




# EMS Centers (EMS CTR) -hospital specialty services

- At least one EMS CTR per region
- Modeled on current trauma system – Stroke, Cardiac & Behavioral Health
- Voluntary categorization as EMS CTR to receive TSE patients
- EMS CTR standards –nationally recognized preferred
- Follow state standards in OAR and regional plans
- Flexibility for hospitals to become compliant and adopt data systems

#### Integrated EMS Data Systems

#### Identify

- Identify current national data standards
  - NTDS, GWTG, CARES, etc.

#### Adopt

 Adopt national standard when available

#### Form

 Form workgroups to create standards where none exist

#### Advise

 Advise program on implementation of data systems

#### Develop

 Develop and adopt quality measures

 Adopt rules and policies to implement data systems


