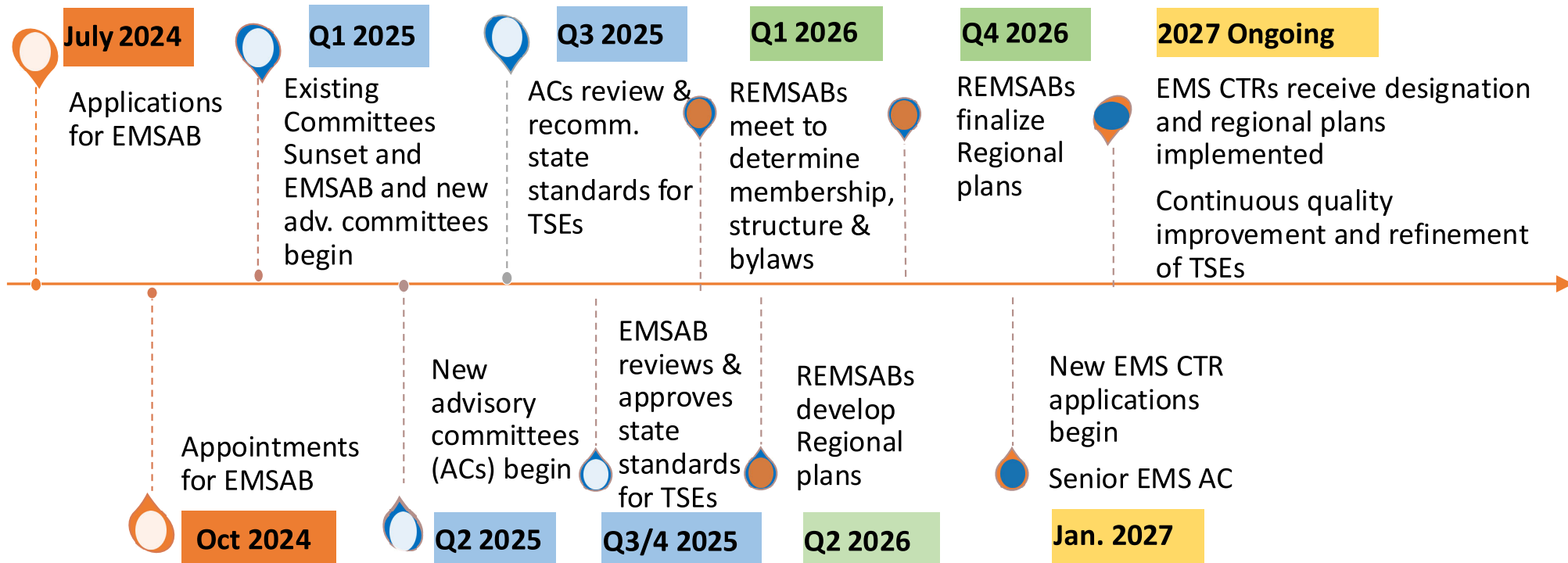

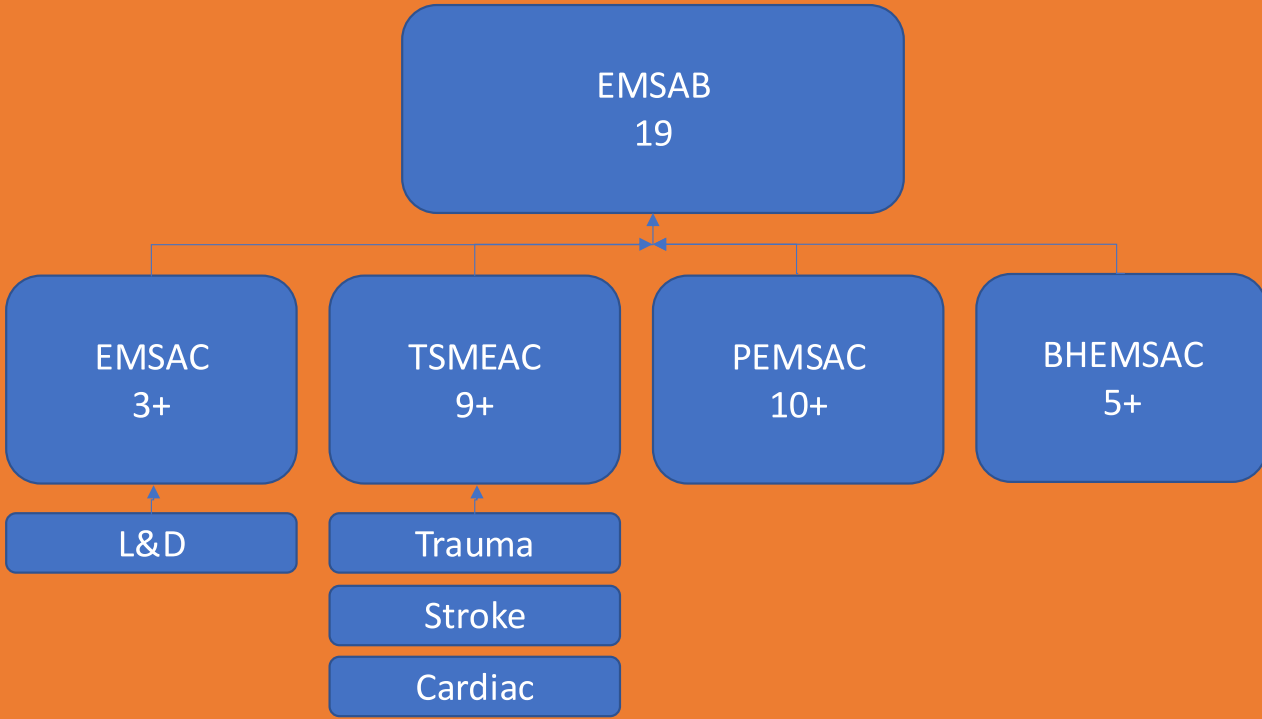

EMS Centers (EMS CTR) –hospital specialty services

- At least one EMS CTR per region
- Modeled on current trauma system – Stroke, Cardiac & Behavioral Health
- Voluntary categorization as EMS CTR to receive TSE patients
- EMS CTR standards –nationally recognized preferred
- Follow state standards in OAR and regional plans
- Flexibility for hospitals to become compliant and adopt data systems

Integrated EMS Data Systems

Identify

- Identify current national data standards
 - NTDS, GWTG, CARES, etc.

Adopt

- Adopt national standard when available

Form

- Form workgroups to create standards where none exist

Advise

- Advise program on implementation of data systems

Develop

- Develop and adopt quality measures

Adopt

- Adopt rules and policies to implement data systems
