SAMHSA Grant: Rural Emergency Medical Services Training

Notice of Funding Opportunity | Applications due Wednesday, March 20, 2024

Eligible applicants are rural emergency medical service agencies operated by a local or tribal government (fire-based and non-fire based) and rural non-profit emergency medical service agencies.

Purpose: to recruit and train EMS personnel in rural areas with a particular focus on addressing substance use disorders (SUD) and co-occurring disorders (COD) substance use and mental disorders. With this program, SAMHSA aims to develop the capacity of EMS staff to support residents in rural communities.

EMS Biosafety Transport

This <u>FREE EMS course</u> aims to increase understanding about standard and transmission-based infection control practices and provides education about high consequence infectious diseases like COVID-19, Mpox, Ebola Virus Disease, Smallpox, SARS, MERS, and novel, seasonal and pandemic influenza.

The course also describes operational considerations including selection of PPE, donning and doffing of PPE, modification of the ambulance, destination considerations, decontamination and disinfection of the ambulance and durable medical equipment, waste management, and post-mission medical surveillance.
