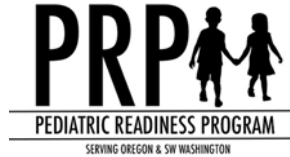

Participants will learn about how to distinguish between primary and secondary seizures, how to identify indications for ordering an outpatient EEG, prescribing a rescue medication, and starting anti-seizure and rescue medications. Participants will also learn about typical dosing and side effects of common anti-seizure and rescue medications. Participants will also understand why pediatric patients come to the emergency room for headache, and why emergency room utilization is increasing, while also discussing emergency room treatment of pediatric headache.
