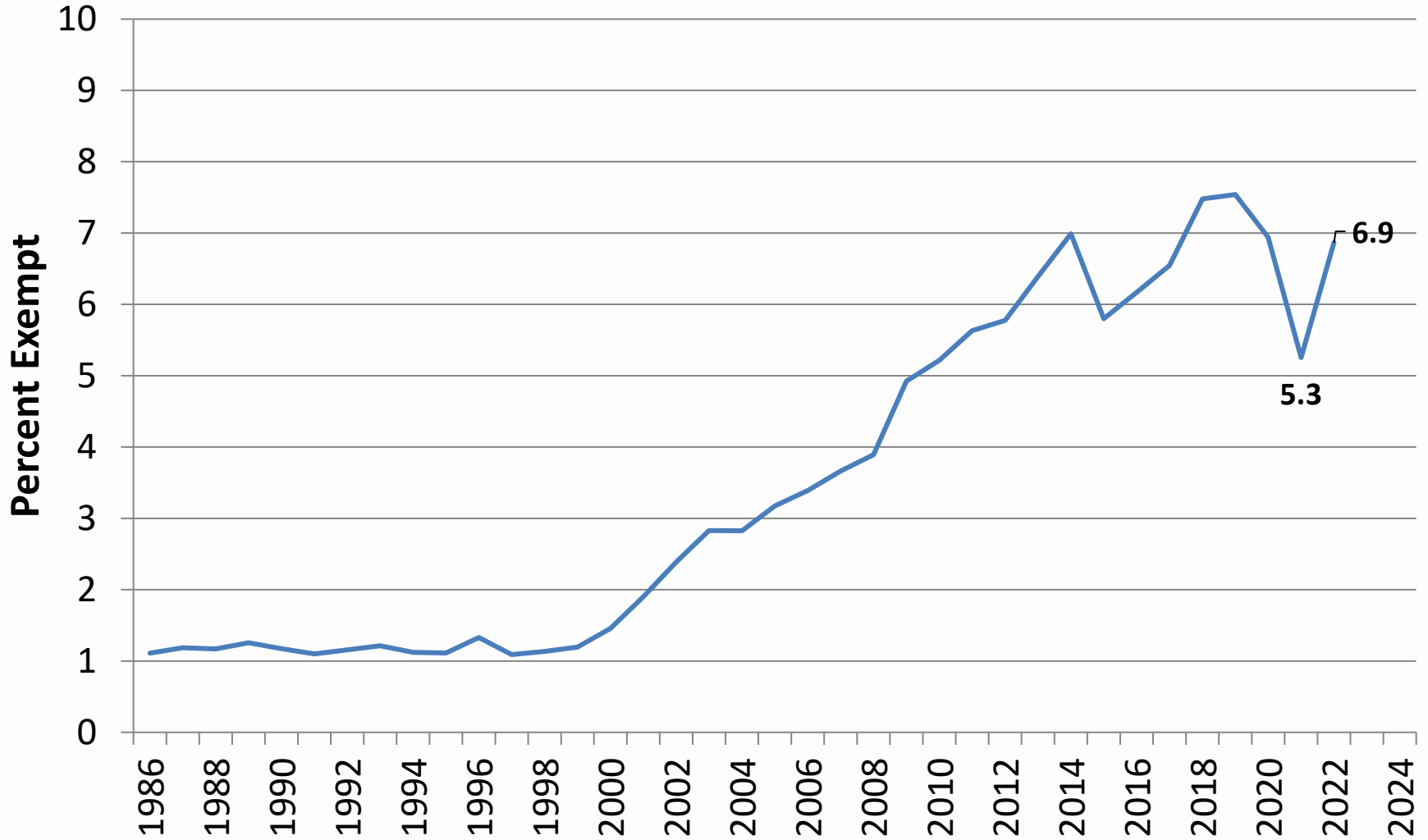

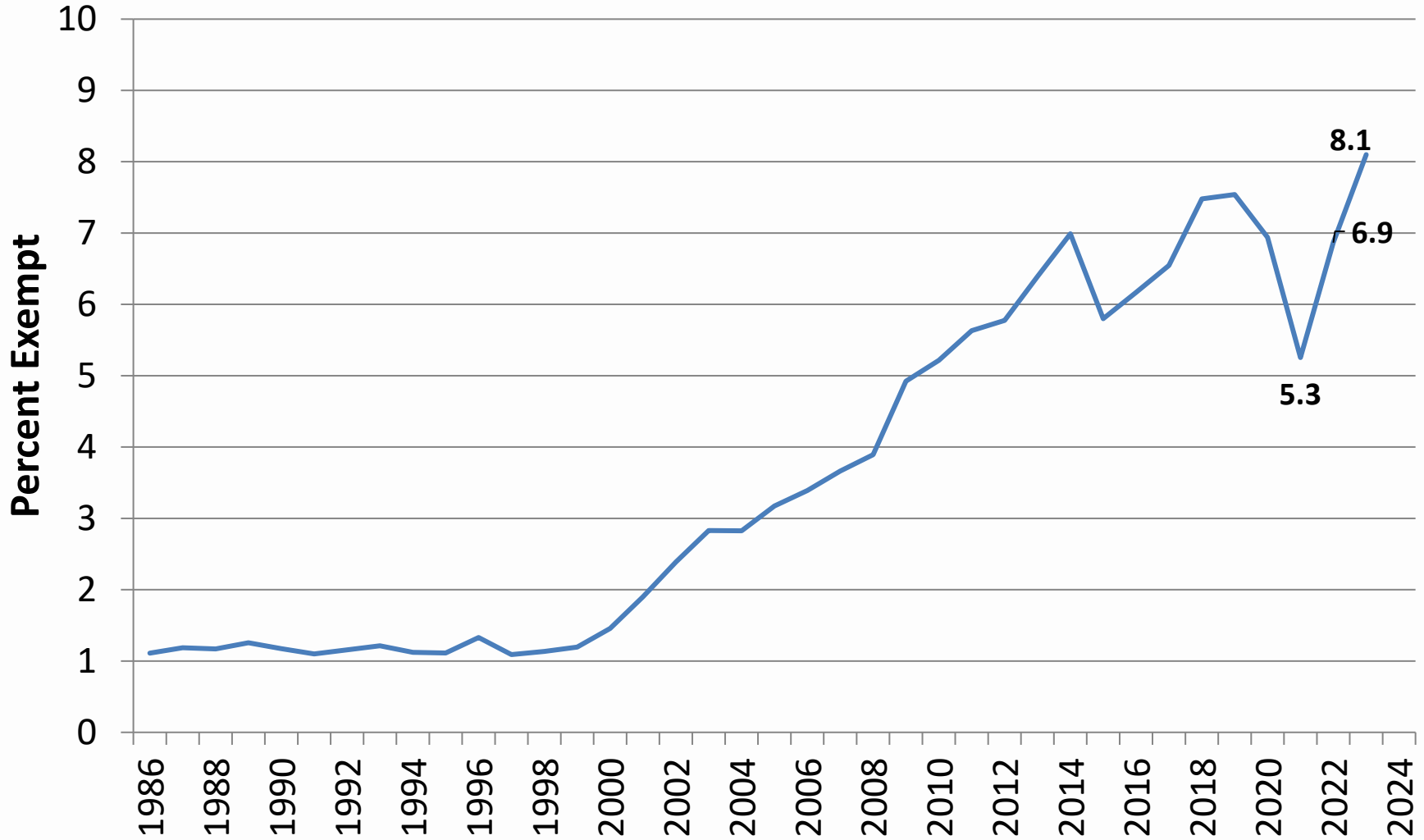

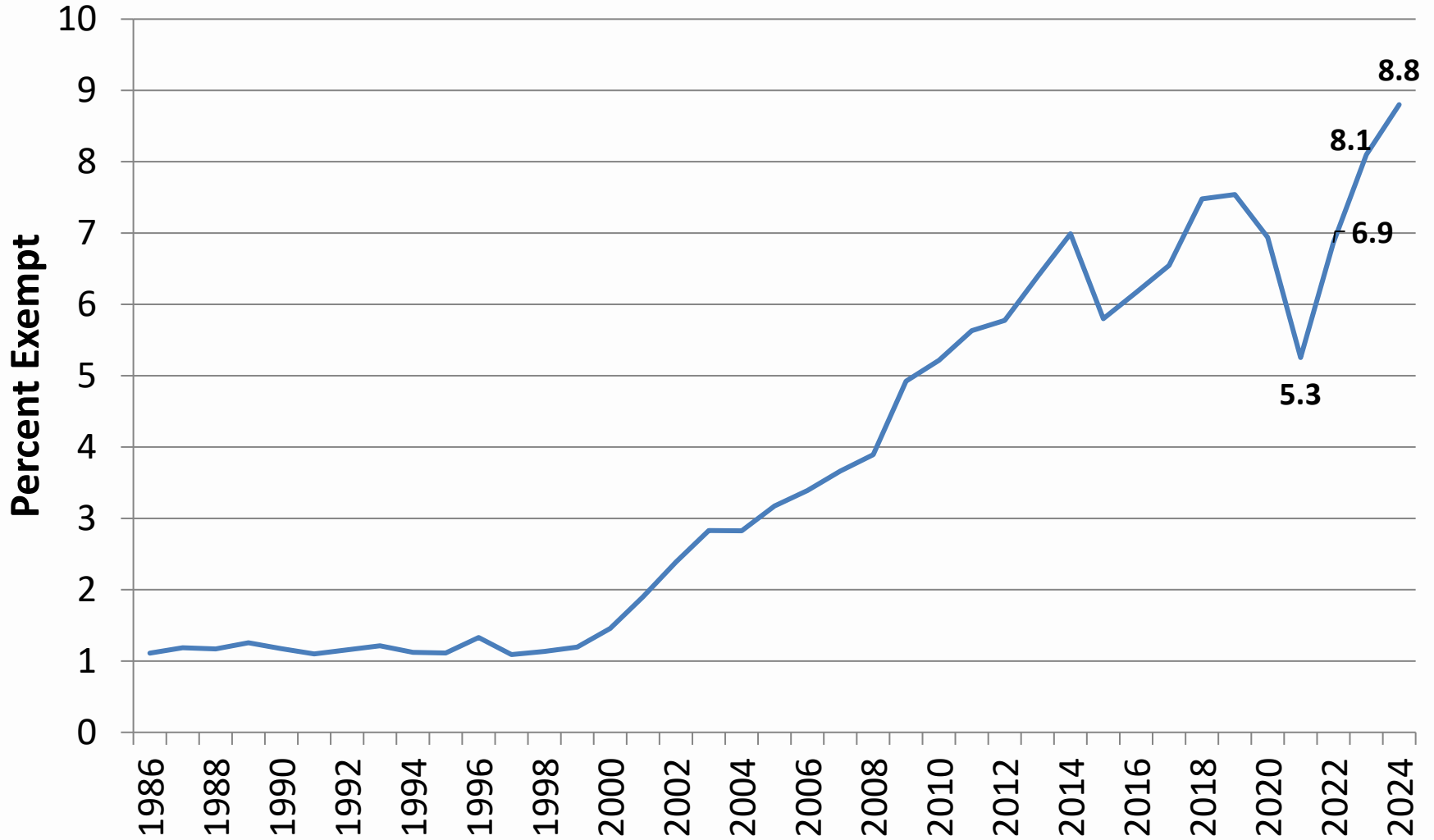

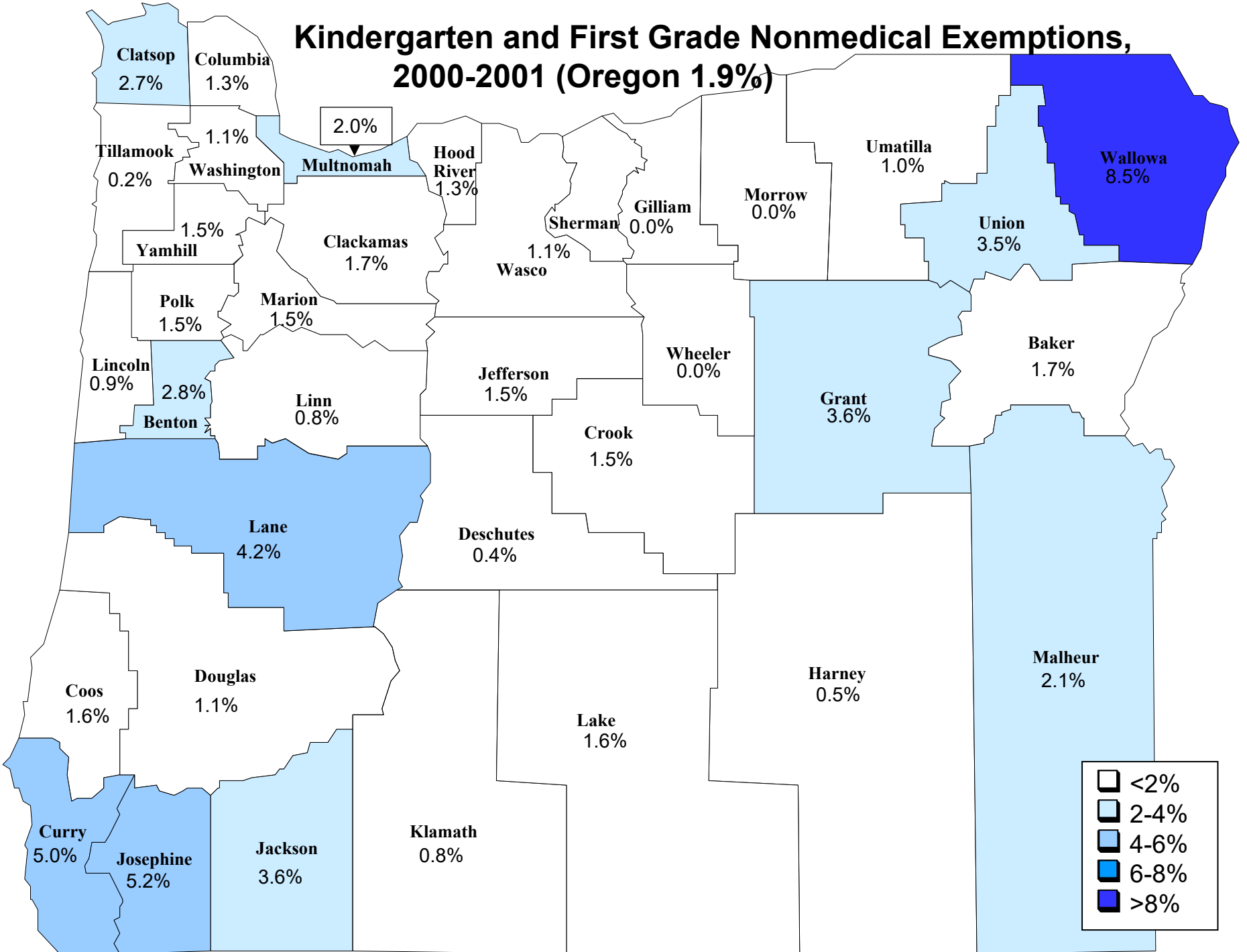

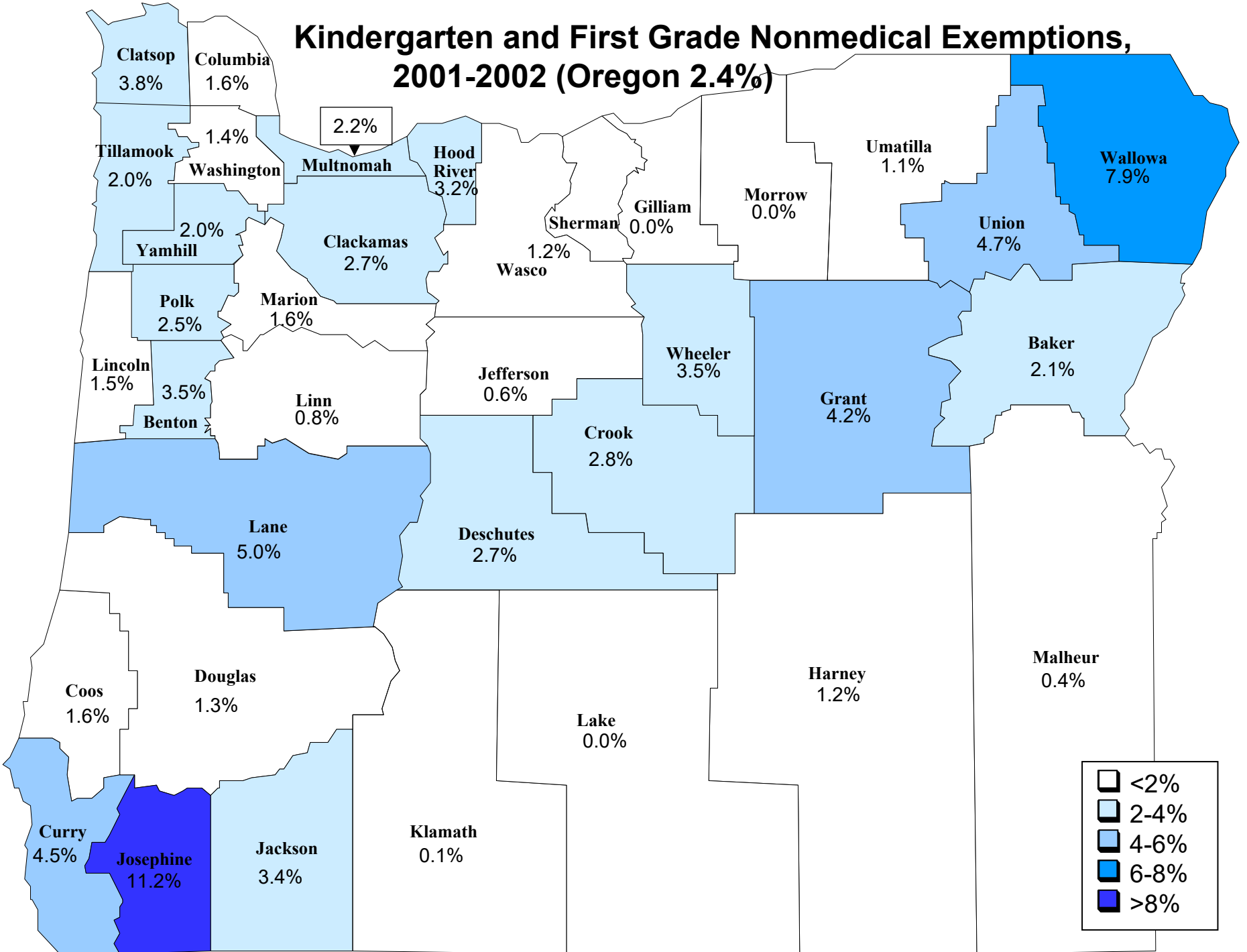

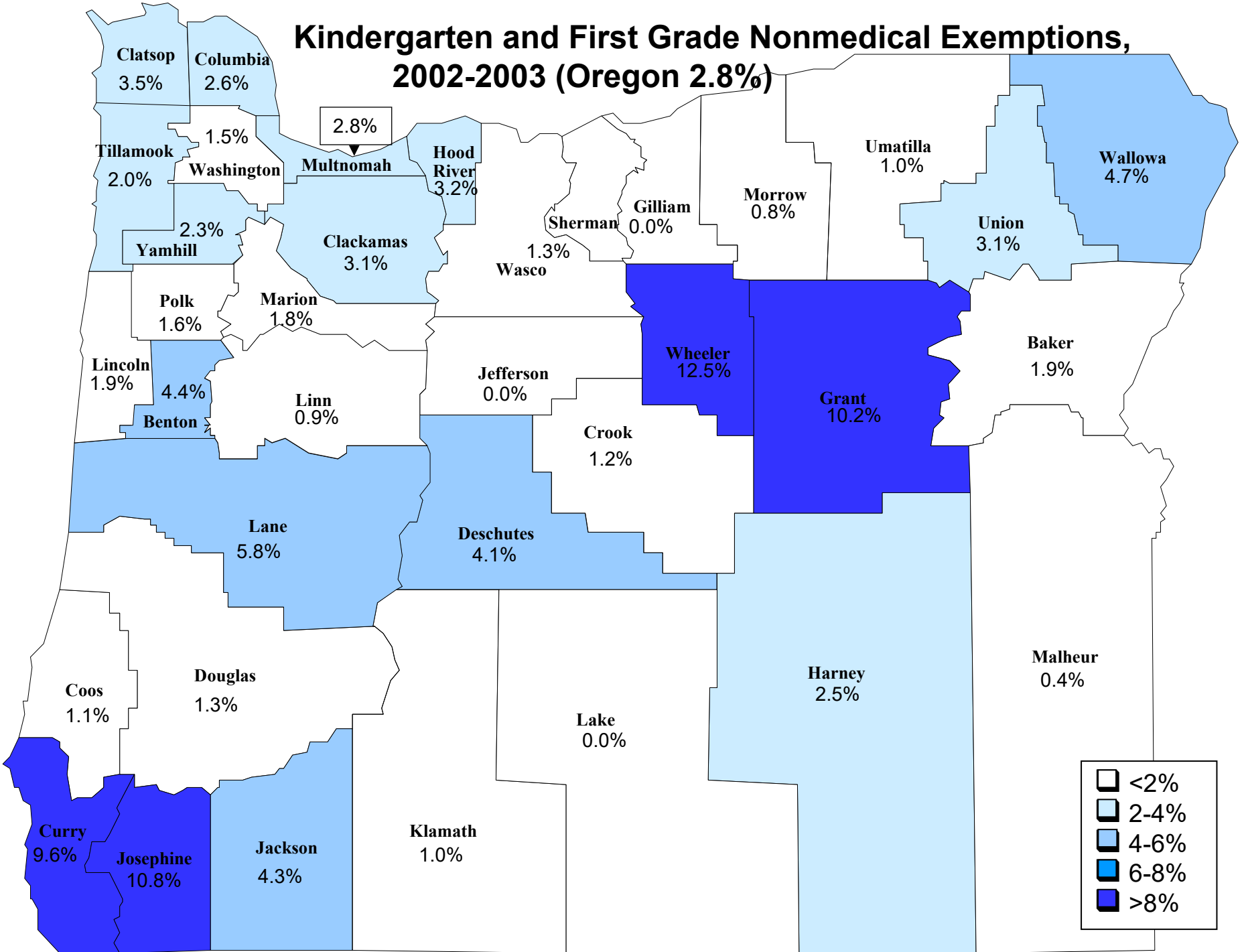
Kindergarten and First Grade Nonmedical Exemptions, 2000-2001 (Oregon 1.9%)



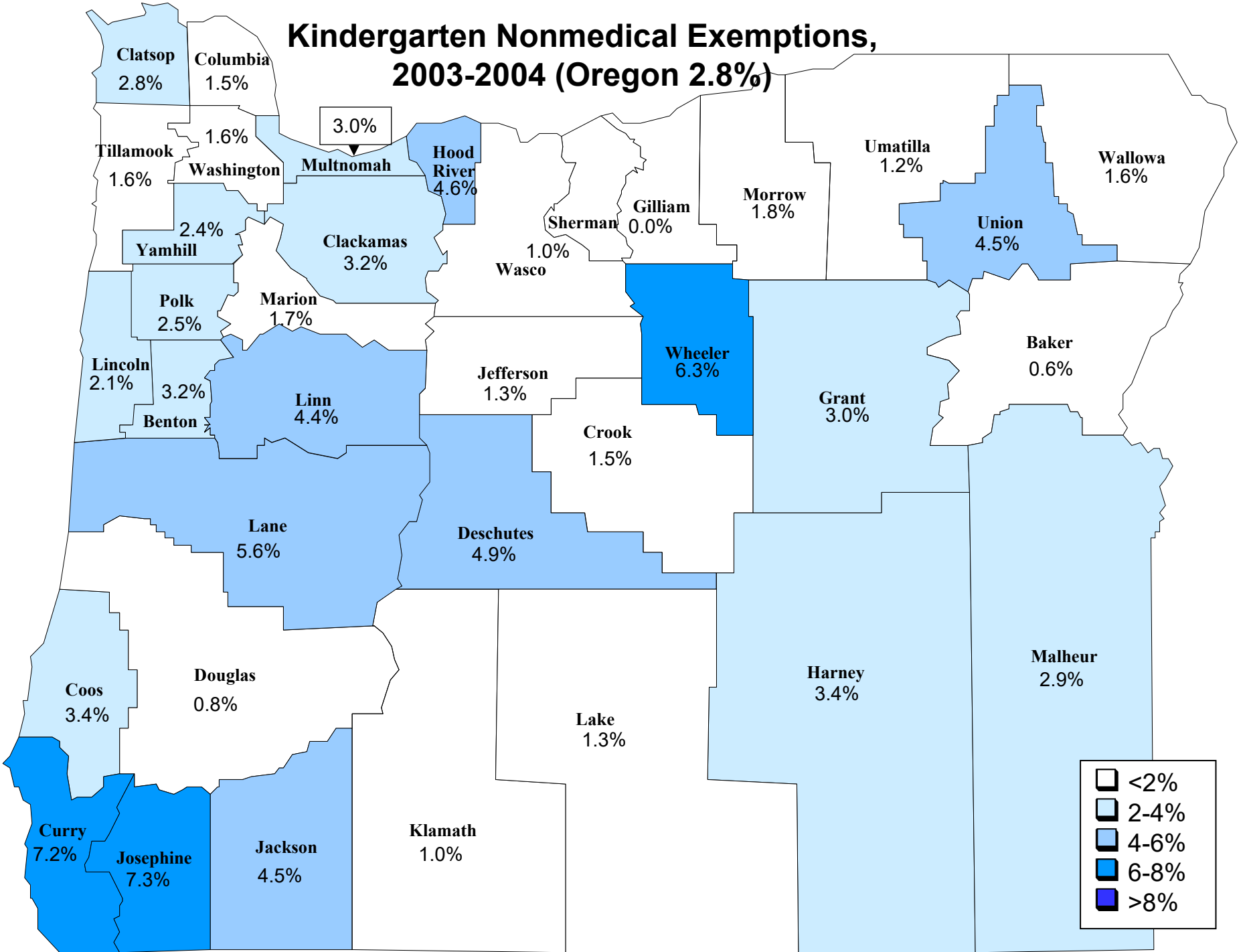
Kindergarten and First Grade Nonmedical Exemptions, 2001-2002 (Oregon 2.4%)



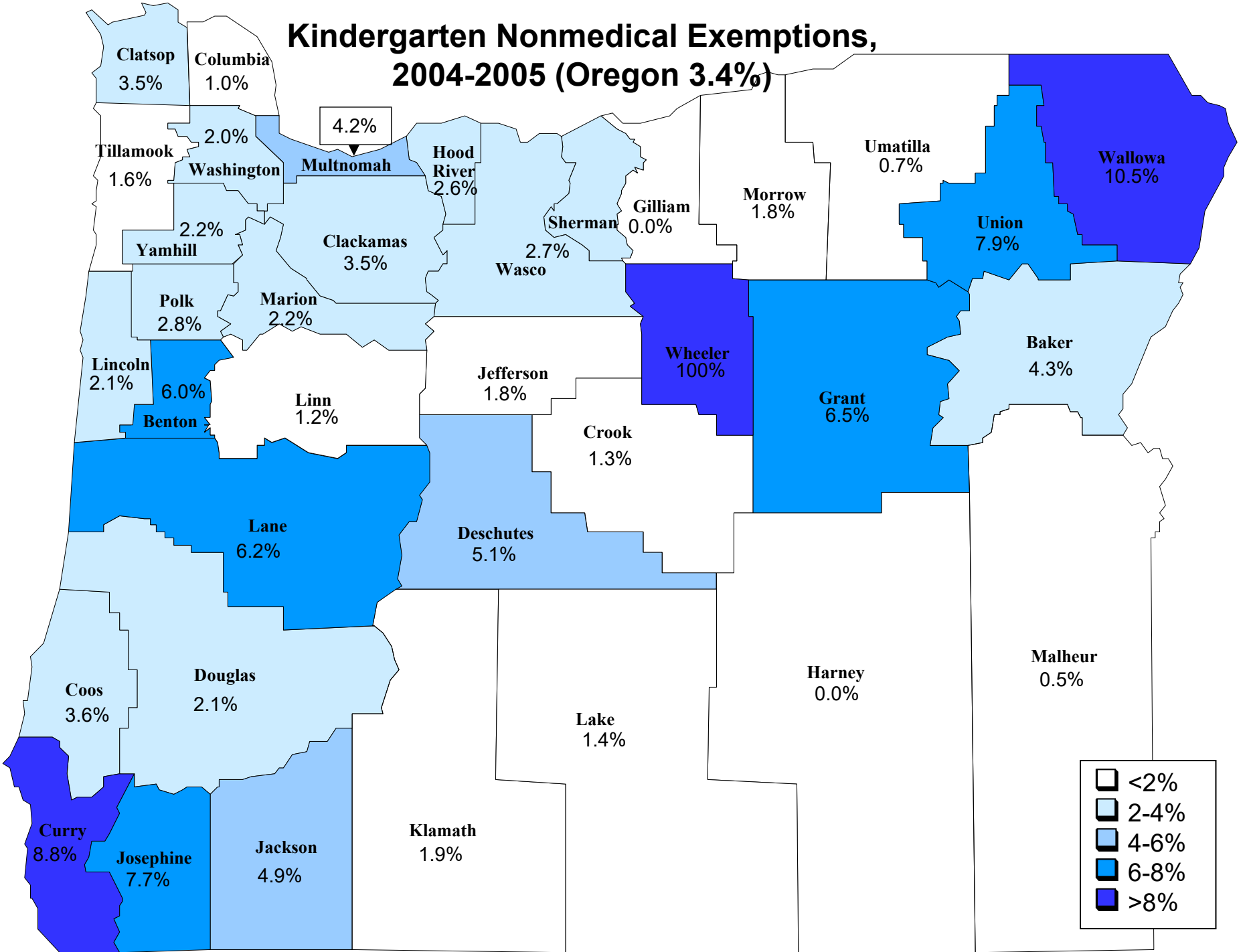

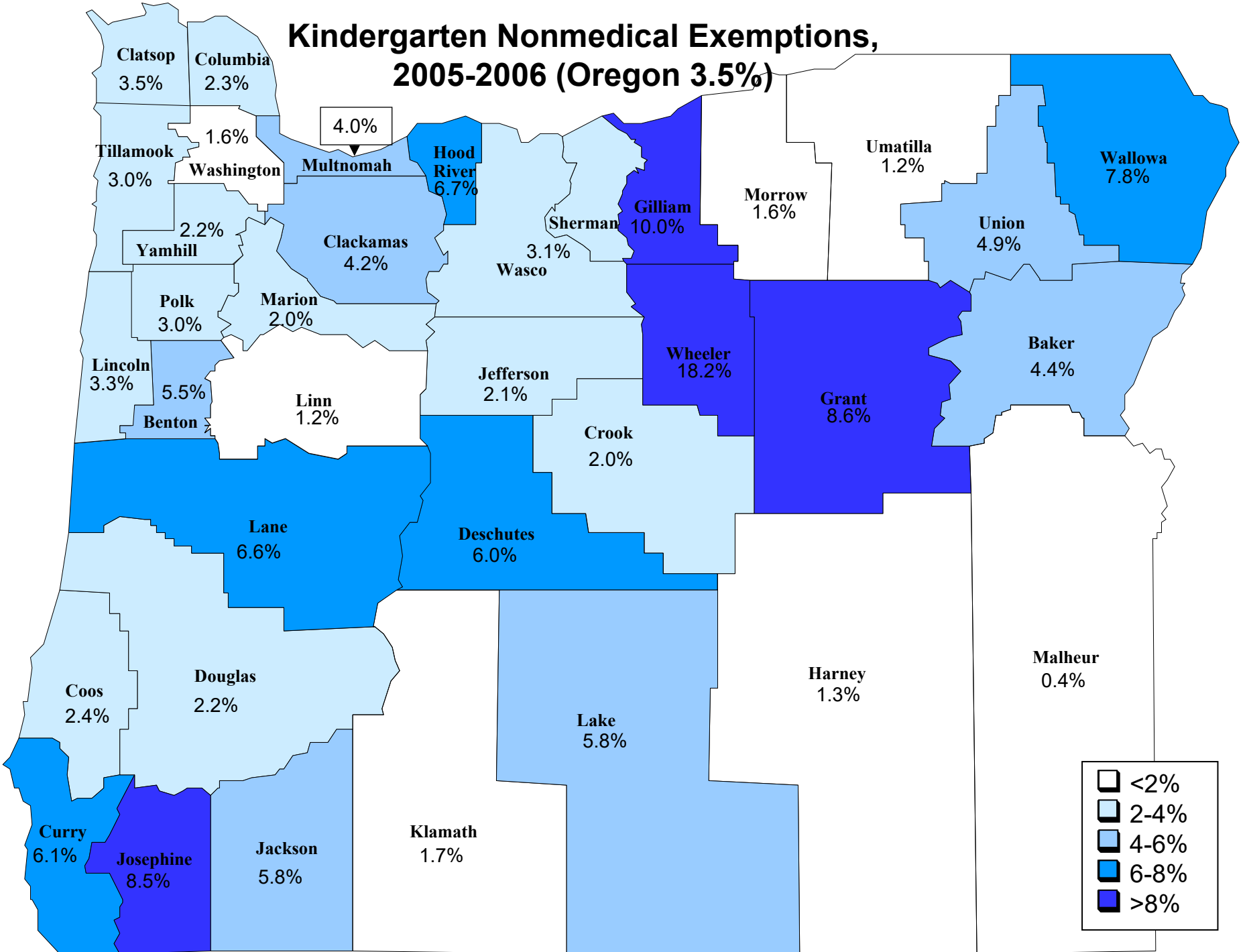

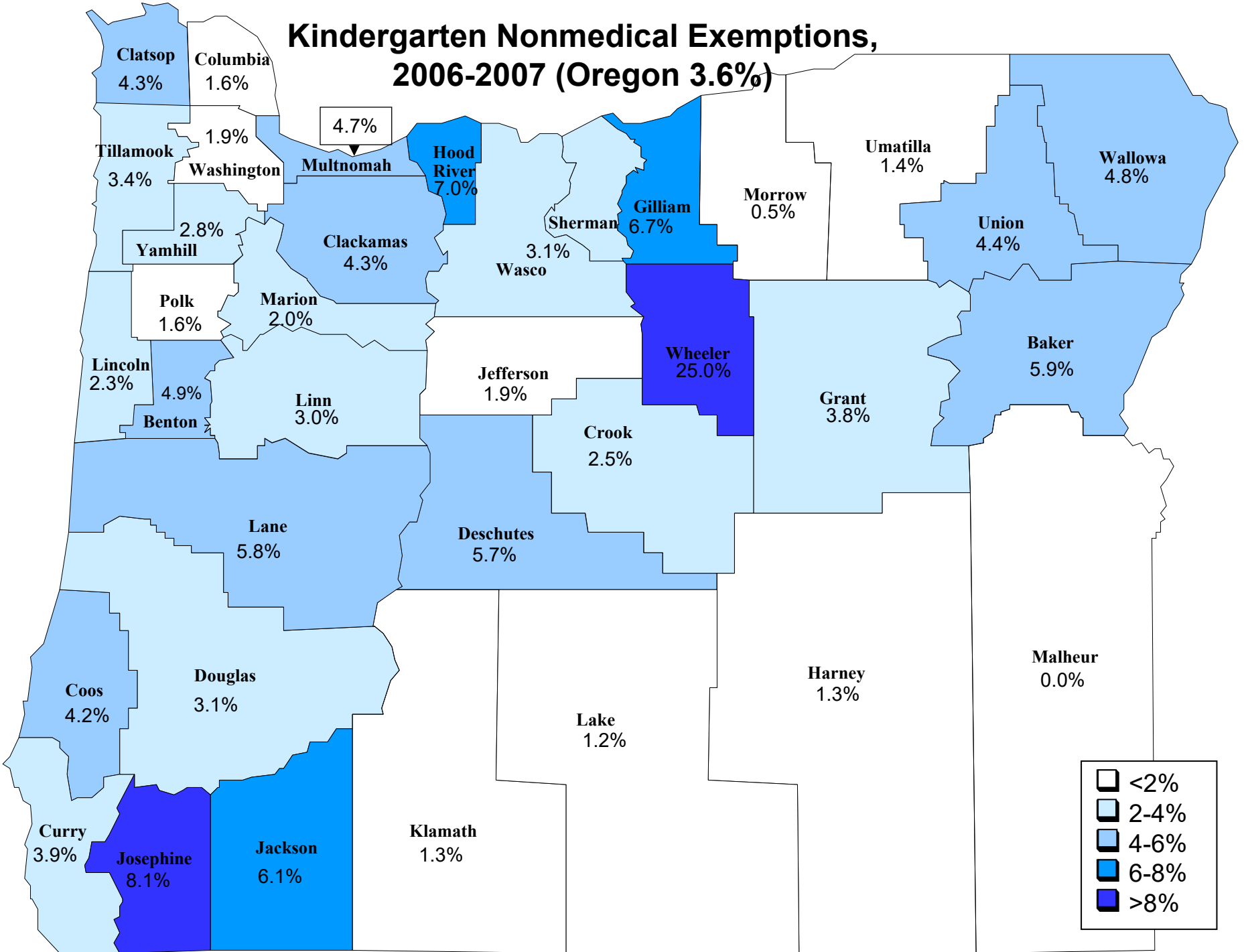

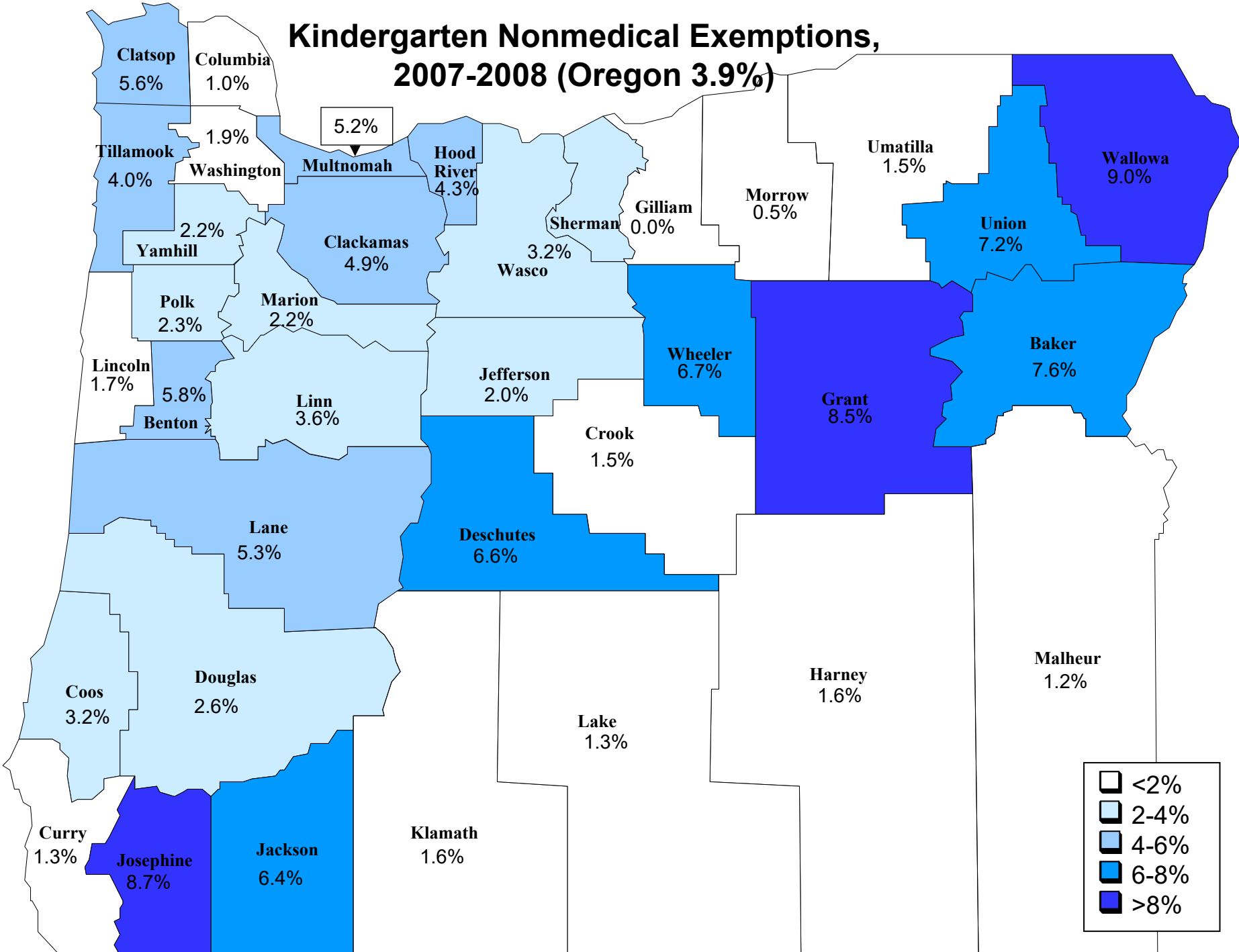

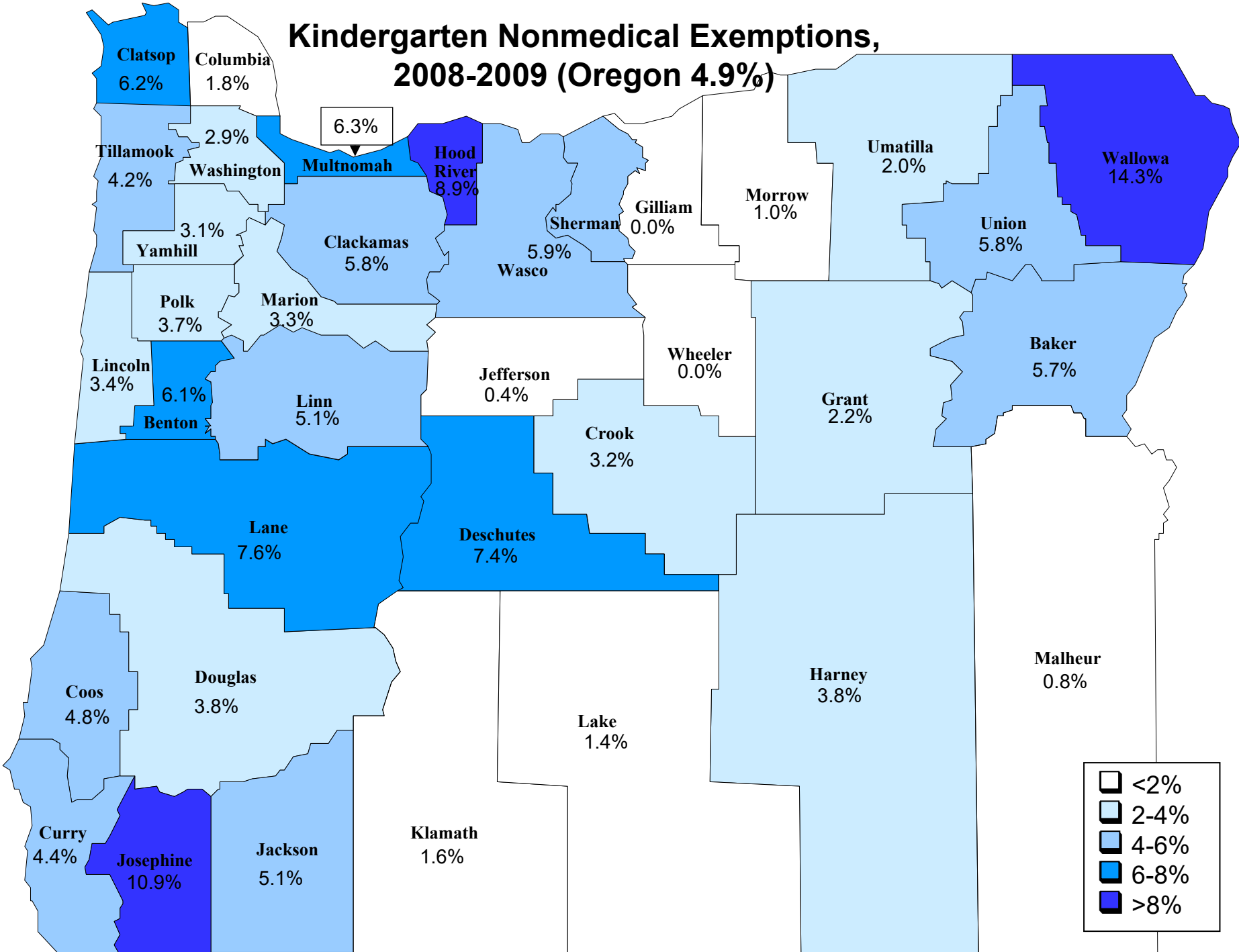

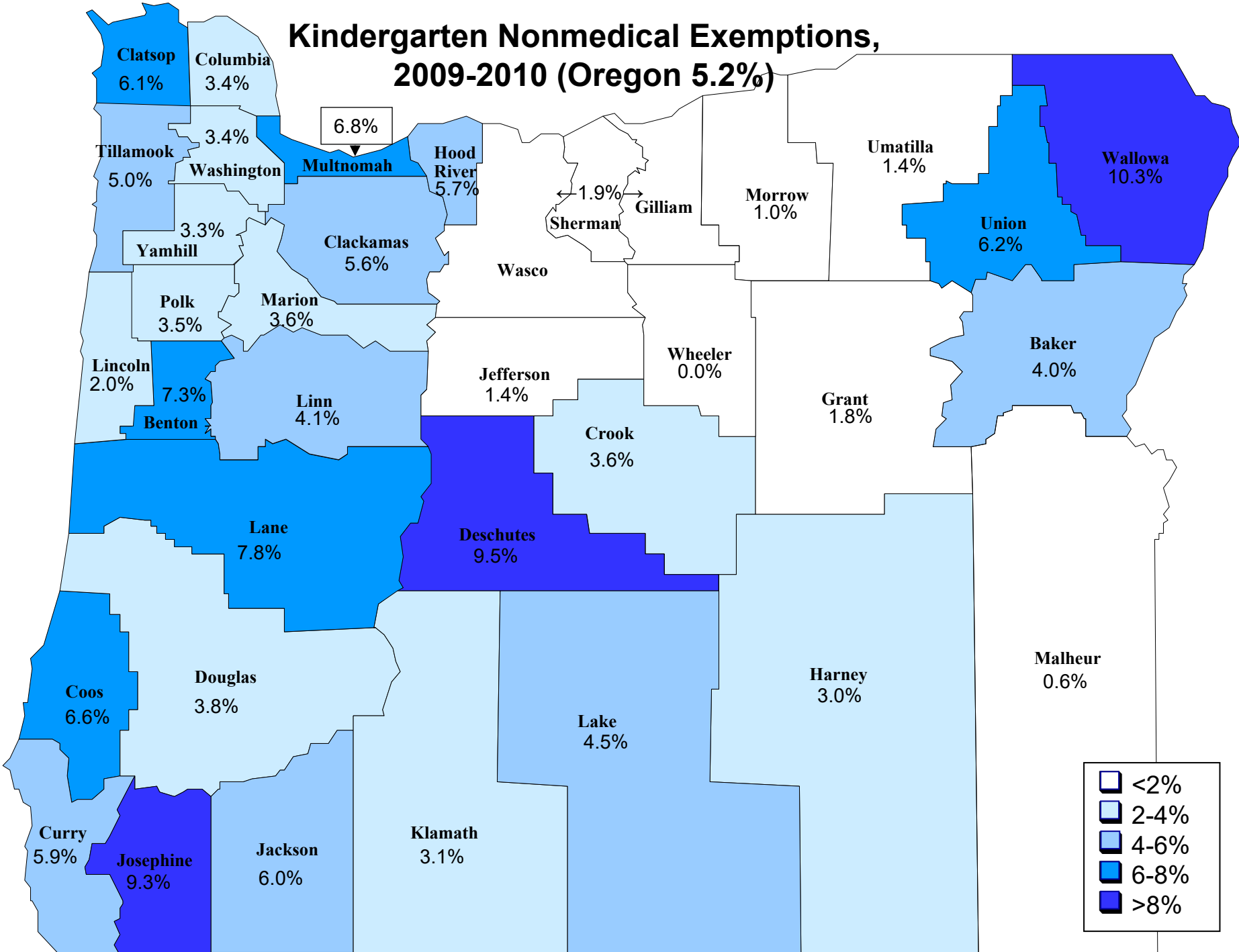

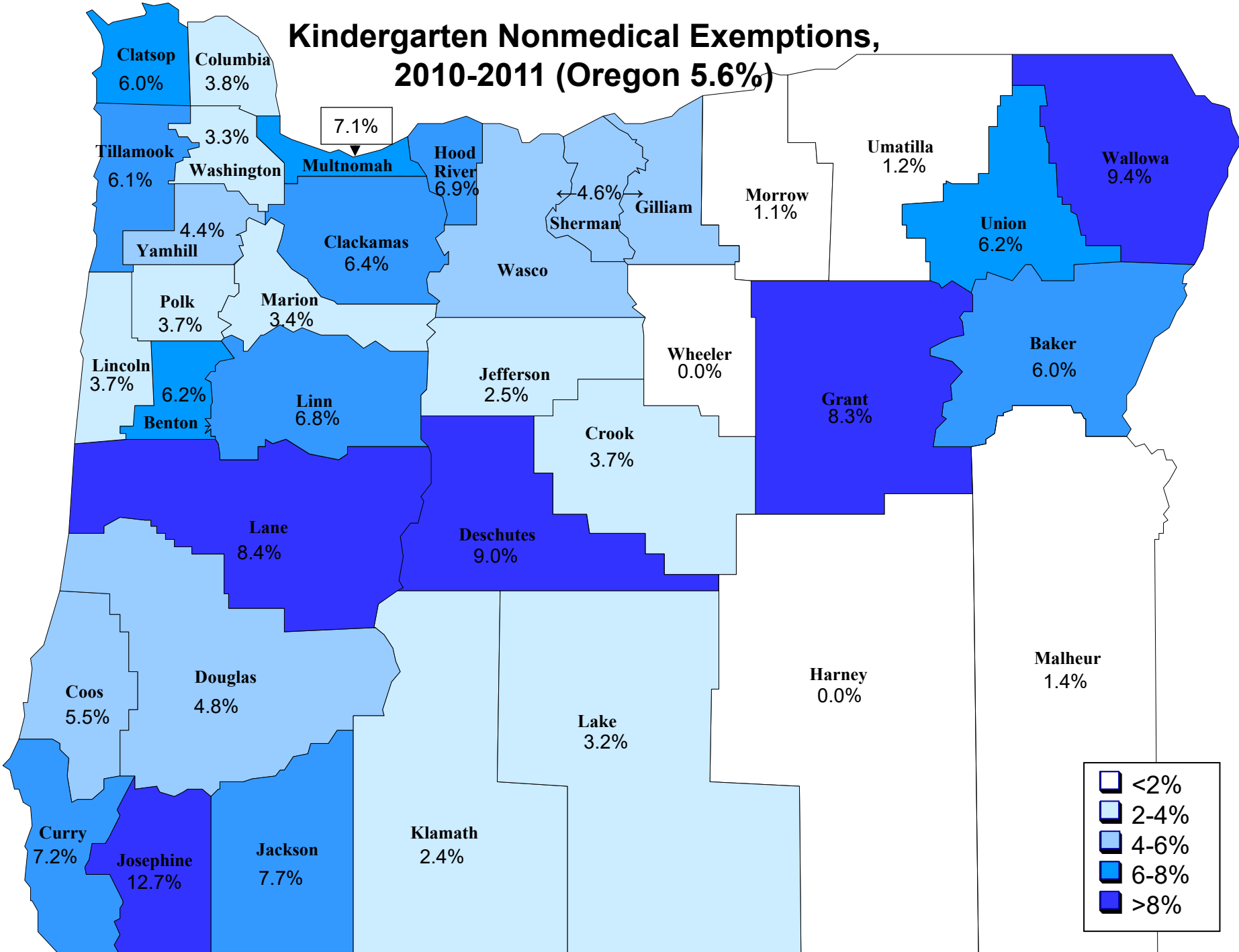

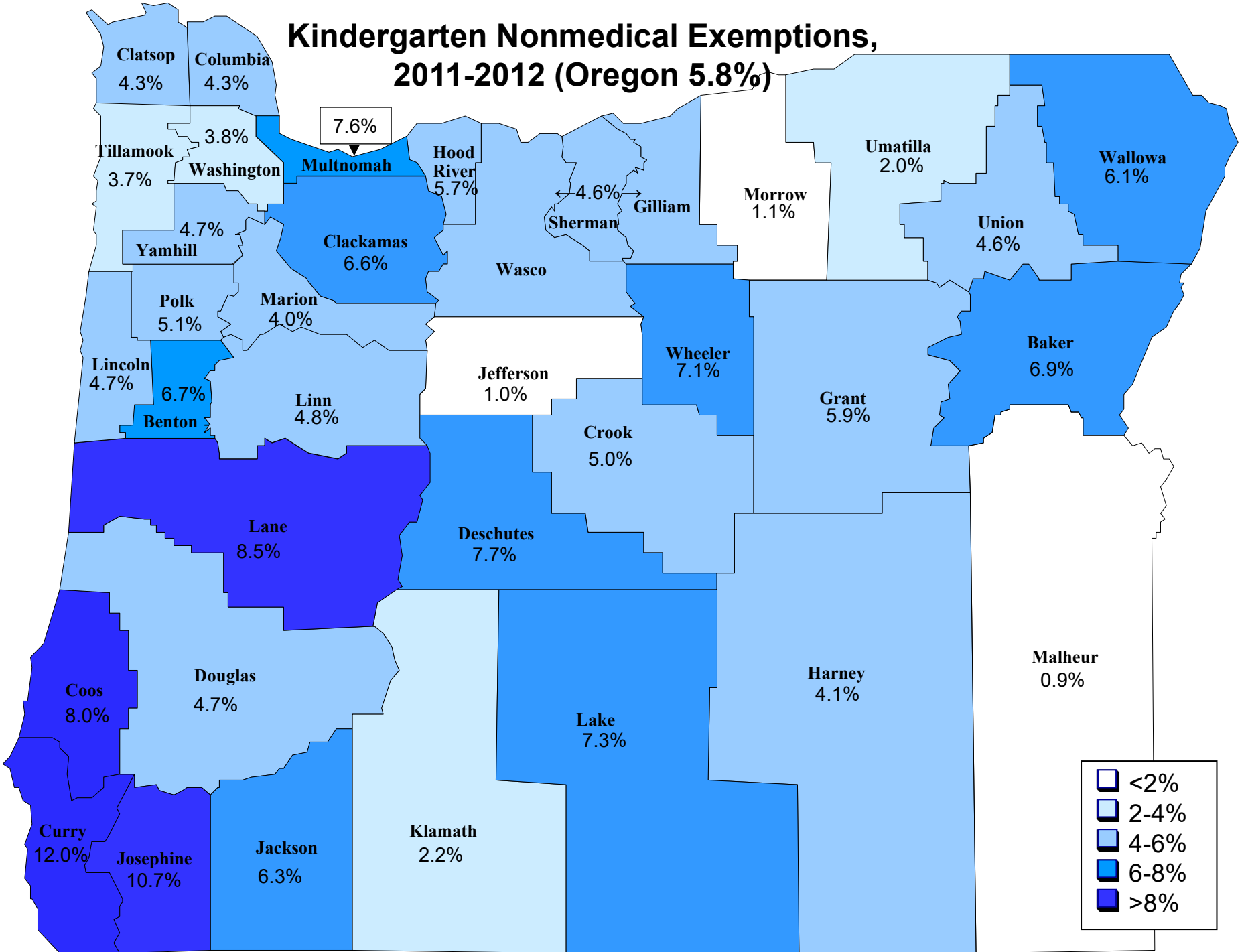

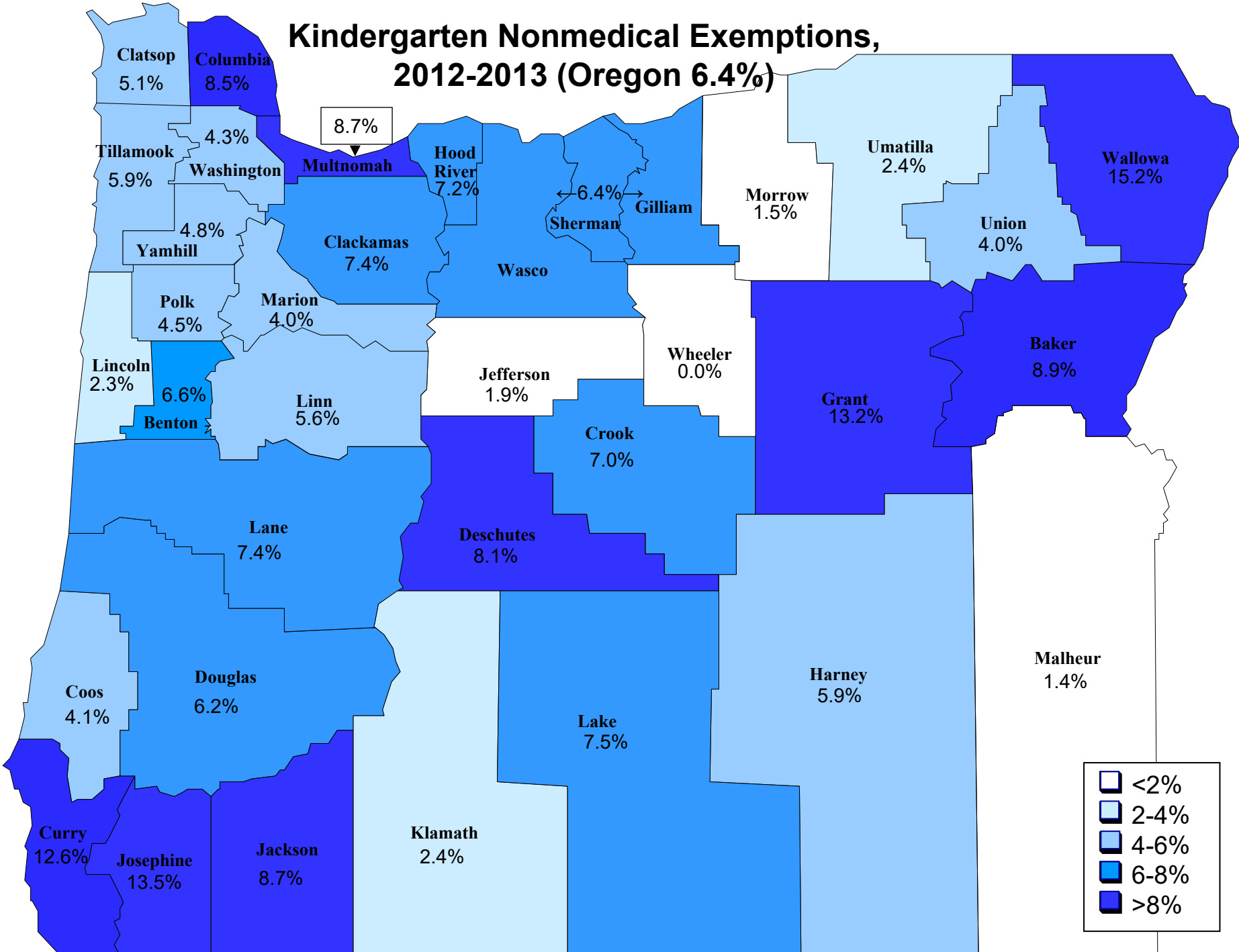

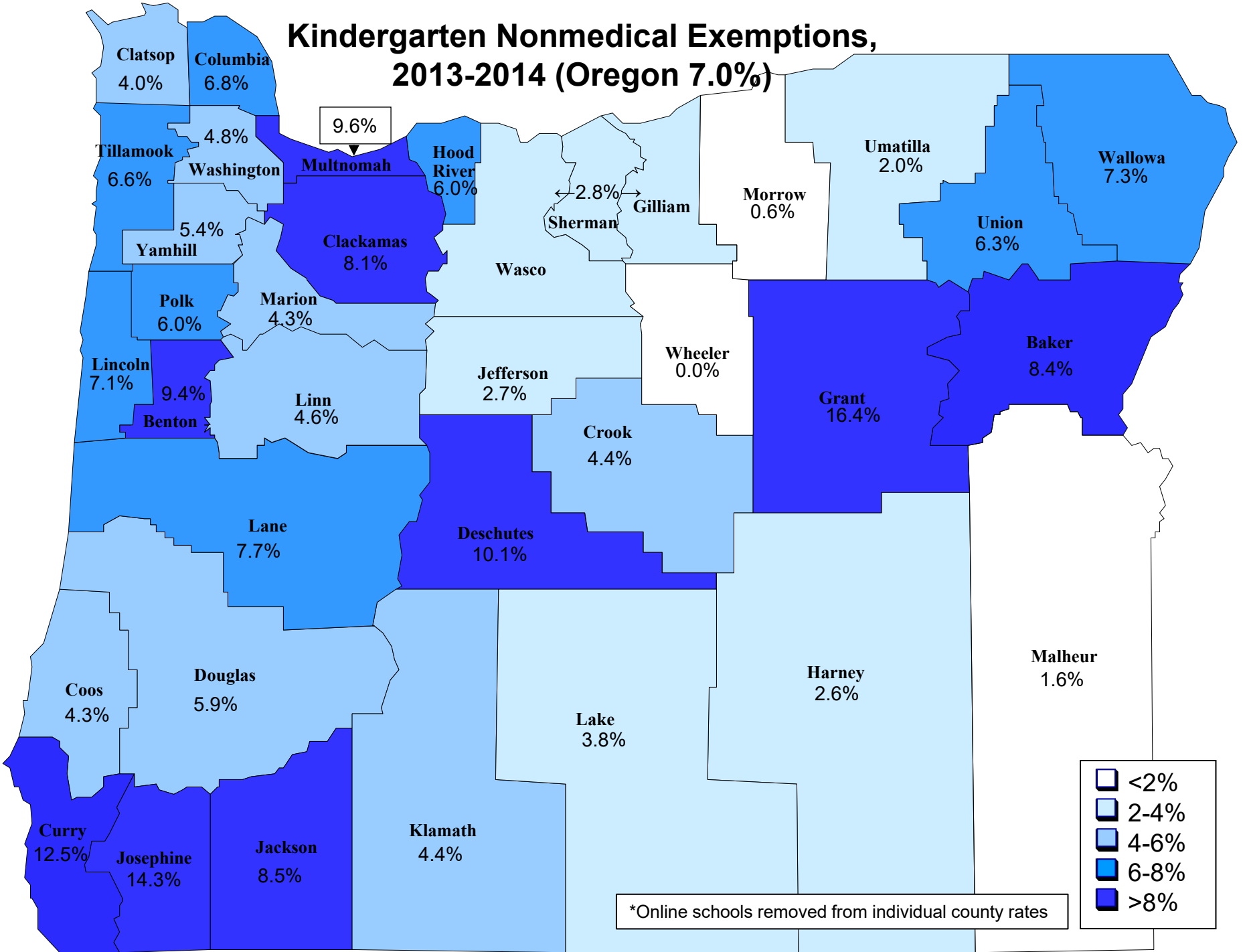

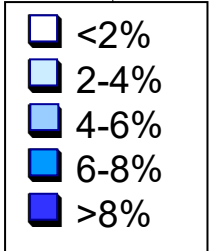

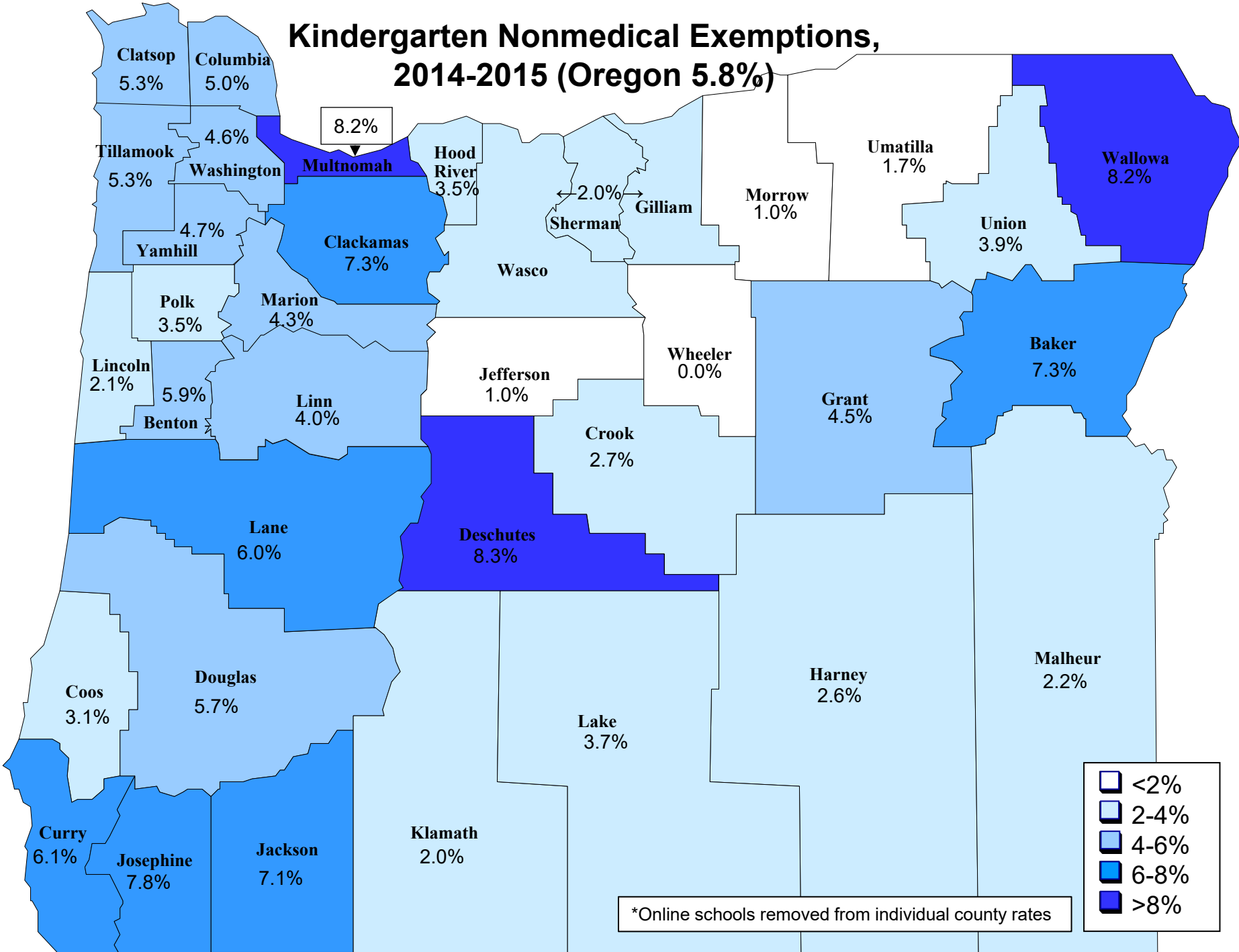

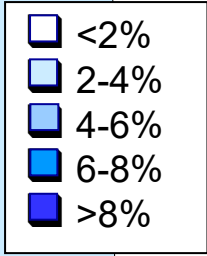

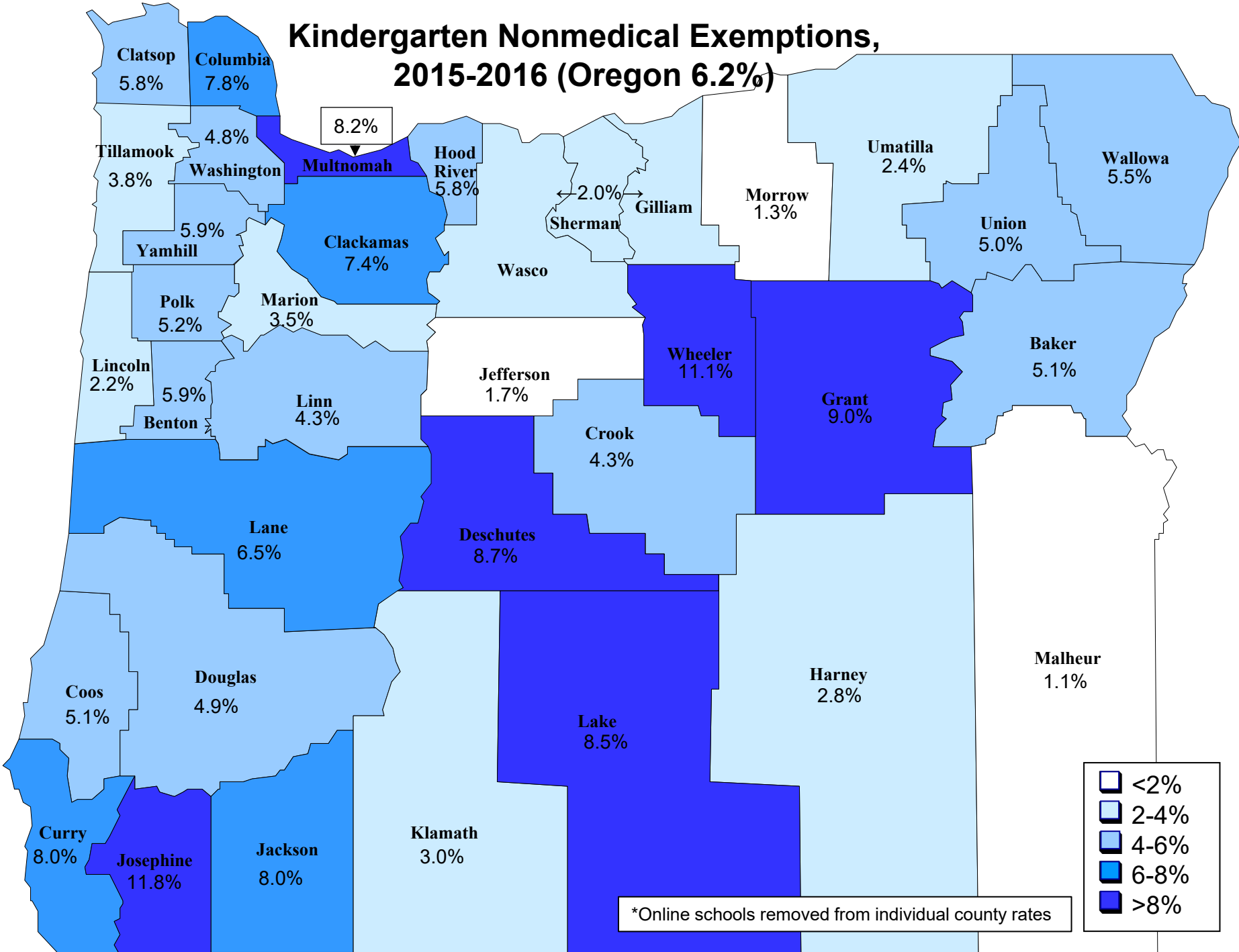
Kindergarten Nonmedical Exemptions, 2014-2015 (Oregon 5.8%)

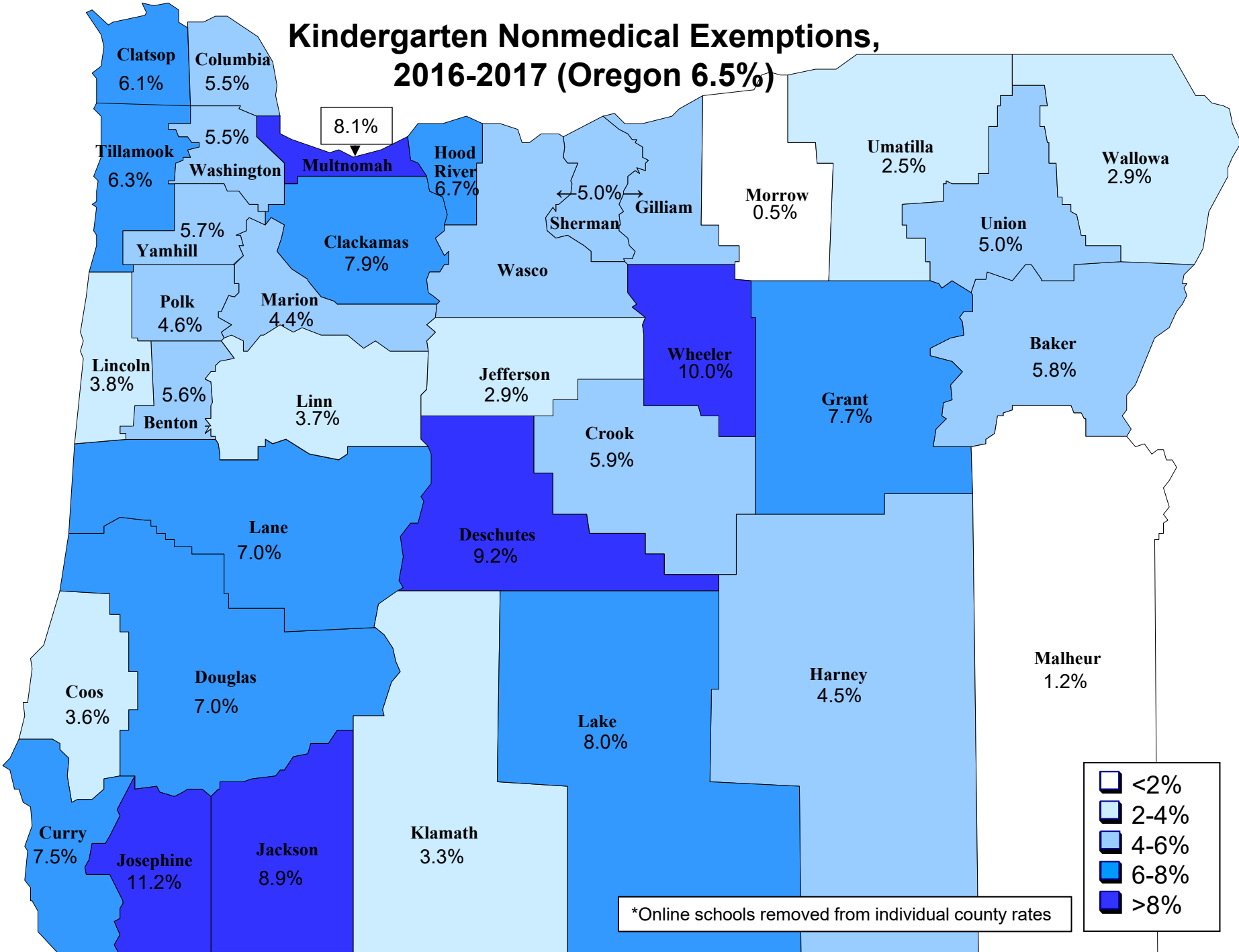


Kindergarten Nonmedical Exemptions, 2015-2016 (Oregon 6.2%)

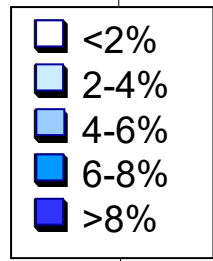

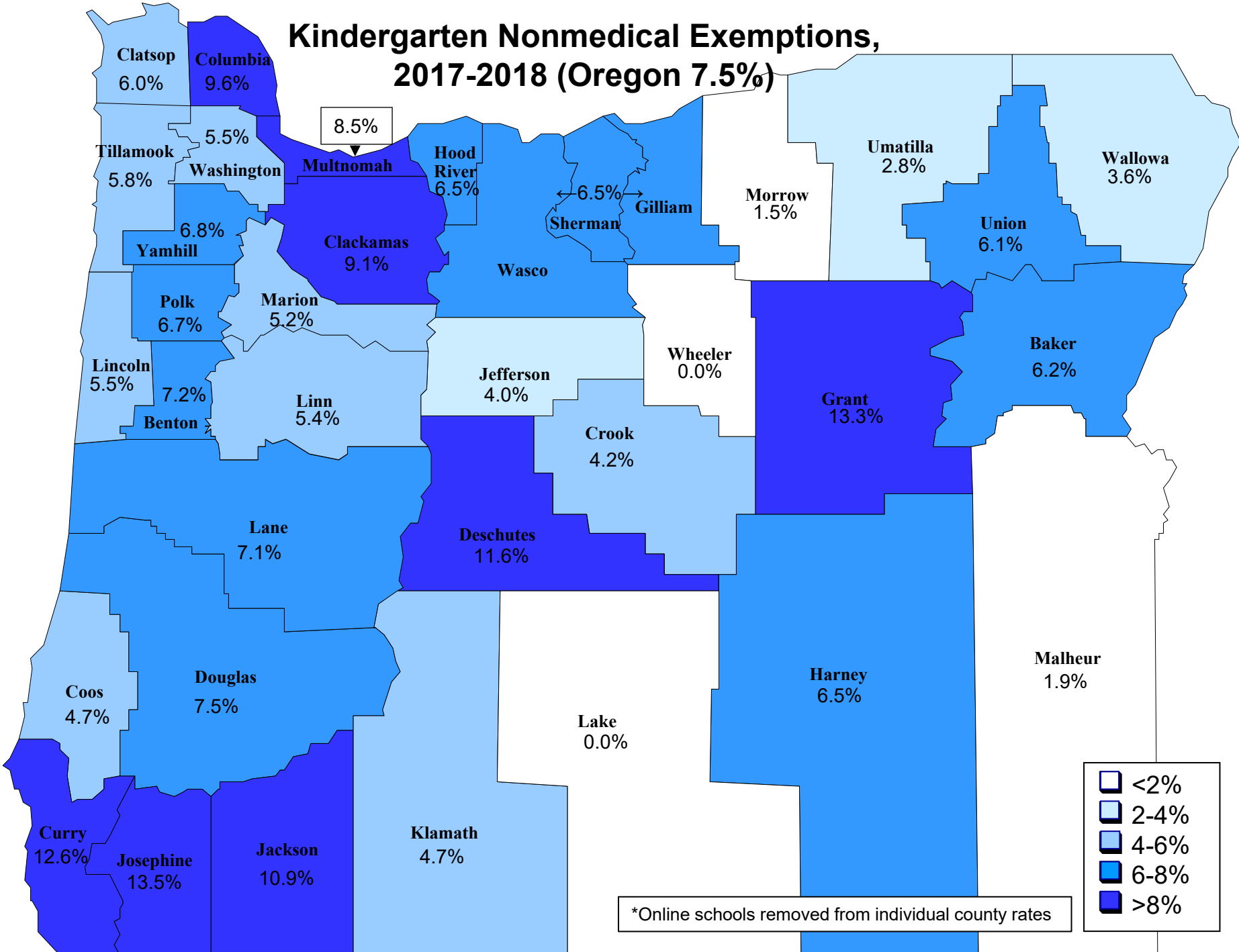

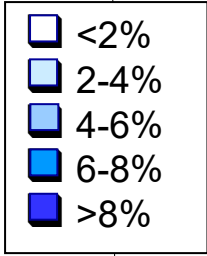

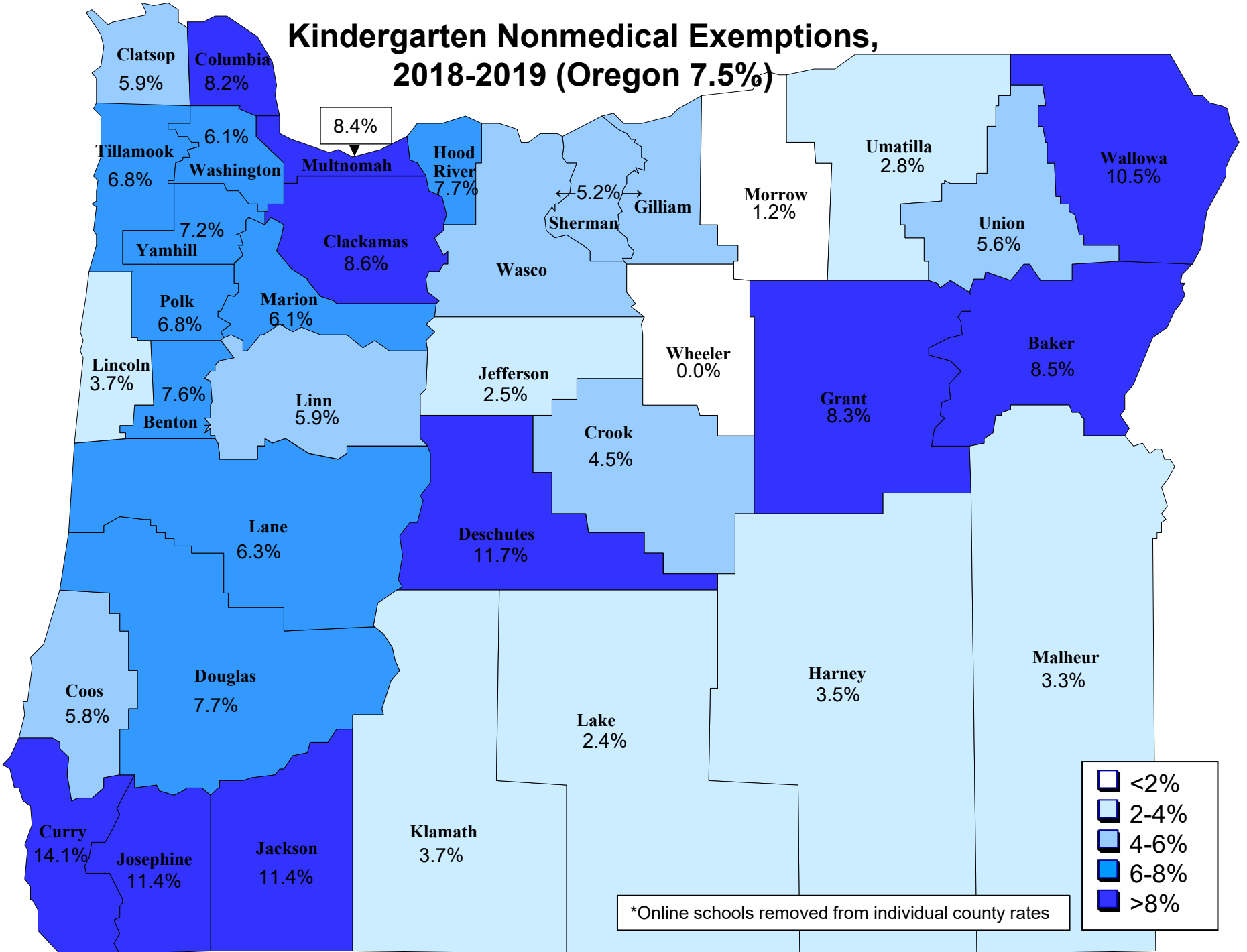

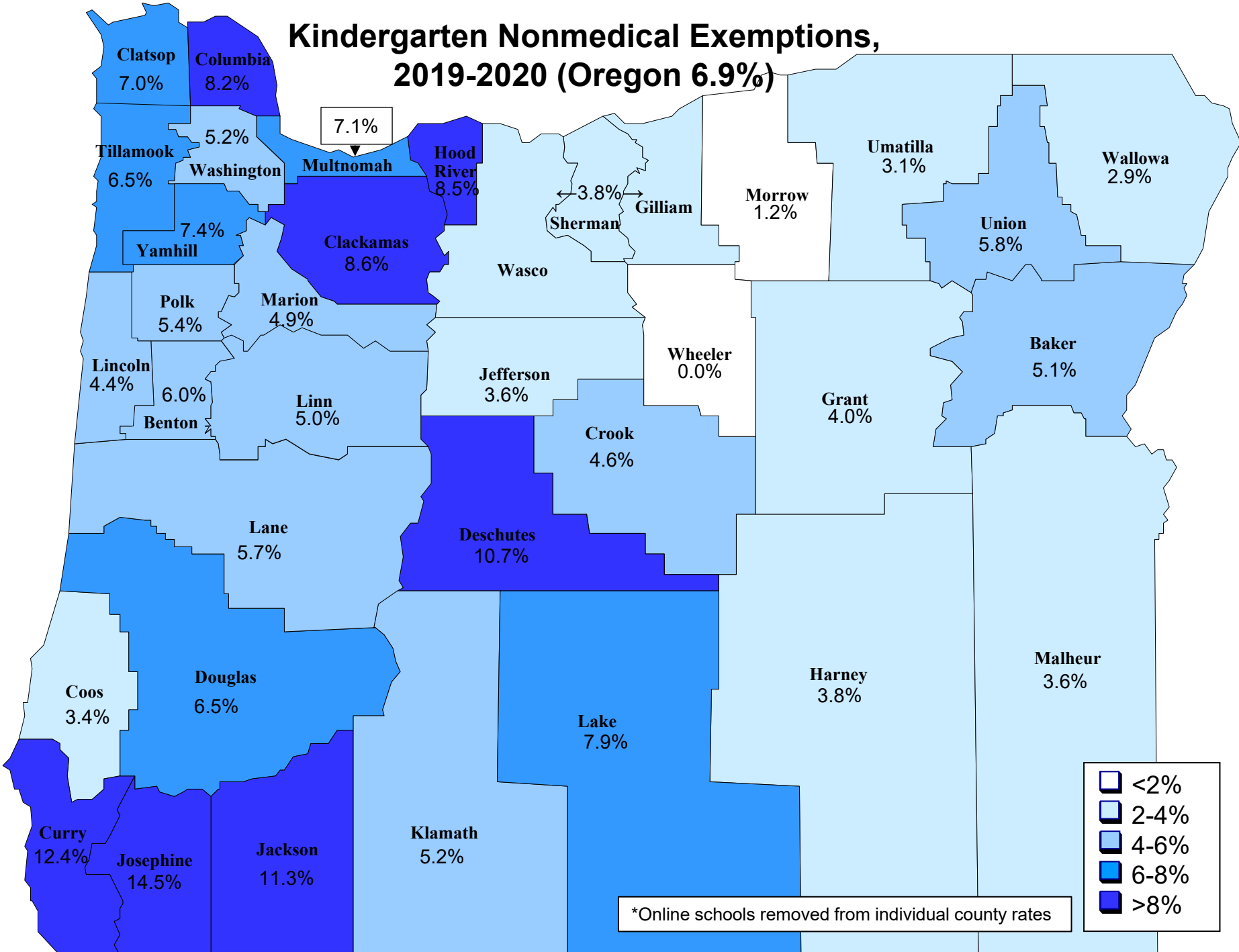

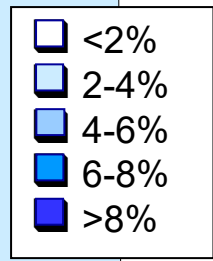

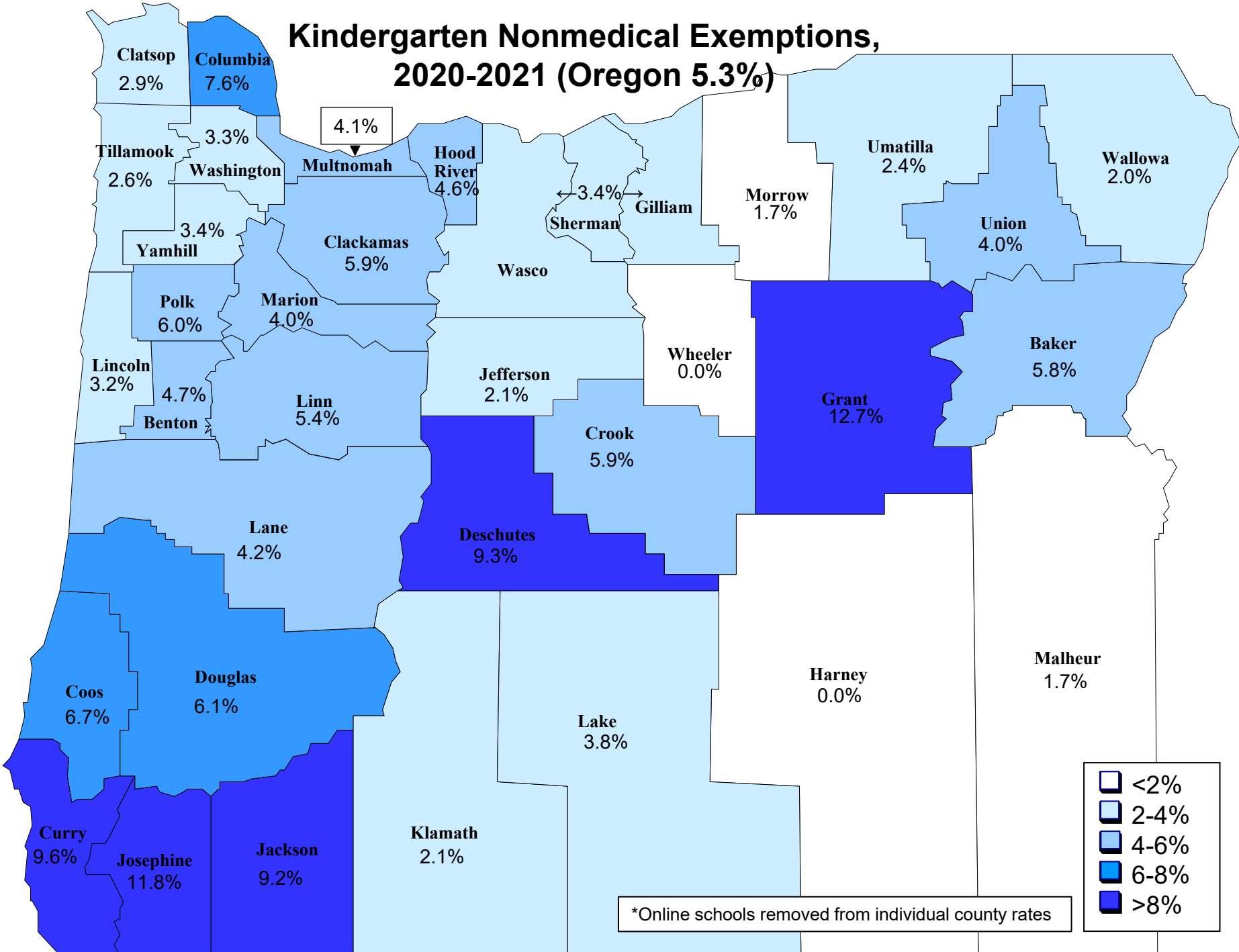

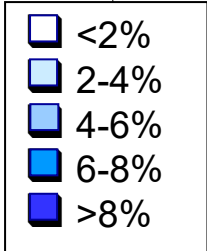

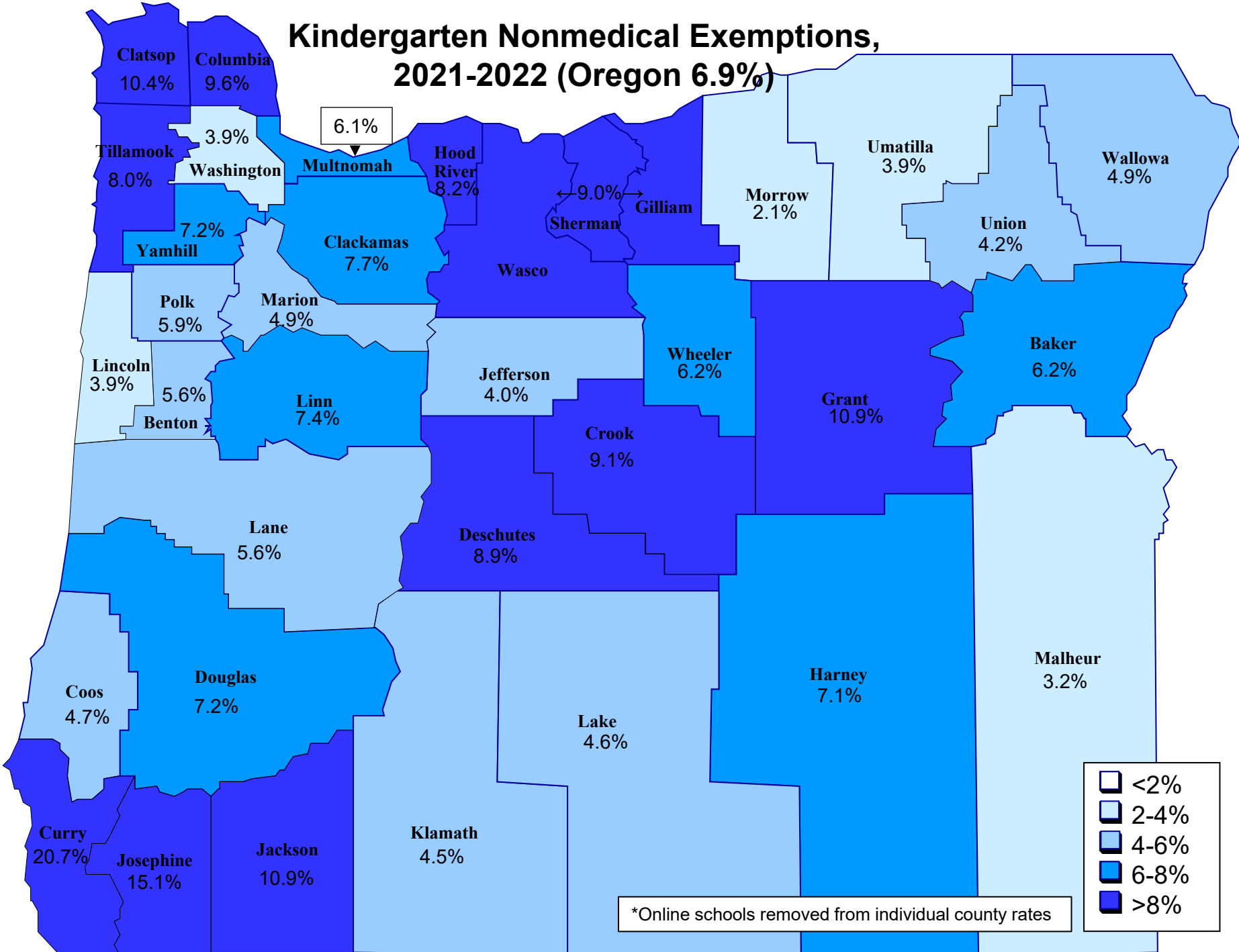

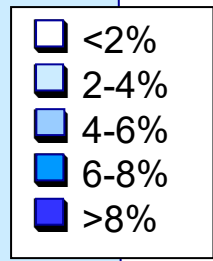

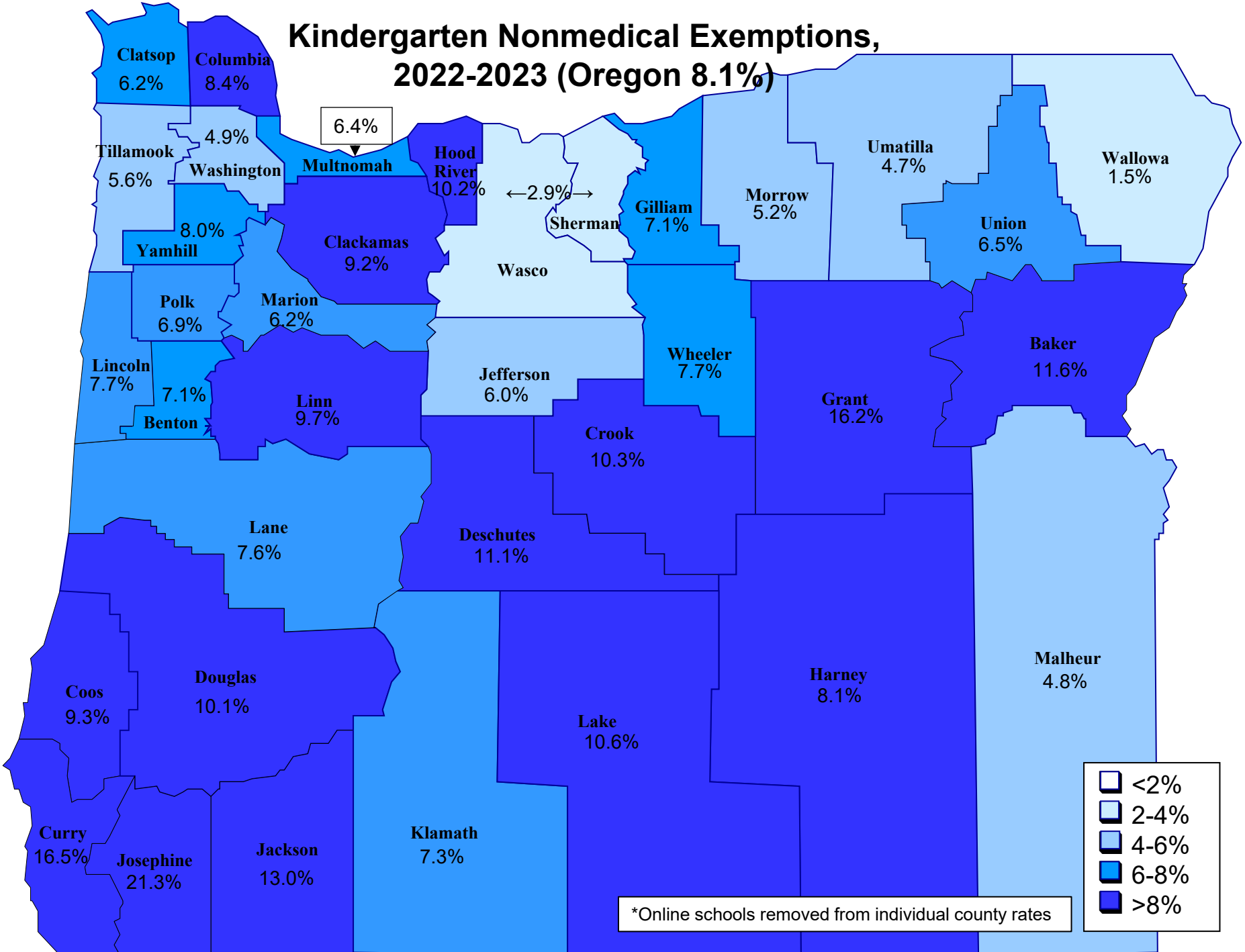

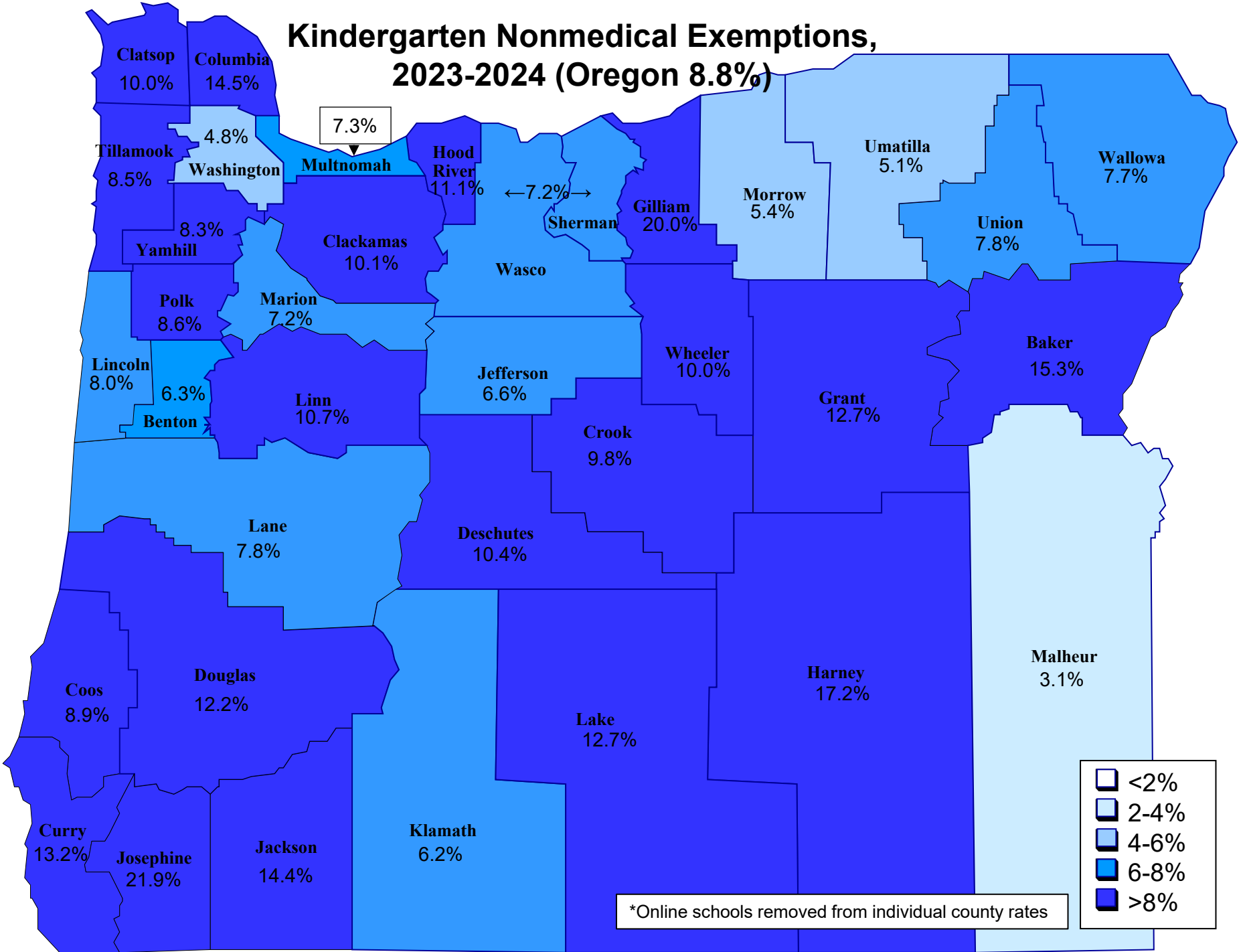


Kindergarten Nonmedical Exemptions, 2022-2023 (Oregon 8.1%)

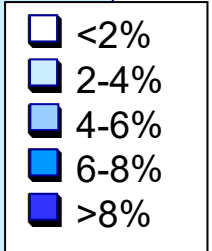

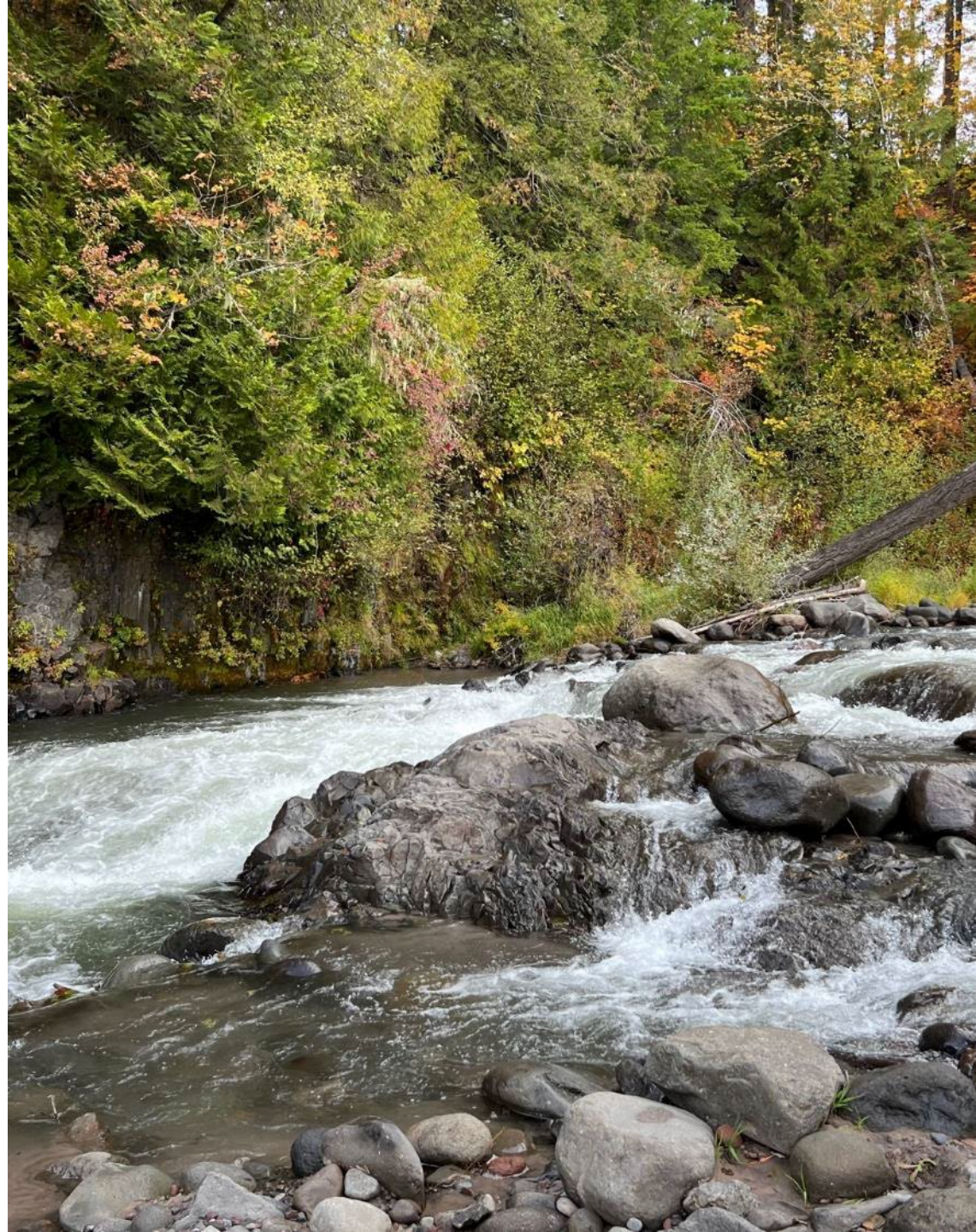
